延期项目的执行情况和第5条国家实现遵守  
《蒙特利尔议定书》今后管制措施的前景

## 执行摘要

- 根据截止 2011 年 10 月 6 日提交的 2010 年第 7 条数据和 2010 年国家方案数据，似乎没有国家未履约；
- 然而，最新消费量数据显示，多数国家实现了剩余物质的零消费（不包括氟氯烃和豁免情况），仅有 3 个国家 2009 年报告有哈龙消费；30 个国家报告有甲基溴消费；3 个国家报告有甲基氯仿消费；
- 在 2010 年的 49 个问题中，根据第 7 条数据和臭氧秘书处提供的信息，43 个问题已经得到解决，而根据第 7 条数据或臭氧秘书处提供的其他资料，有 2 个履约相关问题尚未得到解决。尚有 4 个问题未提供资料；
- 关于国家方案执行情况的数据表明：
  - 所有国家都按照 5 年以前核准的新格式提供了数据，但 51 个国家使用网络系统提交 2010 年数据，其中 5 个国家只提交了数据表；
  - 估计 2010 年第 5 条国家的消耗臭氧层物质剩余消费量共计 1,102.3 ODP 吨，不包括氟氯烃，约有 1,057.4 ODP 吨（包括第 7 条数据，有 1 个国家没有报告国家方案数据）消费量有待执行委员会审议采取行动；
  - 在 1,057.4 ODP 吨的剩余消费量中，全部为甲基溴；
  - 国家方案数据报告的氟氯烃消费量共计 501,922 公吨（33,301 ODP 吨）。128 个国家报告了 2009 年和 2010 年数据，其中氟氯烃消费量增加了 8.6%；
  - 在 144 个报告了许可证制度相关信息的国家中，有 135 个国家报告称这些制度已在运行中（在 107 个报告了 2010 年数据的国家中，有 100 个国家具有经营许可证制度，其中 97% 运行情况“令人满意”或“非常好”）。以下提供 2010 年数据的国家表示，它们的许可证制度运行情况不好：库克群岛、刚果民主共和国和莱索托；
  - HCFC-22、HCFC-141b 和 HCFC-142b 仍然比相关的各类氟氯化碳便宜得多。
- 在 34 个执行有延误的项目中，有 4 个项目已经完成，有 7 个项目报告了进展情况，有 3 个项目第一次报告没有进展，有 1 个项目将向第六十五次会议提交关于延误的报告，还有 15 个项目建议继续监测。尚未收到加拿大（1 个项目）、以色列（1 个项目）、葡萄牙（1 个项目）和西班牙（1 个项目）的延误报告；
- 建议提交一份补充报告，以介绍 55 个准备向本次会议提交情况报告的项目；两个项目的情况报告将提交第六十五次会议，以及建议就 7 个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制活动情况提交一份补充报告。

## 导言

1. 本文件由四部分组成：

- (a) 第一部分是根据第 32/76 (b) 和第 46/4 号决定编制的，其中请秘书处为执行委员会各次会议编制关于应遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》管制措施的第 5 条国家履约现状的增订资料。
- (b) 第二部分载有应遵守各缔约方决定和执行委员会履约建议的第 5 条国家的资料。
- (c) 第三部分提供了关于国家方案执行情况的数据，包括按行业分列的消耗臭氧层物质消费量数据的分析。还包含一部分述及国家消耗臭氧层物质淘汰方案特点的内容。
- (d) 第四部分介绍了关于存在执行延误的项目以及要求提供特别情况报告的项目的结果信息。

2. 本文件进行的分析和得出的结论不妨碍由缔约方会议所确定的履约现状，缔约方会议是唯一有权对履约现状进行评估的机构。根据《议定书》第 7 条报告的数据专门用于确定年度履约现状。本文件在分析时所使用的数据综合了向基金秘书处报告的履约各阶段国家方案执行情况的数据和第 7 条数据。因此，文件本身没有确定履约现状，而是评估了第 5 条国家在努力实现遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》一项或多项管制措施方面的前景。其主要目的是确定尚需要由多边基金支持的行动来加以处理的消耗臭氧层物质。

### 第一部分：履约现状和前景（根据最新可用数据）

3. 本部分介绍了对 2010 年前最终淘汰各类氟氯化碳、哈龙和四氯化碳以及 2015 年最终淘汰甲基溴和甲基氯仿的管制措施履约现状的分析结论。<sup>1</sup> 该分析假设根据第 7 条或国家方案数据报告的最新消费数据已经考虑到了已完成的由执行委员会核准项目的淘汰量。自多边基金设立以来，截至 2010 年 12 月，已完成项目淘汰的消费量为 235,604 ODP 吨，生产量为 191,246 ODP 吨。已完成项目的价值为 19.8 亿美元，核准的价值共计约 24.8 亿美元。关于此次分析所用方法的详细说明载于提交执行委员会第三十七次会议的 UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/37/18 号文件。

4. 分析采用了最新可用数据。截至 2011 年 10 月 6 日，有 121 个第 5 条国家已根据第 7 条报告了 2010 年数据（2010 年 10 月有 119 个国家）。另有 7 个国家向基金秘书处报告了关于国家方案执行进度的 2010 年数据（第 17/34 号决定）。对于尚未提交 2010 年数据的国家，分析采用了最新可用消费数据。包括使用 2009 年第 7 条数据的 19 个国家。分析假设，最新报告的不包括氟氯烃的消耗臭氧层物质消费量并未增加，尽管这种情况对于未提供 2010 年数据的 19 个国家来说可能并不属实。

5. 双边和多边执行机构向执行委员会第六十四次会议提交了年度进度报告，其中载有关于截至 2010 年底委员会核准的所有活动和项目执行情况的数据。关于 2011 年可能获得

核准的数据来自第六十三次会议核准的《2011-2014 年综合业务计划》（UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/63/7）。

6. 基金秘书处将继续综合以前关于履约现状和前景的报告中的所有数据。这些数据被基金秘书处用于分析之目的。可应要求提供这些数据。

### 生产行业

7. 在 7 个<sup>2</sup>有氟氯化碳生产设施的第 5 条国家中，阿根廷、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国、印度、墨西哥和委内瑞拉玻利瓦尔共和国政府拥有关于计划削减的协定。所有氟氯化碳生产项目已经完成，但中国仍在继续报告，印度的剩余付款尚未达成一致，尽管它已将其提交第六十五次会议审批。巴西政府表示它已自行淘汰了各类氟氯化碳的生产。关于哈龙生产，中国政府已有一项协定，而印度政府得到了一次性赠款用以关闭其哈龙生产设施。

8. 4 个国家（巴西、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国和印度）确定了四氯化碳生产基准。3 个国家（中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国和印度）有四氯化碳生产基准。三个国家（中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国和印度）的生产和消费行业彻底淘汰四氯化碳的项目已经得到执行委员会核准。第五十四次会议核准了巴西的一个四氯化碳加工剂行业项目。只有中国的甲基氯仿生产关闭项目得到核准。

9. 中国作为仅有的两个拥有甲基溴生产设施的第 5 条国家之一，其甲基溴生产关闭项目已获核准。另一个国家大韩民国没有寻求基金援助。

10. 有 6 个国家在 2009 或 2010 年生产了氟氯烃：阿根廷、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国、印度、墨西哥和委内瑞拉玻利瓦尔共和国。生产行业分组将在第六十五次会议期间的会议上收到顾问关于中国氟氯烃生产行业技术审计的临时报告。

### 消费行业

11. 这一部分概述了对似乎未履约或其最新消费量超过管制措施的国家违约程度进行详细分析的结果。在制定基准前提供了除氟氯烃以外的所有五种受控物质的一览表。这些一览表的数据显示了似乎未遵守 2010 年管制措施的国家，以及包括 2009 年数据在内的消费数据超过下一管制措施的国家。概述所依据的数据载于附件一，其中包含按物质分列的各国的详细资料。附件一还说明了这些国家是否得到了预计将由多边基金提供的所有援助。

12. 附件一所载履约情况评估中包含了何时核准有助于履约的活动以及国家是否报告了有关建立许可证制度的资料。这些资料应有助于执行委员会评估各国的履约前景，因为已核准数据表明了项目或协定已经执行的时间。此外，建立许可证制度的资料表明，现有的管制措施保证了未来的履约，不管当前的消费量是多少。关于项目核准的资料来自《已核准项目目录》。2011 年 8 月 8 日，臭氧秘书处提供了关于建立许可证制度的数据。

## 各类氟氯化碳

13. 表 1 概括了各国对各类氟氯化碳管制措施的履约现状。

14. 所有其最新消费量数据超过 2010 年管制措施的国家均已得到多边基金的支助。

## 哈龙

15. 表 2 概括了各国遵守哈龙管制措施的现状。有 75 个国家在 1995 和 2010 年期间没有报告哈龙的任何消费量。有 61 个国家获得了关于哈龙库活动或淘汰协定的支助，包括参与区域哈龙库的国家。

## 甲基溴

16. 表 3 概述了各国对甲基溴管制措施的履约现状（不包括检疫和装船前）。在 145 个已批准《哥本哈根修正案》中的国家，有 144 个国家均报告完成了基准数据。有 2 个国家尚未批准《哥本哈根修正案》，它们是几内亚和尼泊尔。在这 145 个已批准《哥本哈根修正案》的国家中，有 57 个国家报告其基准消费量和最新消费量均为零。99 个国家的甲基溴淘汰活动和（或）项目获得了多边基金的支助。

17. 土库曼斯坦是唯一一个最新消费量超过其 2005 年管制措施的国家。土库曼斯坦已核准有助于彻底淘汰甲基溴的项目。

#### 四氯化碳

18. 表 4 概括了各国履行四氯化碳管制措施的现状。概括数据不包括原料，也不按照特定用途进行区分（诸如溶剂和加工剂）。在 146 个报告了基准数据的国家中，有 90 个国家报告基准消费和最新消费均为零。

19. 所有最新消费量超过其 2010 年管制措施的国家均已得到了多边基金的支助，大韩民国除外。大韩民国已同意不从多边基金领取四氯化碳供资。

#### 甲基氯仿

20. 表 5 概括了各国对甲基氯仿管制措施的履约现状。在 146 个报告了基准数据的国家中，有 103 个国家报告其基准消费量和最新消费量均为零。

21. 所有最新消费量超过其下一个管制措施的国家均已得到多边基金的支助，大韩民国除外。大韩民国已同意不领取多边基金的供资。

### 氟氯烃

22. 附件一的附录六载有对氟氯烃最新消费数据的分析，并指出国家是否收到氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制供资、核准的投资项目数量、核准的示范项目数量、以 ODP 吨计算的核准淘汰总量以及 2011 年业务计划中规划的各项活动。提供补充资料是为了说明迄今获得核准并提交第六十五次会议的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划及其时间范围（例如，已核准氟氯烃淘汰管理计划将在 2015 年实现 10% 削减或者在 2020 年实现 35% 削减）。执行委员会迄今已核准 81 项氟氯烃淘汰管理计划协议。

23. 截止 2011 年 10 月 6 日，121 个第 5 条国家报告了基准和最新消费量数据。

24. 所有国家均收到了氟氯烃淘汰管理计划项目编制供资，大韩民国、新加坡和阿拉伯联合酋长国除外。这些国家同意不领取多边基金的供资。2 个已收到氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制的国家（几内亚和尼泊尔）尚未批准《哥本哈根修正案》。依据第 53/37 号决定，批准《哥本哈根修正案》是获得氟氯烃淘汰管理计划供资的前提条件。

### 第二部分：须遵守缔约方关于履约问题各项决定的国家的执行情况

25. 本节述及须遵守关于履约问题各项决定的第 5 条国家。

26. 有 49 项缔约方决定涉及到履约问题，它们适用于 36 个国家。其中 43 个履约相关问题已根据第 7 条或臭氧秘书处的数据得到解决。有 2 个履约相关问题根据第 7 条或臭氧秘书处的数据尚未得到解决。有 4 个问题的相关资料尚未提供。表 6 根据提供给臭氧秘书处和各机构的信息以及国家方案数据，说明了执行委员会各项决定取得的进展情况。

### 附件二中的资料

27. 附件二提供的资料介绍了需遵守 2011 年缔约方关于履约问题各项决定的国家情况。提供的资料按履约问题和国家编排。附件二还包括题为“基金秘书处和执行机构评论意见”的专栏，提供的资料摘自国家臭氧机构提交的国家方案数据报告以及臭氧秘书处和各执行机构酌情提供的数据。

### 第三部分：关于国家方案执行情况的数据

28. 第三部分载有关于国家方案执行情况的数据，包括按行业分列的消耗臭氧层物质消费数据，这些数据在每年 5 月 1 日前提交基金秘书处。本节还提供了关于国家消耗臭氧层物质淘汰方案特点的补充资料。国家方案数据报告格式由执行委员会第三十五次会议第 35/58 (e) 号决定核准，并根据第 46/39 号决定和第 60/4 (b) (四) 号决定进行了修订。

### 按行业分列除氟氯烃以外的消耗臭氧层物质消费数据

29. 截至 2011 年 10 月 6 日，基金秘书处已从 144 个被要求提交这类报告的国家中收到 107 个国家的 2010 年国家方案执行情况的最新报告，34 个国家的 2009 年报告以及 2 个国家的 2008 年报告。1 个国家从未报告国家方案数据：南非。南非只有资格接受多边基金为氟氯烃提供的援助。应当指出，体制建设项目的延期要以接收到这类数据的情况而定。此外，国家方案实施数据必须在本年度最后一次会议和后续会议之前提交，作为核准和发放项目资金的先决条件。所有向第六十五次会议提交供资申请的国家还提交了 2010 年国家方案数据，冈比亚和约旦除外。

30. 尽管所记录的消费量取自不同年份，并且可能未必符合所报告的第 7 条数据，但国家方案数据仍提供了全球范围内按国家分列的最新行业评估。这些数据应协助相关的第 5 条国家和执行委员会评估各行业仍需淘汰的物质。

31. 考虑到已核准但尚未执行的项目，表 7 按行业分列了淘汰剩余消耗臭氧层物质（氟氯烃除外）的消费总量。表 7 还包括尚未完成的核准项目的淘汰消费总量。

32. 已核准但尚未执行的消耗臭氧层物质（氟氯烃除外）削减总量（表 7）不包括原则上核准多年期协定的数量或者预计通过执行制冷剂管理计划和哈龙库活动实现的削减量。除已获供资的削减量，执行委员会还原则上核准了行业和国家淘汰项目根据实现的计划削减量发放年度付款。

33. 如表 7 所示，今后年度付款的削减将涉及大量剩余消费量。此外，低消费量国家的制冷剂管理计划占这些国家基准消费和最终淘汰管理计划剩余基准的 85%。然而，已核准但尚未执行的项目数据不计入这一消费量的总数之中。另外，表 7 中已核准但尚未执行的消耗臭氧层物质淘汰量不包括已接受哈龙库项目的国家的某些哈龙消费量。

34. （考虑到最终淘汰管理计划、低消费量国家的制冷剂管理计划、哈龙库、全部淘汰项目和原则上核准的多年期协定产生的淘汰量）尚待解决的消耗臭氧层物质（氟氯烃除外）剩余消费总量似乎为 1,057.4 ODP 吨（表 8），这比向第六十二次会议报告的 1,102.3 ODP 吨略有下降。

## 氟氯烃数据

35. 表 9 列出了基于现有最新数据的氟氯烃消费量。它表明，氟氯烃的消费量为 501,922 公吨 (33,301 ODP 吨)，主要包括 HCFC-22 (占总量的 61%) 和 HCFC-141b (占总量的 32%) 的消费量。501,922 公吨的氟氯烃消费量表明，该数量比向第六十二次会议报告的数量 (473,715 公吨) 增加了 28,207 公吨。相比之下，截至 2010 年 12 月 31 日，多边基金削减了 233,087 公吨 (244,343 ODP 吨) 消耗臭氧层物质消费量。报告中的这一数据来源于 107 个国家报告的 2010 年数据、34 个国家的 2009 年数据和 2 个国家的 2008 年数据。关于报告了 2009 年和 2010 年数据的国家，其氟氯烃消费量增长了 8.6 %。

## 国家淘汰方案的特点

36. 第 46/39 号决定通过且在第六十次会议上修订 (第 60/4 (b) (四) 号决定) 的国家方案报告的新格式，为国家臭氧机构提供了一次从质和量的角度来评估履约前景的机会。

## 数据的完整性

37. 这是第五年使用新格式报告国家方案数据。9 个国家仍使用第四十六次会议核准的格式提供了 2010 年数据，98 个国家使用了第六十次会议核准的修订格式。然而，大部分以新格式提供的数据都不完整，主要表现在质量、数量和规范性三个方面。仅有 10 个国家，即巴哈马、布基纳法索、赤道几内亚、几内亚比绍、肯尼亚、马来西亚、巴拉圭、摩尔多瓦共和国、塞拉利昂和土库曼斯坦从所有三个方面提供了完整资料。

38. 按照第 59/4 (b) (四) 号决定，秘书处审查了网上的国家方案执行数据。秘书处注意到，只有 51 个国家采用 2007 年 4 月 25 日启动的网络系统提交 2010 年数据，其中包括 5 个仅提交数据单表的国家。

39. 冈比亚和约旦. 在被要求提供国家方案数据的 144 个国家中, 有 107 个国家及时提供了 2010 年国家方案数据, 用于本文件分析。所有向第六十五次会议提交供资申请的国家还提供了 2010 年国家方案数据, 冈比亚和约旦除外。

## 数据概要

### 氟氯烃以外的所有消耗臭氧层物质

40. 在 107 个报告制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的国家中, 有 87 个国家表示, 在其制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的执行过程中取得了进展, 或者已经完成这些计划。包括报告 2010 年以前数据的国家, 这 143 个国家中有 118 个国家表示在执行制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的过程中取得了进展, 或者已完成了这些计划。

41. 在报告 2010 年以前数据的国家中, 共有 13,152 台回收机和 4,659 台再循环机正在运行。在使用回收和再循环机器的国家中, 75% 的国家报告机器运行状况“令人满意”或“非常好”。回收的 CFC-11 共计 2,421.4 ODP 吨, 其中 2,153.2 ODP 吨得到了再利用; 回收的 CFC-12 共计 24,463.8 ODP 吨, 再利用的有 21,112.8 ODP 吨。未收集其他消耗臭氧层物质的数据。综合 2006-2010 年报告的最新数据以及此前数年度报告中的数据表明, 共有 64,323 名制冷维修技术员接受过培训, 50,679 人获得了证书, 并有 2,929 名制冷技术员培训人员接受了培训。

42. 在 143 个报告了数据 (包括此前数年度报告的数据) 的国家中, 109 个国家表示已制定了配额制度。此外, 121 个国家建议将进口商注册作为一项规定。根据报告, 共有 14,600 名海关官员接受了培训。目前尚不清楚这一数据是年度数据还是累计数据。

43. 在 144 个符合报告要求的国家中, 135 个国家报告已实施了经营许可证制度 (在报告了 2010 年数据的 107 个国家中, 100 个国家已实施经营许可证制度, 其中 97% 运行状况“令人满意”或“非常好”)。下列国家没有报告其许可证制度是否已经运行: 库克群岛、刚果民主共和国和莱索托。谨建议执行委员会请秘书处致函这些国家, 询问它们为什么报告其许可证制度运行不满意。

### 各类氟氯化碳和氟氯烃及其替代品的价格数据

45. 未提供哈龙、甲基溴或四氯化碳的此类数据。

46. 表 10 显示, 根据本次数据样本, 2010 年 HCFC-22、HCFC-141b 和 HCFC-142b 的价格仍旧比相关各类氟氯化碳便宜得多。应该指出的是, 仅有 13 个国家提供了 CFC-11

的价格数据，29个国家提供了 CFC-12 的价格数据，而且由于这些氟氯化碳将来自库存量，因而无法判断大多数国家是否销售任何氟氯化碳。例如，关于 HFC-134a 和丙烷（HC-290），表 10 所示的价格高于各种氟氯化碳的价格，但该表并未考虑各类氟氯化碳缺乏可用性的问题。

### 氟氯烃

47. 这是第二年采用第六十次会议上（第 60/4（b）（四）号决定）核准的修订格式以纳入氟氯烃淘汰情况的相关资料。在 107 个采用修订格式提供 2010 年数据的国家中，有 98 个国家列入有关氟氯烃的资料。

48. 在报告了数据的 116 个国家中，有 63 个国家指出，已经出台了配额制度，有 93 个国家通知说已将进口商注册定为一项要求。回收 HCFC-22 共计 38,696.5 ODP 吨，其中 37,845.5 ODP 吨得到再利用。根据报告，共有 4,597 名海关官员接受了氟氯烃方面的培训。共有 1,350 台回收机和 442 台再循环机正在运行。共有 9,644 名技术员获得了证书，18,703 名技术员接受了培训，1,464 名技术员培训人员接受了培训，以回收和再循环各种氟氯烃。

### 第四部分：存在执行延误及需要特殊情况报告的项目

49. 有 34 个正在执行的项目被归于执行延误的项目类别，并可能进入委员会的项目取消程序。存在执行延误的项目包括：（一）预计将会在超过 12 个月后完成的项目，和（或）（二）在项目批准后的 18 个月内未付款。按执行和双边机构分列的延误执行项目如表 11 所示：工发组织（8 个）；开发计划署（7 个）；环境规划署（5 个）；世界银行（4 个）；意大利（3 个）；日本（2 个）；以及澳大利亚（1 个）。尚未收到加拿大（1 个）、以色列（1 个）、葡萄牙（1 个）和西班牙（1 个）的报告。延误最常见的原因与外界因素相关（9 个）。

#### 解决延误原因过程中取得的进展

50. 执行机构和双边机构在其报告中提出，在解决延误问题的过程中已取得了不同程度的进展。在第六十四次会议上列出的存在延误的项目中有 4 个现已完成（附件三）。7 个项目取得了一定进展，或者解决了执行有延误项目的问题，可能将其排除在今后报告的执行有延误的项目之外（附件四）。

### *取得一定进展的项目*

51. 有 15 个项目被列入取得“一定进展”的类别，其执行和双边机构表示将继续对这些项目进行监测（附件五）。尽管取得了进展，但应该指出的是，必须根据第 32/4 号决定继续监测三年多以前核准的项目。因此，在最终完成之前，不能将这些项目排除在监测清单之外，尽管可能已取得了进展。所以建议继续对这些项目进行监测。

### *未取得进展的项目——可能取消函*

52. 有 3 个项目自第六十四次会议以来就没有取得进展（附件六）。根据现行政程序，基金秘书处将以该项目没有取得进展为依据，对它发出可能取消函。

### *将向第六十五次会议报告的项目*

53. 应向第六十五次会议报告 1 个项目的执行情况（附件七）。

### *要求提交补充情况报告的项目*

54. 体制建设、哈龙库、海关培训、回收和再循环以及示范项目不受项目取消程序的制约。然而，执行委员会已决定继续对其开展适当的监测（第 36/14 (b) 号决定）。在第六十四次会议上，执行委员会要求提交 127 份补充情况报告。要求提交此类情况报告的条件是，自上一次报告以来没有任何进展迹象，和（或）报告称执行过程中存在其他障碍。70 个项目取得了进展。按要求有 55 个项目向第六十六次会议提交补充情况报告（附件八），其中包括要求提交补充情况报告的原因。此外，按要求有 2 个项目向第六十五次会议提交情况报告（附件九），其中包括关于印度氟氯化碳生产行业及墨西哥销毁消耗臭氧层物质项目的报告。

55. 附件显示，仍存在没有签署协定而进行的氟氯化碳活动，且尚未采购回收和再循环机电设备。仍然存在正在与国家银行进行讨论、付款额不高、正在转让、正在被重新设计以及挑选一名顾问来执行这个项目的冷风机项目。还存在应提交但尚未提交第六十五次会议的若干销毁消耗臭氧层物质项目。连续两次会议的两个哈龙库项目付款额仍然偏低。还有付款额不高的一个氟氯烃示范项目和一个氟氯烃投资项目正等待项目文件签署，而其他项目取得了进展。在 35 份关于体制建设项目文件签署的情况报告中，7 个项目尚未签署，5 个项目尚未按要求提交财务报告。有两次甲基溴项目的项目编制未按照计划提交，一个正等待甲基溴技术选择委员会就水含量高替代品日期给出建议。另一个甲基溴项目的前景正在重新评估。一个消耗臭氧层物质监管活动仍等待挑选培训中心。仍有一个制冷剂管理计划的设备竞标尚未完成。两个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的付款额不高。

### *氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制/项目文件签署*

56. 执行委员会核准了 81 个国家的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划，价值 4.139 亿美元，其中 1.945 亿美元用于首次年度付款活动，至此，执行委员会已核准 144 个国家的 297 个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划。根据已经核准以及提交第六十五次会议的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的数量，35 个国家将在第六十五次会议后提交其氟氯烃淘汰管理计划。

57. 执行委员会第六十四次会议要求就氟氯烃淘汰管理计划发展项目提交 13 份补充情况报告。要求提交此类情况报告的条件是，自上一次报告以来没有任何进展迹象，和（或）报告称执行过程中存在其他障碍。相关的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划处于各完成阶段，其中有 2 个国家的调研尚未开始（毛里塔尼亚和秘鲁），有 4 个国家的调研正在进行之中

（巴巴多斯、文莱达鲁萨兰国、海地和南非），有 4 个国家的调研已经完成（厄瓜多尔、厄立特里亚、菲律宾和泰国）。按要求有 7 个项目向第六十六次会议提交补充情况报告（附件十）。

58. 执行委员会第六十四次会议要求 16 个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划提交情况报告，以确定是否已签署项目文件/谅解备忘录/赠款协定，其中有 14 个现在已签署项目文件/协定。秘书处就最后一个机构的进度报告给出的评论强调了第一个里程碑的重要性。工发组织表示，它仅签署了体制建设的项目文件/协定。秘书处问工发组织如何通知国家委员会的协定以及启动相关活动，从历史角度要求所有机构提供关于何时签署项目文件/协定的资料的意图是什么。所有机构在表述什么时候做好所有必要安排的问题上说法不一。例如，环境规划署称其协定为《小额供资协定》。世界银行有时需要次级赠款协定。工发组织在答复秘书处的问题时表示，它向各国发出信函，通知它们执行委员会的安排/决定。它还告知其氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的工作安排是否已经落实到位。

59. 谨建议执行委员会要求双边和执行机构报告项目文件/协议/小额供资协定的签署情况或何时落实已经核准的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的工作安排。

60. 谨建议执行委员会考虑：

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## Annex I

### **DETAILED ANALYSIS OF THE STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION IN COUNTRIES SUBJECT TO DECISIONS OF THE PARTIES ON COMPLIANCE AND THOSE WHOSE LATEST CONSUMPTION DATA EXCEEDS THE CONTROL MEASURES**

1. Annex I presents the detailed analysis of the status of implementation in countries subject to decisions of the Parties on compliance and those whose latest consumption data exceeds the next control measures. The data tables in Appendices I-VI indicate whether a country has received a total phase-out agreement for a specific controlled substance. The analysis of halons (Appendix II) indicates whether a halon banking activity has been approved. Halon banking guidelines require that regulations facilitating production and import bans are established within six months of the establishment of a reclamation centre (decision 18/22). The methyl bromide analysis (Appendix III) indicates further whether a country has received funding for a phase-out to meet the 2005 control measures. Appendices IV and V present information on the carbon tetrachloride (CTC) and methyl chloroform (TCA) phase-out, respectively. Appendix VI provides information on HCFC consumption only.

#### **ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR CFCs (Appendix I)**

2. Countries have been grouped into one category: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target

3. This category consists of 15 countries, including 6 LVC countries, which may need to achieve additional CFC phase-out amounting to 1,748 ODP tonnes by 2010 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction target.

4. Of the 15 countries, the Executive Committee has approved national CFC phase-out agreements for 14 countries including 6 LVC countries. The remaining country (the United Arab Emirates) has agreed not to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund.

5. Seven of the 15 countries that have 2010 consumption that exceeded zero consumption either have essential use authorizations for CFC consumption (Bangladesh, China, Egypt, India, Iran (Islamic Republic of) and Syrian Arab Republic) as per decision XXI/4 or emergency essential use for CFC-113 2010-2011 consumption as per decision XXII/4 para. 7 (Dominican Republic (the)).

#### **ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR HALONS (Appendix II)**

6. Seventy-five countries have reported no consumption of halons between 1995 and 2010.

7. Sixty-one countries have received support for halon banking activities or phase-out agreements. This includes those countries participating in regional halon banks. Halon banking is presumed to be the last funded activity in the halon consumption sector for most countries but there are some halon phase-out activities that are part of multi-sectoral phase-out agreements.

8. Countries have been grouped into the following one category: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target

9. This category consists of three countries that may need to phase-out additional halons amounting to 5.5 ODP tonnes by 2010 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction targets. These countries

have received support from the Multilateral Fund, except the United Arab Emirates. The United Arab Emirates have agreed not to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund.

### **ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR METHYL BROMIDE (Appendix III)**

10. This section presents the analysis for compliance with methyl bromide control measures. It should be noted that all data reported and used in this analysis relate to controlled use only, which means that the data exclude quarantine and pre-shipment (QPS). 144 of the 145 Article 5 countries that have ratified the Copenhagen Amendment have reported complete baseline data. Of these 145 countries, 57 reported zero for both the baseline consumption and the latest consumption.

11. Ninety-nine Article 5 countries have received support from the Multilateral Fund for methyl bromide activities and/or projects. This includes projects that will lead to a complete phase-out of methyl bromide in 60 of these countries, partial phase-out in an additional 10, and other forms of assistance received by 29.

12. Countries have been grouped into the following two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 20 per cent reduction target of 2005 that applies until December 2014; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix III identifies those countries that have not ratified the Copenhagen Amendment.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 20 per cent MB baseline reduction target

13. This category consists of only one country, Turkmenistan. This country may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 0.02 ODP tonnes in order to comply with the 20 per cent reduction targets. Turkmenistan has approved projects that will lead to complete phase-out of methyl bromide.

(b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 phase-out target

14. This category consists of 30 countries that may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 2,415.4 ODP tonnes by 2015 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction targets. Of the 30 countries, 22 countries have approved projects that will lead to complete phase-out of methyl bromide. Seven countries may need additional assistance from the Multilateral Fund to achieve the phase-out of methyl bromide by 2015. The remaining country (Singapore) is currently not eligible to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund.

### **CARBON TETRACHLORIDE (CTC) (Appendix IV)**

15. This section presents the analysis of compliance with CTC control measures. All data reported and used in this analysis are those related to controlled use only, which excludes feedstock. Reported CTC consumption was not differentiated by specific end use, such as solvents, process agents and laboratory use.

16. Of the 146 countries with reported baseline data, 90 reported zero both for the baseline and the latest consumption.

17. Countries have been grouped into the following one category: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix IV notes those countries that have not ratified the London Amendment.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target

18. This category consists of 5 countries that may need to phase out additional CTC amounting to 480.2 ODP tonnes to meet the 100 per cent reduction by 2010. Four of the 5 countries have received funding for CTC phase-out agreements or projects from the Multilateral Fund. The Republic of Korea has agreed not to receive CTC funding from the Multilateral Fund.

19. Countries with 2010 CTC consumption that exceeded zero consumption have process use exemptions for CTC consumption as per decision XXII/8 (China) or CTC consumption was for laboratory and analytical uses (Croatia, Mexico, Nepal), except Republic of Korea (the).

**METHYL CHLOROFORM (TCA) (Appendix V)**

20. This section presents the analysis for compliance with TCA control measures. Of the 146 countries that have reported baseline data, 103 reported zero both for the baseline and the latest consumption.

21. Countries have been grouped into two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 70 per cent reduction target of 2010; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix V specifies those countries that have not ratified the London Amendment.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 70 per cent TCA baseline reduction target

22. All countries are in compliance with the 70 per cent TCA baseline reduction target.

(b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 100 per cent TCA baseline reduction target

23. This category consists of three countries that may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 76.5 ODP tonnes by 2015 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction target. Two of those three countries have received funding for TCA phase-out agreements or projects from the Multilateral Fund. The remaining country (the Republic of Korea) is not eligible to receive TCA funding from the Multilateral Fund.

**HCFCs (Appendix VI)**

24. Appendix VI also includes an analysis of the latest consumption data on HCFCs and indicates whether the country had received HPMP preparation funding, the number of investment projects approved, the number of demonstration projects approved, total phase-out approved in ODP tonnes and activities planned in the 2011 business plans. All countries have received HPMP preparation funds. Information was provided for HPMPs approved to-date and those submitted to the 65<sup>th</sup> meeting and the duration covered by the HPMP (such as, HPMP approved to achieve the 10 per cent reduction in 2015 or to achieve the 35 per cent reduction in 2020, for example). 121 of the 147 countries already reported both the baseline and the latest consumption.
