拖延项目的执行情况和第5条国家实现遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》  
今后管制措施的前景

## 执行摘要

- 根据 2010 年或 2011 年第 7 条报告的数据和截至 2012 年 3 月 12 日提交的国家方案数据，似乎没有国家出现违约现象；
- 然而，最新的消费数据表明，大多数国家的剩余物质（不包括氟氯烃和豁免使用）实现了零消费，只有 1 个国家报告有氟氯化碳消费（2009 年的数据）；2 个国家报告了 2009 年的哈龙消费情况；29 个国家报告有甲基溴消费；3 个国家报告有甲基氯仿消费；
- 在 2011 年与履约有关的 25 个问题中，根据第 7 条数据已解决了一个问题；根据来自执行机构和臭氧秘书处的信息，2 个被报告为已完成，而 22 个问题尚未报告已完成；
- 有关国家方案执行情况的数据表明：
  - 所有国家均按照五年前核准的新格式提供了数据，但 59 个国家提交了 2010 年使用网络系统的数据，其中只有 5 个国家提交了数据单表；
  - 在第 5 条国家 2011 年 1,057.8 ODP 吨的剩余消耗臭氧层物质消费总估计量（不包括氟氯烃）中，约有 830.3 ODP 吨仍有待执行委员会审议采取行动；
  - 所有 830.3 ODP 吨的剩余消费量是甲基溴消费；
  - 在国家方案数据中，共报告有 506,610 公吨（33,589 ODP 吨）的氟氯烃消费量。对于报告 2009 年和 2010 年数据的 145 个国家，氟氯烃消费量增加了 7.2%；
  - 在报告有关许可制度方面的信息的国家中，144 个国家有报告要求，其中 134 个国家报告称这些制度正在运营中（在 121 个报告了 2010/2011 年数据的国家中，有 113 个国家拥有经营许可制度，其中 97% 运行“令人满意”或“非常好”）；
  - HCFC-22、HCFC-141b 和 HCFC-142b 仍远远没有相关的氟氯化碳昂贵。
- 在 22 个执行拖延的项目中，有 6 个项目已经完成，2 个首次报告为没有进展，1 个可能通过共同协议被取消，11 个建议继续监测。没有收到以色列和西班牙提交的拖延报告；
- 建议针对向本次会议提交情况报告的 33 个项目另提交一份报告，并建议针对 6 项氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的准备活动，提交额外的报告。

## 导言

1. 本文件由四部分组成：

- (a) 第一部分是响应第 32/76(b)和 46/4 号决定编写的，决定请秘书处为执行委员会每次会议编制有关遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》管制措施的第 5 条国家的最新履约情况。
- (b) 第二部分包含遵守各缔约方决定和履约委员会履约建议的第 5 条国家的资料。
- (c) 第三部分提出了关于国家方案执行情况的数据，包括按行业分列的消耗臭氧层物质消费量数据的分析。还包含一部分述及国家消耗臭氧层物质淘汰方案特点的内容。
- (d) 第四部分介绍了有关出现执行拖延及要求提交特别情况报告的项目结果情况。

2. 本文件进行的分析和得出的结论，不妨碍由缔约方会议所确定的履约情况，缔约方会议是唯一得到授权对履约情况进行评估的机构。根据《议定书》第 7 条报告的数据专门用于确定一个国家每年的履约情况。本文件中的分析混合采用了向基金秘书处报告的有关各个履约阶段国家方案执行情况的数据和第 7 条数据。因此，文件本身没有决定履约情况，而是评估了第 5 条国家努力遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》一项或多项管制措施的前景。其主要目的是，确定有待通过多边基金支持的行动加以处理的消耗臭氧层物质。

### 第一部分：履约情况和前景（根据最新获得的数据）

3. 本节介绍了截至 2010 年对氟氯化碳、哈龙和四氯化碳，截至 2015 年对甲基溴和甲基氯仿，<sup>1</sup>以及截至 2013 年冻结时对氟氯烃的最终淘汰管制措施履约情况的分析结果。该分析假设，根据第 7 条或在国家方案数据中所报告的最新消费量已考虑到已完成的、由执行委员会批准的项目的淘汰量。自多边基金启动以来，一直到 2010 年 12 月，已完成的项目淘汰了 235,604 ODP 吨的消费量和 191,246 ODP 吨的生产量。在大约 24.8 亿美元的已核准总额中，已完成的项目估价为 19.8 亿美元。有关该分析所使用的方法的详细说明，见提交执行委员会第三十七次会议的 UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/37/18 号文件。

4. 该分析使用了最新的可用数据。截至 2012 年 3 月 12 日，三个第 5 条国家根据第 7 条报告了 2011 年的数据，141 个国家报告了 2010 年的数据（而 2011 年 3 月，有 145 个国家）。另有一个国家仅向基金秘书处报告了 2011 年有关国家方案执行进展情况的数据（第 17/34 号决定）。对于尚未提交 2011 年或 2010 年数据的国家，在分析中使用了最新可用的消费数据。这涉及到使用两个国家 2009 年根据第 7 条报告的数据。该分析假设，最新报告的、不包括氟氯烃的消耗臭氧层物质的消费水平没有增加，虽然对于没有获取 2010 年或 2011 年数据的两个国家而言这或许不实。

5. 双边和多边执行机构向执行委员会第六十四次会议提交了年度进展报告，其中包含了一直到 2010 年底委员会所核准的所有活动和项目执行情况的数据。有关 2012 年可能核准的数据，已从将在第六十六次会议上应对的《2012-2014 年综合业务计划》（UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/66/7）中提取。

6. 基金秘书处将继续综合以前其用于分析目的的、有关履约情况和前景的报告中所包括的全部数据。一旦提出要求，可提供这些数据。

## 生产行业

7. 在 7 个<sup>2</sup>有氟氯化碳生产设施的第 5 条国家中，阿根廷、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国、印度、墨西哥和委内瑞拉（玻利瓦尔共和国）签有计划削减的协定。氟氯化碳生产行业的所有项目均已完成，但中国报告正在进行中，印度的其余部分虽已提交第六十六次会议获得批准，但尚未被同意。巴西政府表示已自行淘汰了氟氯化碳的生产。关于哈龙生产，中国政府已有一项协定，而印度政府得到了关闭其哈龙生产设施的一次性赠款。

8. 四个国家（巴西、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国和印度）拥有四氯化碳的生产线基准。执行委员会已批准了在 3 个国家（中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国和印度）的生产行业完全淘汰四氯化碳的项目。在第五十四次会议上，批准了巴西的四氯化碳加工剂行业项目。

9. 中国作为仅有的两个拥有甲基溴生产设施的第 5 条国家之一，其甲基溴生产关闭项目已获核准。第二个国家大韩民国没有寻求基金援助。

10. 2009 年或 2010 年，有 6 个国家生产了氟氯烃：阿根廷、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国、印度、墨西哥和委内瑞拉（玻利瓦尔共和国）。生产行业分组将在执行委员会第六十六次会议休会期间其召开的会议上收到来自顾问的、有关中国氟氯烃生产行业技术审计的报告草案。

## 消费行业

11. 该部分概述了对各国似乎违约的程度或在哪些方面其最新消费超出管制措施的详细分析结果。对所有六种控制物质都提供汇总表。该汇总表显示了使用 2010 年数据时没有遵守 2010 年管制措施以及其消费数据超出今后管制措施（包括 2009 年数据）的国家。概述基于附件一所载数据，其中包括按物质分列的各国的详细信息。附件一还说明各国是否已得到预期由多边基金提供的所有援助。

12. 附件一的履约情况评估中还载有关于何时批准了有助于履约的活动及该国是否报告了有关许可制度建立情况的信息。由于核准数据表明了项目或协定已经执行的时间长度，因此，这一信息应使执行委员会能够进一步评估各国的履约前景。此外，有关建立许可制度的信息表明，不管当前的消费水平有多高，管制措施的存在使今后履约成为可能。项目核准的信息取自《已获准的项目清单》。2012 年 3 月 12 日，臭氧秘书处提供了关于建立许可制度的最新资料。

## 氟氯化碳

13. 表 1 概括了各国遵守氟氯化碳管制措施的情况。

14. 也门是最新消费数据超出 2010 年管制措施的唯一国家, 已得到多边基金的支助。

## 哈龙

15. 表 2 概括了各国遵守哈龙管制措施的情况。75 个国家报告在 1995 年至 2010 年期间没有消费哈龙。61 个国家已获得对于哈龙库活动或淘汰协定的支持, 其中包括参与区域哈龙库的国家。

16. 所有最新消费数据超出 2010 年管制措施的国家均得到了多边基金的支助。

## 甲基溴

17. 表 3 概括了各国遵守甲基溴管制措施 (不包括检疫和装运前) 的情况。在 146 个已批准《哥本哈根修正案》的第 5 条国家中, 有 144 个国家已报告完成了基准数据。尚未批准《哥本哈根修正案》的唯一一个第 5 条国家是尼泊尔。在 146 个已批准《哥本哈根修正案》的国家中, 有 57 个国家对基准消费量和最新消费量报告为零。100 个第 5 条国家得到了多边基金对甲基溴淘汰活动和/或项目的支助。

18. 土库曼斯坦是最新消费量超出其 2005 年管制措施的唯一一个国家。土库曼斯坦已批准了将促成完全淘汰甲基溴的项目。

## 四氯化碳

19. 表 4 概括了各国遵守四氯化碳管制措施的情况。所概括的数据不包括原料，也没有区分特定的最终用途（如溶剂和加工剂）。在 146 个已报告基准数据的国家中，有 90 个国家对基准消费量和最新消费量均报告为零。

## 甲基氯仿

20. 表 5 概括了各国遵守甲基氯仿管制措施的情况。在 146 个已报告基准数据的国家中，有 103 个国家的基准消费量和最新消费量均报告为零。

21. 除大韩民国外，所有最新消费数据超出其今后管制措施的国家均得到了多边基金的支助。大韩民国同意不接受多边基金的供资。

## 氟氯烃

22. 附件一的附录六载有对氟氯烃最新消费数据的分析，并指明该国是否得到了编制氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的资金、已批准的投资项目数量、已批准的示范项目数量、已批准的以 ODP 吨表示的总淘汰量，和 2012 年业务计划中所规划的活动。还提供了额外的信息，表明至今已批准的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划、那些提交第六十六次会议的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划，及氟氯烃淘汰管理计划所涵盖的期限（如，已批准的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划在 2015 年实现 10% 的削减量，或者在 2020 年实现 35% 的削减量）。迄今为止，执行委员会已批准 106 个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划协议。

23. 截至 2012 年 3 月 12 日，有 145 个第 5 条国家报告了基准消费量和最新消费量。

24. 除大韩民国、新加坡和阿拉伯联合酋长国，所有国家都得到了氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的项目编制资金。大韩民国和新加坡同意不接受多边基金的供资。阿拉伯联合酋长国在 2012-2014 年的业务计划中规划了各项活动。已得到氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制资金的一个国家（尼泊尔）没有批准《哥本哈根修正案》。批准《哥本哈根修正案》是按照第 53/37 号决定向氟氯烃淘汰管理计划供资的先决条件。

25. 表 6 概括了各国遵守氟氯烃管制措施的情况。

26. 在 75 个国家中，有 53 个国家已得到多边基金对氟氯烃淘汰协定的资助。在其余的 22 个国家中，有 10 个国家已向第六十六次会议提交了氟氯烃淘汰项目，11 个国家尚未提交氟氯烃淘汰管理计划，但在 2012-2014 年的业务计划中规划了氟氯烃的各项活动，大韩民国同意不接受多边基金的氟氯烃供资。

## 第二部分：须遵守缔约方履约决定的国家的执行情况

27. 该部分述及须遵守履约决定的第 5 条国家。

28. 有适用于 23 个国家的、与履约相关的 25 项缔约方决定。根据第 7 条数据已解决了 1 个与履约相关的问题。根据来自执行机构和臭氧秘书处的信息，2 个与履约相关的问题被报告为已完成，而 22 个问题尚未报告已完成。表 7 表明，根据提交给臭氧秘书处和臭氧机构的信息，在执行委员会各项决定方面的进展程度。

## 附件二中的信息

29. 附件二介绍了 2012 年须遵守缔约方履约决定的国家信息。所提供的信息按履约问题和国家编排。附件二还包括题为“执行机构评论意见”和“多边基金基于各机构的初步意见、第 7 条数据和来自臭氧秘书处的信息进行的评估”两个栏目。

## 第三部分：关于国家方案执行情况的数据

30. 第三部分载有在每年的 5 月 1 日之前提交基金秘书处的有关国家方案执行情况的数据，并包括按部分分列的消耗臭氧层物质消费数据。该部分还提供了关于一个国家消耗臭氧层物质淘汰方案特点的额外信息。国家方案的数据报告格式，在执行委员会第三十五次会议的第 35/58(e)号决定中得到批准，并根据第 46/39 和 60/4(b)(iv)号决定进行了修改。

## 按行业分列的消耗臭氧层物质消费数据（除氟氯烃外）

31. 截至 2012 年 3 月 12 日，基金秘书处已从 144 个被要求提交此类报告的国家中收到 3 个国家的 2011 年国家方案执行情况最新报告，118 个国家的 2010 年报告，21 个国家的 2009 年报告和 1 个国家的 2008 年报告。应当指出的是，在分析时，纳米比亚的 2010 年国家方案数据尚未提交。1 个国家从未报告过国家方案数据：南非。南非是唯一有资格从多边基金获取氟氯烃援助的国家。应当指出，体制建设项目的延期取决于收到此类数据的情况。此外，国家方案执行数据必须在本年度最后一次会议和后续会议之前提交，以作为核准和发放项目资金的先决条件。向第六十六次会议提交资金请求的所有国家也提交了 2010 年的国家方案数据。

32. 尽管所记录的消费量水平取自不同年份，还可能未必符合所报告的第 7 条数据，但国家方案数据仍提供了全球范围内按国家分列的最新行业评估。这些数据应协助相关的第 5 条国家和执行委员会评估各行业仍需淘汰的物质。

33. 表 8 按行业分列了要淘汰的剩余消耗臭氧层物质的消费总量（不包括氟氯烃），并考虑到已核准但尚未执行的项目。它还包括了来自己核准但尚未完成的项目的淘汰消费总量。

34. 已核准但尚未执行的消耗臭氧层物质（除氟氯烃之外）削减总量（表 8）不包括针对多边协定原则上批准的数量，或者预期通过执行制冷剂管理计划和哈龙库各项活动而产生的数量。除已获供资的削减，执行委员会原则上批准了根据已实现的计划削减量发放年度付款的行业和国家淘汰项目。

35. 通过未来年度付款实现的削减将解决表 8 中所确定的大量剩余消费量。此外，低消费量国家的制冷剂管理计划占这些国家基准消费和最终淘汰管理计划剩余基准的 85%。然而，已核准但尚未执行的项目数据不计入所有这些吨数。另外，表 8 中已核准但尚未执行的消耗臭氧层物质淘汰量不包括已有哈龙库项目的国家的某些哈龙消费量。

36. （考虑到最终淘汰管理计划和低消费量国家的制冷剂管理计划、哈龙库、全部淘汰项目和原则上批准的多年期协定所表现的淘汰量），仍有待解决的消耗臭氧层物质剩余消费总量（不包括氟氯烃）似乎为 830.3 ODP 吨（表 9）。这个数字少于已报告第六十三次会议的 1,057.8 ODP 吨。

### 氟氯烃数据

37. 表 10 呈现基于最新可用数据的氟氯烃消费水平。该表表明，氟氯烃的消费量为 506,610 公吨（33,589 ODP 吨），主要由 HCFC-22（占总量的 61%）和 HCFC-141b（占总量的 32%）构成。506,610 公吨的氟氯烃表示比报告给第六十三次会议的数量（471,180 公吨）增加了 35,430 公吨。相比之下，截至 2010 年 12 月 31 日，基金已减少 233,087 公吨（244,343 ODP 吨）的消耗臭氧层物质消费量。本报告中的消费水平基于 3 个国家的 2011 年数据，118 个国家的 2010 年数据，21 个国家的 2009 年数据和 1 个国家的 2008 年数据。对于那些既报告 2009 年数据又报告有 2010 年数据的国家而言，氟氯烃消费量已增加了 7.2%。

## 国家方案的特点

38. 第 46/39 号决定通过的、并在第六十次会议（第 60/4(b)(iv)号决定）上订正的国家方案新的报告格式，为国家臭氧机构提供了一个从质和量的角度来评估履约前景的机会。

## 数据的完整性

39. 这是使用新格式报告国家方案数据的第五年。10 个国家仍使用在第四十六次会议上批准的格式提供 2010 年的数据，111 个国家使用在第六十次会议上批准的订正格式。但大部分以新格式提供的数据都不完整，主要表现在三个方面：质量、数量和规范性。仅有 11 个国家，即巴哈马、布基纳法索、科特迪瓦、赤道几内亚、几内亚比绍、肯尼亚、马来西亚、巴拉圭、摩尔多瓦共和国、塞拉利昂和土库曼斯坦针对所有三个方面提供了全部信息。

40. 根据第 59/4(b)(iv)号决定，秘书处审查了使用网络的国家方案执行数据。秘书处注意到，只有 59 个国家使用于 2007 年 4 月 25 日启动的网络系统提交 2010 年的数据，其中只有 5 个国家提交了数据单表；

41. 在被要求的 144 个国家中，只有 118 个国家提供了 2010 年的国家方案数据，有 3 个国家及时提供了 2011 年数据，用于本文件中的分析。除纳米比亚外，向第六十六次会议提交了资金请求的所有国家也提交了 2010 年国家方案数据。

## 数据概要

### 除氟氯烃之外的所有消耗臭氧层物质

42. 在 121 个报告制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的国家中，100 个国家显示有进步，或者完成了对其制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的执行。包括已报告 2010 年以前数据的国家在内，143 个国家中有 119 个国家表示有进步或者完成了对其制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的执行。

43. 包括报告 2010 年以前数据的国家在内，共有 13,267 台回收机和 5,675 台再循环机在运行。在使用回收和再循环机的国家中，75%的国家报告机器运行状况一直“令人满意”或“非常好”。回收的 CFC-11 共计 2,420.4 ODP 吨，其中 2,153.2 ODP 吨得到了再利用；回收的 CFC-12 共计 25,800.2 ODP 吨，其中 21,342.4 ODP 吨得到了再利用。未收集其他消耗臭氧层物质的数据。2006-2011 年报告的最新数据，结合此前数年报告的数据表明，共培训了 61,430 名制冷维修技师，50,210 人已得到认证，并有 2,892 名制冷技师培训人员接受了培训。

44. 在 143 个报告数据（包括来自往年报告的数据）的国家中，有 110 个国家表示已建立配额制度。此外，121 个国家建议需要进行进口商登记。据报告，共有 14,248 名海关官员接受了培训。尚不清楚这是年度数据还是累计数据。

45. 在 144 个有报告要求的国家中，134 个国家已报告了经营许可制度（在报告了 2010/2011 年数据的 121 个国家中，113 个国家拥有经营许可制度，其中 97% 运行情况“令人满意”或“非常好”）。

## 氟氯化碳和氟氯烃及其替代品的价格数据

47. 未提供哈龙、甲基溴或四氯化碳的此种数据。

48. 表 11 表明, 基于这份数据样本, 2010 年, HCFC-22、HCFC-141b 和 HCFC-142b 的价格仍远远低于可比较的氟氯化碳价格。应当注意的是, 只有 14 个国家提供了 CFC-11 价格数据, 32 个国家提供了 CFC-12 价格数据, 且尚不清楚在大多数国家里是否有氟氯化碳销售, 因为此种氟氯化碳库存数量。比如, 关于 HFC-134a 和丙烷 (HC-290), 表 11 中的价格高于各自的氟氯化碳价格, 但是该表没有考虑获取不到氟氯化碳的情况。

## 氟氯烃

49. 这是使用经订正的格式载入第六十次会议核准（第 60/4(b)(iv)号决定）的、有关氟氯烃淘汰情况相关信息的第二年。在 121 个国家中，有 111 个国家使用经订正的格式提供了 2010/2011 年有关氟氯烃的信息。

50. 在报告数据的 137 个国家中，有 64 个国家表示它们已建立了配额制度，98 个国家建议需要进行进口商登记。共回收了 38,697.9 ODP 吨的 HCFC-22，其中 37,841.8 ODP 吨得到再利用。据报告，共有 4,312 名海关官员接受了氟氯烃方面的培训。总数为 1,317 台的回收机和 476 台再循环机在运行中，9,449 名技师已得到认证，18,640 技师得到了培训，且 1,472 名技师培训人员接受了回收和再循环氟氯烃的培训。

### 第四部分：存在执行拖延及需要特殊情况报告的项目

51. 有 22 个正在进行的项目被归于执行拖延项目类别，并被委员会列入项目取消程序。存在执行拖延的项目有：(1) 预计延迟 12 个月以上完成的项目，和/或 (2) 项目获批后 18 个月内未付款的项目。按执行机构和双边机构分列的拖延执行项目细目见以下表 12：工发组织 (7 个)；开发计划署 (6 个)；世界银行 (2 个)；日本 (2 个)；环境规划署 (1 个)；意大利 (1 个) 和葡萄牙 (1 个)。尚未收到以色列 (1 个) 和西班牙 (1 个) 的报告。技术原因是造成拖延的最常见原因。

#### 解决拖延原因过程中取得的进展

52. 执行机构和双边机构在其报告中提出，在克服拖延的过程中取得了不同程度的进展。在第六十五次会议上列出的存在拖延情况的项目中，有 6 个项目现已完成（附件三）。

#### 取得一定进展的项目

53. 有 11 个项目被列入显示“一定进展”的类别，且执行机构和双边机构表示，将继续对这些项目进行监测（附件四）。尽管取得了进展，但应该注意的是，必须依照第 32/4 号决定继续对超过三年前批准的项目进行监测。因此，无论这些项目进展如何，在最终完成之前不能从监测列表中删除。所以建议对这些项目继续进行监测。

*未取得进展-有可能取消的信件的项目*

54. 有 2 个项目自第六十五次会议以来未取得进展（附件五）。按照现有的程序，基金秘书处将基于项目未取得进展的情况发出可能取消的通知。

*可能通过共同协定取消的项目*

55. 有 1 个项目可能通过共同协定被取消（附件六）。

*需提交补充情况报告的项目*

56. 体制建设、哈龙库、海关培训、回收和再循环以及示范项目不受项目取消程序的制约。然而，执行委员会已决定在适当的情况下继续对其进行监测（第 36/14(b)号决定）。执行委员会第六十五次会议上要求提交 56 份补充情况报告。要求提交此类情况报告的条件是，自上一次报告以来没有任何进展迹象，以及/或者报告称执行过程中存在其他障碍。有 23 个项目已取得了进展。对于 33 个有具体原因需要提交补充情况报告的国家，应向第六十七次会议提交补充情况报告（附件七）。

57. 附件显示，仍有一些氟氯化碳活动未签署协议且未购置回收和再循环设备。在项目设备采购中报告未取得进展的四氯化碳项目有 2 个。仍有一些冷却器项目，与国家银行的协议仍在讨论中，项目正被重新设计，正在选择执行项目的顾问，且支付款很低。有几个应提交第六十五次会议的销毁消耗臭氧层物质项目，但直到第六十六次会议尚未提交。有 1 个哈龙库项目连续三次会议的付款仍较低。1 个氟氯烃示范项目和 1 个正在等待签署项目文件的氟氯烃投资项目的付款也较低，而其他氟氯烃项目已取得进展。在 10 个体制建设项目文件签署情况报告中，有 3 个项目尚未签署，5 个项目尚未提供必需的财务报告。期望提交第六十五次会议的 1 个甲基溴项目仍在编制中，1 个项目建议关闭。1 个最终淘汰管理计划和 1 个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的付款较低。

*氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的编制/项目文件签署*

58. 迄今为止，执行委员会已批准了 144 个国家 297 项氟氯烃淘汰管理计划和氟氯烃淘汰项目编制活动，从而使 106 个国家中已批准的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划活动价值为 4.393 亿美元，其中 2.09 亿美元已获准用于第一批年度付款活动。根据在第六十六次会议已经批准的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划和已提交的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划数量，23 个国家将在第六十六次会议之后提交其氟氯烃淘汰管理计划。

59. 在其第六十五次会议上，执行委员会要求针对氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制项目提交补充情况报告。要求提交此类情况报告的条件是，自上一次报告以来没有任何进展迹象，以及/或者报告称执行过程中存在其他障碍。有关的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划处于完成的各个阶段，其中 1 个正在初始的编制阶段，3 个正在进行调查，2 个已经完成调查，1 个已提交给第六十六次会议并应政府核准数据的要求已撤回。有 6 个项目需要向第六十七次会议提交补充情况报告（附件八）。

## Annex I

### **DETAILED ANALYSIS OF THE STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION IN COUNTRIES SUBJECT TO DECISIONS OF THE PARTIES ON COMPLIANCE AND THOSE WHOSE LATEST CONSUMPTION DATA EXCEEDS THE CONTROL MEASURES**

1. Annex I presents the detailed analysis of the status of implementation in countries subject to decisions of the Parties on compliance and those whose latest consumption data exceeds the next control measures. The data tables in Appendices I-VI indicate whether a country has received a total phase-out agreement for a specific controlled substance. The analysis of halons (Appendix II) indicates whether a halon banking activity has been approved. Halon banking guidelines require that regulations facilitating production and import bans are established within six months of the establishment of a reclamation centre (decision 18/22). The methyl bromide analysis (Appendix III) indicates further whether a country has received funding for a phase-out to meet the 2005 control measures. Appendices IV and V present information on the carbon tetrachloride (CTC) and methyl chloroform (TCA) phase-out, respectively. Appendix VI provides information on HCFC consumption only.

#### **ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR CFCs (Appendix I)**

2. Countries have been grouped into one category: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target

3. This category consists of 8 countries which may need to achieve additional CFC phase-out amounting to 1,702 ODP tonnes by 2010 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction target.

4. The Executive Committee has approved national CFC phase-out agreements for all of these countries.

5. Seven of the 8 countries that have 2010 consumption that exceeded zero consumption either have essential use authorizations for CFC consumption (Bangladesh, China, Egypt, India, Iran (Islamic Republic of) and Syrian Arab Republic) as per decision XXI/4 or emergency essential use for CFC-113 2010-2011 consumption as per decision XXII/4 para. 7 (Dominican Republic (the)).

#### **ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR HALONS (Appendix II)**

6. Seventy-five countries have reported no consumption of halons between 1995 and 2010.

7. Sixty-one countries have received support for halon banking activities or phase-out agreements. This includes those countries participating in regional halon banks. Halon banking is presumed to be the last funded activity in the halon consumption sector for most countries but there are some halon phase-out activities that are part of multi-sectoral phase-out agreements.

8. Countries have been grouped into the following one category: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target

9. This category consists of two countries that may need to phase-out additional halons amounting to 3 ODP tonnes by 2010 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction targets. These countries have received support from the Multilateral Fund.

### **ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR METHYL BROMIDE (Appendix III)**

10. This section presents the analysis for compliance with methyl bromide control measures. It should be noted that all data reported and used in this analysis relate to controlled use only, which means that the data exclude quarantine and pre-shipment (QPS). 144 of the 146 Article 5 countries that have ratified the Copenhagen Amendment have reported complete baseline data. Of these 146 countries, 57 reported zero for both the baseline consumption and the latest consumption.

11. One-hundred Article 5 countries have received support from the Multilateral Fund for methyl bromide activities and/or projects. This includes projects that will lead to a complete phase-out of methyl bromide in 63 of these countries, partial phase-out in an additional 8, and other forms of assistance received by 29.

12. Countries have been grouped into the following two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 20 per cent reduction target of 2005 that applies until December 2014; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix III identifies those countries that have not ratified the Copenhagen Amendment.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 20 per cent MB baseline reduction target

13. This category consists of only one country, Turkmenistan. This country may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 0.02 ODP tonnes in order to comply with the 20 per cent reduction targets. Turkmenistan has approved projects that will lead to complete phase-out of methyl bromide.

(b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 phase-out target

14. This category consists of 29 countries that may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 2,456.4 ODP tonnes by 2015 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction targets. Of the 29 countries, 24 countries have approved projects that will lead to complete phase-out of methyl bromide. Four countries may need additional assistance from the Multilateral Fund to achieve the phase-out of methyl bromide by 2015. The remaining country (Singapore) is currently not eligible to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund.

### **CARBON TETRACHLORIDE (CTC) (Appendix IV)**

15. This section presents the analysis of compliance with CTC control measures. All data reported and used in this analysis are those related to controlled use only, which excludes feedstock. Reported CTC consumption was not differentiated by specific end use, such as solvents, process agents and laboratory use.

16. Of the 146 countries with reported baseline data, 90 reported zero both for the baseline and the latest consumption.

17. Countries have been grouped into the following one category: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix IV notes those countries that have not ratified the London Amendment.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target

18. This category consists of 5 countries that may need to phase out additional CTC amounting to 283 ODP tonnes to meet the 100 per cent reduction by 2010. Four of the 5 countries have received

funding for CTC phase-out agreements or projects from the Multilateral Fund. The Republic of Korea has agreed not to receive CTC funding from the Multilateral Fund.

19. Countries with 2010 CTC consumption that exceeded zero consumption have process agent use exemptions for CTC consumption as per decision XXII/8 (China) or CTC consumption for laboratory and analytical uses (Croatia, Mexico, Nepal), except Republic of Korea (the).

#### **METHYL CHLOROFORM (TCA) (Appendix V)**

20. This section presents the analysis for compliance with TCA control measures. Of the 146 countries that have reported baseline data, 103 reported zero both for the baseline and the latest consumption.

21. Countries have been grouped into two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 70 per cent reduction target of 2010; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix V specifies those countries that have not ratified the London Amendment.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 70 per cent TCA baseline reduction target

22. All countries are in compliance with the 70 per cent TCA baseline reduction target.

(b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 100 per cent TCA baseline reduction target

23. This category consists of three countries that may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 76.5 ODP tonnes by 2015 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction target. Two of those three countries have received funding for TCA phase-out agreements or projects from the Multilateral Fund. The remaining country (the Republic of Korea) is not eligible to receive TCA funding from the Multilateral Fund.

#### **HCFCs (Appendix VI)**

24. Appendix VI also includes an analysis of the latest consumption and baseline data on HCFCs and indicates whether the country had received HPMP preparation funding, the number of investment projects approved, the number of demonstration projects approved, total phase-out approved in ODP tonnes and activities planned in the 2012 business plans. 145 of the 147 countries already reported both the baseline and the latest consumption.

25. All countries have received HPMP project preparation funds except the Republic of Korea, Singapore and the United Arab Emirates. The Republic of Korea and Singapore had agreed not to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund. The United Arab Emirates has activities planned in the 2012-2014 business plans.

(a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the freeze reduction target

26. This category consists of 75 countries that may need to phase out additional HCFC amounting to 1,483 ODP tonnes to meet the freeze reduction target by 2013.

27. 53 of the 75 countries have received funding for HCFC phase-out agreements from the Multilateral Fund. Of the 22 remaining countries, 10 countries have submitted HCFC phase-out projects to the 66<sup>th</sup> meeting, 11 countries have activities planned in the 2012-2014 business plans and the Republic of Korea has agreed not to receive HCFC funding from the Multilateral Fund.

**CFC ANALYSIS**
