REPORT ON BALANCES AND AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES

Introduction

1. This document presents a summary of financial adjustments indicated by the bilateral and implementing agencies (IAs) as agreed by the Secretariat. It includes statistical data¹, as required by decisions 28/7 and 56/2(c), from projects for bilateral and IAs with balances that have been held for over the allowable 12-month period following completion of the project. It also addresses balances to be returned against projects as a follow-up to decisions 70/7(b)(ii) and (iii) and 71/11(b) referred to as “by-decision projects” in this document. Further to decision 41/92(b), this document also indicates the level of resources available to the Executive Committee in cash and promissory notes as recorded in the status of contributions and disbursements document².

Funds to be returned to the 72nd meeting

3. The total funds to be returned amount to US \$4,450,778 (i.e., US \$4,443,674 by the IAs and US \$7,104 by bilateral agencies) from completed projects and by-decision projects.

Funds to be returned to the 72nd meeting by IAs

4. A total of US \$1,589,391, plus US \$133,798 agency support costs will be returned from completed projects, and US \$2,490,466, plus US \$230,019 agency support costs will be returned from by-decision projects as shown in Table 1.

5. Table 2 presents the number of both completed projects and by-decision projects with balances to be returned by decisions that are still being withheld by the IAs. Three of the four IAs have projects that were completed over two years ago with remaining balances³; and all IAs have by-decision projects with remaining balances that should have been returned at the end of 2013.

6. The following observations are relevant on completed projects over two years:
- UNDP balance for projects completed has decreased from US \$94,141 to US \$8,332. UNDP is working to financially complete the 10 projects operationally completed in 2011 and would return US \$8,332 to the 73rd meeting;
 - UNEP has the largest number of completed projects over two years. UNEP is the only agency with unobligated balances (US \$65,608 on 11 projects against cash advances to UNDP and the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) waiting for interoffice vouchers). These balances could not be obligated but should remain available to absorb future invoices. UNEP intends to return these un-obligated balances when the projects are financially completed;
 - UNIDO has financially completed all projects in 2009 and 2010. While UNIDO had reported at the 71st meeting that it would close the project in China (CPR/PRO/INV/436) by the 72nd meeting, during the review process UNIDO overlooked an on-going contract on technical assistance for which the final payment is scheduled in December 2015. Therefore, UNIDO is requesting the reinstatement of the project to on-going status; and
 - The World Bank does not have projects over two years old but holds US \$2,106,228 in obligated balances for one on-going project.
7. The following observations are relevant on by-decision projects:
- All IAs indicated that return of balances against some of the by-decision projects to the 72nd meeting requires updated financial data that would not be available before the preparation and submission of the 2013 progress reports due in 1 May 2014;
 - Both UNEP and UNIDO indicated that operationally ongoing projects are exposed to possible future unforeseen financial charges (e.g., late receipts from UNDP local offices, claims, currency exchange differences) that are unpredictable at the time of operational closure. For this reason, the balances are considered committed after operational completion to ensure that any such charges can be accommodated in line with United Nations financial rules;
 - UNEP also evoked the constraint of the 2013 final accounts not yet closed at the time of the request to return balances on on-going projects as well as the administrative burden of financial closure of on-going projects; and
 - UNIDO explained that as per decision 66/42(h), the funding remaining of US \$800,000 from the NPP for Argentina was reallocated to the HPMP; therefore, no funds will be returned for two projects (ARG/PHA/50/INV/150 and ARG/PHA/53/INV/152). The project in Guatemala (GUA/FUM/59/INV/38) is an on-going project for which partial funds are being returned in response to decision 71/7(a)(iii). As per decision 65/47(d) the Government of Uruguay could submit an investment project to phase out the use of HCFC-22 in the refrigeration manufacturing assembly of cold rooms during the implementation of stage I of the HPMP; therefore, no funds will be returned for the project (URU/REF/60/PRP/55).

8. The Secretariat requested all IAs to provide financial information on on-going projects for which returns are due by decisions as soon as soon financial information is updated from the progress reports to be submitted on 1 May 2014, with a view to return these balance to the 72nd meeting. The Secretariat also requested IAs to fill an obligation review form if balances on by-decision projects would not be returned to the 72nd or 73rd meeting.

Funds to be returned to the 72nd meeting by bilateral agencies

9. Table 3 provides the information on returns of balances from projects completed by the Governments of Italy and Japan.

11. The Government of France advised that it can return balances of two projects completed over 2 year ago in 2014. As per decision 71/10(d)(ii), the Government of France will return remaining balances for the regional project in Africa (AFR/REF/48/DEM/36) no later than the first meeting in 2015. The Government of France is verifying expenses for two projects in the Lao People's Democratic Republic (LAO/PHA/54/INV/18 and LAO/PHA/61/INV/21) for closure of accounts within the French Development Agency (AFD) and will indicate the final amount when the progress report is submitted.

12. The Government of Italy advised that it is returning the balance of one project completed in Mexico (MEX/FUM/54/INV/137) to the 72nd meeting, and has one completed project over 2 years old.

13. The Government of Japan advised that it will return the balances for one completed project over 2 years old to the 72nd meeting, but will not return funds from by-decision projects.

Availability of resources

14. The status of contributions and disbursements indicates an available balance amounting to US \$61,280,299 as at 11 April 2014. The total net balance returned by IAs, including agency support costs, is US \$4,443,674. The total level of resources available for approvals by the Executive Committee at its 72nd meeting, after taking into account the Fund's balance as contained in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/72/3 and the total amount returned by IAs agencies is US \$65,723,973.

SECRETARIAT'S COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

COMMENTS

15. During the Inter-agency coordination meeting held in Montreal 11 to 13 February 2014, the Secretariat re-stressed the need for closing all on-going projects not related to HCFCs or methyl bromide (e.g., CFC phase-out plans) and returning all the balances associated with completed projects.

16. UNEP's return of balances (US \$989,100 including supporting costs) on completed projects relates mainly to the 2013 Compliance Assistance Programme (CAP) (GLO/SEV/68/TAS/315). Only UNEP and UNIDO returned funds from the by-decision projects as follows: UNIDO, US \$1,705,511 (excluding agency support costs) against 17 projects; and UNEP, US \$784,955 (excluding programme support costs) against 34 projects.

17. Balances returned from by-decision projects related to project preparation for stage I of HPMPs amount to US \$1,041,618 including agency support costs. These balances are distributed as follows: UNDP, US \$291,280 against 18 projects; UNEP, US \$674,441 against 53 projects; and UNIDO, US \$75,897 against 15 projects. The outstanding balances are: 15 projects for UNDP, 18 for UNEP, 12 for UNIDO and 2 for the World Bank.

18. Considering that the total level of funding for projects and activities as submitted to the 72nd meeting amounts to US \$48,024,779, including support costs, as of the finalizing of this document there are sufficient resources available for approvals at the 72nd meeting, as well as for the Fund Secretariat's and Senior Monitoring and Evaluation Officer's budgets.

RECOMMENDATIONS

19. The Executive Committee may wish:

(a) To note:

- (i) The report on balances and availability of resources contained in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/72/4;
- (ii) That the net level of funds being returned by the implementing agencies to the 72nd meeting was US \$1,589,391 against completed projects, which included the return of US \$377,453 from UNDP, US \$1,088,529 from UNEP, and US \$123,409 from UNIDO;
- (iii) That the net level of funds being returned by the implementing agencies to the 72nd meeting was US \$2,490,466 against by-decision projects, which included the return of US \$784,955 from UNEP, and US \$1,705,511 from UNIDO;
- (iv) That the net level of support costs being returned by the implementing agencies to the 72nd meeting was US \$133,798 against completed projects,

which included the return of US \$28,823 from UNDP, US \$95,717 from UNEP, and US \$9,258 from UNIDO;

- (v) That the net level of support costs being returned by the implementing agencies to the 72nd meeting was US \$230,019 against by-decision projects, which included the return of \$102,045 from UNEP, and US \$127,974 from UNIDO;
 - (vi) That implementing agencies had balances totalling US \$307,766, excluding support costs, from projects completed over two years previously, which included US \$8,332 for UNDP, US \$138,187 for UNEP and US \$161,247 for UNIDO;
 - (vii) That UNDP is working to financially close the 10 projects operationally completed in 2011 and intends to return the balances of US \$8,332 to the 73rd meeting;
 - (viii) That the Government of France has balances for two completed projects over two years previously not returned to the Fund, totaling US \$308,920, excluding support costs and that these balances would be returned in 2014;
 - (ix) That the Government of Italy has balances for one completed projects over two years previously not returned to the Fund, totaling US \$2,677, excluding support costs;
 - (x) That the net level of funds and support costs being returned by the bilateral agencies to the 72nd meeting is US \$7,104, which included the return of US \$6,725 from the Government of Italy and US \$379 from the Government of Japan which will be offset against future projects; and
 - (xi) That UNIDO has requested the project in China (CPR/PRO/INV/436) be reinstated as an “on-going” due to an on-going contract on technical assistance for which the final payment is scheduled in December 2015; and
- (b) To request:
- (i) Implementing agencies with projects completed over two years previously to return the balances as soon as possible;
 - (ii) Implementing agencies to update information on balances against by-decision projects before the 72nd meeting to provide an update on the return on balances to the 72nd meeting; and
 - (iii) UNEP to return all un-obligated balances to the 73rd meeting.
