#### Note on the organization of the document

1. This document provides an overview of requests from bilateral agencies, and whether these are eligible for approval by the Executive Committee in light of the maximum level of bilateral cooperation available for 2013. It cross-references relevant meeting documents that include a discussion on the bilateral requests, and contains the standard recommendation on the year of assignment for bilateral cooperation.

#### Introduction

2. Only one project for bilateral cooperation with a value of US \$438,036 (including agency fees) has been received by the Secretariat for approval at the 69<sup>th</sup> meeting from the Government of Germany as shown in Table 1.

Pre-session documents of the Executive Committee of the Multilateral Fund for the Implementation of the Montreal Protocol are without prejudice to any decision that the Executive Committee might take following issuance of the document.

#### Introduction

3. Table 2 provides a summary of the request for bilateral co-operation from the Government of Germany. The value of this request (US \$438,036), combined with the amount of US \$1,501,405 and US \$3,554,902 approved at the  $66^{th}$  and  $68^{th}$  meetings, respectively, does not exceed Germany's 2012-2014 bilateral contribution for the triennium (US \$8,182,837).
