Addendum

2012-2014 BUSINESS PLANS AND ANNUAL TRANCHE SUBMISSION DELAYS

This addendum is provided to update the recommended/reviewed funding values compared to the values in the business plans following the completion of project review and the associated draft agreements for the HCFC phase-out management plans (HPMPs).

Replace Table 3 and paragraph 9 with the following:

Submissions after review to the 67th meeting include project values amounting to US \$91,641,646 9. (including US \$248,092 that was not in the business plans), which is above the amount included for them in the 2012 business plans by US \$48.15 million. This is due largely to the HCFC production sector

in China for which the US \$70 million requested in 2012, excluding agency fees, exceeds the business plan allocation of US \$26.4 million by US \$43.6 million.

9(bis). The submissions not included in the business plans are HCFC activities. These cover: an HPMP in one low-volume-consuming (LVC) country (Eritrea) where only UNIDO was listed in the business plans as the implementing agency and UNEP is now covering the non-investment components; an HPMP in one LVC country (United Republic of Tanzania (the)) where only UNEP was listed in the business plans as the implementing agency and UNIDO is now requesting the investment components; and an HCFC investment project for the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia by UNIDO.

• **Replace** paragraph 10 **and** Table 4 **with** the following:

10. Table 4 presents, by agency, the value of accounts included in the 2012 business plans and the balance of funds from projects in the 2012 business plans, which have not been submitted. Table 4 is updated based on the Secretariat's recommendations to the 67th meeting.

- 15. Submissions to the 67th meeting include project values amounting to US \$343,385,384, which is above the funding level included for them in the 2012-2014 business plans by US \$214,259,345. This is due largely to the HCFC production sector in China for which US \$210 million of the total US \$280 million requested, excluding agency fees, exceeds the business plan allocation of US \$79.5 million by US \$200.5 million.
- Add paragraphs 16 (bis) and 16 (ter) and Table 6a under the section on Forward commitments as follows:

16 (bis). Forward commitments *inter alia* consist of funding for multi-year agreements (MYAs) and "other standard activities" such as institutional strengthening, budget of the Fund Secretariat, Treasurer and Executive Committee meeting costs, UNEP's Compliance Assistance Programme (CAP), and the core unit costs for UNDP, UNIDO and the World Bank. Funding for "other standard activities" is based on the 2012-2014 business plans taking into consideration the decisions from the 66th meeting of the Executive Committee.

16 (ter). Table 6a presents the total amount of forward commitments assuming that the requests submitted to the 67th meeting are approved at the levels recommended following review by the Secretariat (e.g., this does not contain the production sector request from China since there is no recommendation). If the requests are approved at the levels recommended to the 67th meeting after review, an additional US \$34.6 million would be needed to cover forward commitments. The total amount of existing commitments for the period 2012 to 2031 is US \$346.8 million.
