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执行蒙特利尔议定书 多边基金执行委员会 第七十七次会议 2016年11月28日至12月2日,蒙特利尔

#### 项目审查期间确定的问题概览

- 1. 本文件由以下部分组成:
  - (a) 对双边和执行机构向第七十七次会议提交的项目和活动数目的分析;
  - (b) 项目审查期间查明的问题:
    - (一) 执行核准的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的执行机构的变动或增加:
    - (二) 提出核查报告和满足具体条件之前留置的资金;
    - (三) 获得资金转用低全球升温潜能值替代品的企业临时制造高全球升温潜能值的制冷和空调设备:
  - (c) 提交一揽子核准的项目和活动;
  - (d) 供单独审议的投资项目。

#### 双边和执行机构提交的项目和活动

- 2. 双边和执行机构向第七十七次会议提交了 170 项为核准的多年期协定、项目和活动付款的供资申请,金额为 170,483,133 美元(975,440,206 美元包括原则上申请的金额),并视情况包括机构支助费用。供资申请包括:
  - (a) 非低消费量国家的 7 个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段和低消费量国家的 2 个氟 氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段;
  - (b) 一个低消费量国家的一个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第一阶段:

- (c) 28 个国家的已核准氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的付款;
- (d) 35 个国家机构强化项目的延长:
- (e) 3个国家氟氯烃淘汰管理计划/氟氯烃淘汰投资活动第二阶段的项目编制
- 3. 项目经审查之后,建议一揽子核准 77 个项目和活动,共计 8,241,271 美元,包括支助费用;正在递交 XX 项目和活动,共计 149,690,219 美元 (678,515,829 美元中包括原则上申请的数额),供单独审议。申请一揽子核准和单独审议的项目加在一起共计157,931,490 美元。

#### 延长机构强化项目的申请

4. 秘书处根据相关决定,审查了 34 个国家的最终报告和延长机构强化项目的申请,这些决定包括:关于机构强化项目和延长的供资金额的第 74/51 号决定(c)段和关于将绩效指标纳入规划活动的必要性的第 74/51 号决定(e)段。所有申请都对照下列文件反复核对:以往的历次机构强化报告;关于国家方案执行情况的进展报告;根据《蒙特利尔议定书》第 7条报告的数据;关于氟氯烃淘汰管理计划执行情况的最新报告;双边和执行机构提交第七十七次会议的进展报告;以及蒙特利尔议定书缔约方通过的关于履约的相关决定。

#### 已提交但嗣后撤回的项目和活动

- 5. 在项目审查过程中,无法及时处理与埃及、肯尼亚和东帝汶氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段和布基纳法索氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第一阶段(第三次付款)有关的问题(费用为7,869,944美元),因此,由相关牵头执行机构撤回:
  - (a) 埃及氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段被撤回,是为了进一步分析有资格获得供资的 HCFC-141b 和进口预混多元醇中所含 HCFC-141b 的剩余消费量,以及进一步评估因技术选择带来的不确定性而在空调制造业产生的增量成本;
  - (b) 肯尼亚氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段因与该国氟氯烃消费许可证和配额制度有 关的问题而被撤回,指出该国政府已提出要采取一系列措施,通过氟氯烃淘汰 管理计划第一阶段的项目活动,在不久的将来加强该制度;
  - (c) 东帝汶氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段被撤回的原因是,氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第一阶段的执行工作没有取得重大进展;
  - (d) 撤回布基纳法索氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第一阶段的付款申请¹的原因是,没有提交 2013、2014 和 2015 年氟氯烃消费量核查报告,以及没有处理与氟氯烃消费量大幅波动有关,从而有可能对氟氯烃消费量持续总体削减的起点进行调整的问题。

#### 项目审查期间查明的问题

6. 在项目审查过程中,秘书处查明了需要执行委员会提供指导的若干问题。

#### 执行核准的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的执行机构的变动或增加

- 7. 秘书处收到了关于作为氟氯烃淘汰管理计划付款申请的一部分增加一个双边或执行机构的请求。 在某些情况下,需要更改机构以解决实施期间遇到的具体问题(例如,在第七十五次会议上,环境规划署把为朝鲜民主主义人民共和国开展的活动和供资转交给了工发组织,原因是环境规划署在将核准的供资交给该国方面受到制约),而在另一些情况下,则是由于受益国愿意与特定机构合作(例如,在本次会议上提出了关于在执行墨西哥氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段第二次付款和以后各次付款时加上西班牙政府的请求)。
- 8. 虽然机构变更或增加新机构并不影响将要执行的活动,也不影响氟氯烃淘汰管理计划 核准的资金数额(不包括机构支助费用),但需要对协定进行调整,以将新机构包括在内, 秘书处往往建议将其付款申请交由执行委员会单独审议。
- 9. 注意到为执行氟氯烃淘汰管理计划而更改或增加一个机构往往不产生任何问题,执行委员会不妨请秘书处考虑对这类申请进行一揽子核准,除非除此变化之外还有未决问题需要执委会审议。

#### 提交核查报告或满足具体条件之前留置的资金

- 10. 在第七十六次会议上,执行委员会核准了几个氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的付款,但有一项谅解,即财务主任将扣留资金,直到有关执行机构提交了下列文件: 氟氯烃消费量核查报告(不丹、柬埔寨、乍得、刚果、海地 、巴基斯坦、圣多美和普林西比和南非); 政府与环境规划署之间签署协定的确认书(智利、危地马拉和洪都拉斯); 或氟氯烃消费量核查报告和已经创造了第 72/32(b)号决定所要求的安全使用碳氢化合物制冷剂的监管环境的确认书(加纳)。
- 11. 在该次会议之后,秘书处收到了不丹、柬埔寨、乍得、刚果和巴基斯坦的令人满意的核查报告,并确认危地马拉政府与环境规划署之间签署了协议。 因此,财务主任向执行机构发放了核准的资金。
- 12. 截至 2016 年 10 月底,尚未提交有关海地(环境规划署)、圣多美和普林西比(环境规划署)及南非(工发组织)的核查报告,环境规划署也未提供与智利和洪都拉斯签署协定的确认书。 就加纳而言,已收到核查报告,但仍需确认是否满足了第 72/32(b)号决定规定的条件。
- 13. 注意到转拨已核准资金的条件应在第七十六次会议之后不久达成,而且与已核准付款有关的活动要在资金转入执行机构之后才能开始,执行委员会不妨敦促环境规划署、工发组织以及海地、圣多美和普林西比及南非政府尽快提交氟氯烃消费量核查报告;环境规划署与智利和洪都拉斯政府尽快签署执行氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的协定;开发计划署和加纳政府尽快执行第72/32(b)号决定,以便不再拖延地开展活动。

同意转用低全球升温潜能值替代品的企业临时制造基于高全球升温潜能值的制冷和空调设备

- 14. 在审查核查报告和在监测和评价下对制冷和空调制造行业进行评价的过程中,秘书处关切地注意到,几个同意转用低全球升温潜能值替代品的制冷和空调制造企业正在利用改装的生产线制造基于高全球升温潜能值的设备。中国的工业和商业制冷行业(HFC-32 技术)、印度尼西亚(HFC-32 技术)和塞尔维亚(氨、氨和二氧化碳/碳氢化合物级联系统)就存在这方面的例子。 特别是,参与这些项目的企业已经安装了制造采用商定的技术的制冷和空调机组所需的设备,但却临时使用这些设备来制造高全球升温潜能值设备。
- 15. 给出的主要理由是企业无法在市场上出售这些设备,原因如下:缺乏安全标准、维修技术人员提出关切、成本高于高全球升温潜能值设备,消费者的接受度不高,某类产品可用的压缩机有限,以及其他因素。如果在采用某些技术时没有考虑到市场的可行性,推行禁止在制造业中使用氟氯烃的国家法规也可能会影响企业的业务连续性。
- 16. 虽然拥有许多生产线的大型企业也许能够通过增加其他生产线上的生产来抵消空闲的生产线,同时等待机会将利用商定的技术的设备销售到市场,但如果中小型企业的制造能力一直被闲置,其财务维持能力就会受到危害。鉴于设备已经安装在改装了的生产线上,据指出,一旦企业能够在市场上出售这种设备,企业就可以无缝地转换到制造采用最初提出的低全球升温潜能值技术的设备。
- 17. 由于多边基金的援助是根据企业选定的特定技术,并在考虑相关环境影响(项目提案中计算的消耗臭氧层物质淘汰和气候影响)后进行计算与核准的,秘书处认为、同意转用低全球升温潜能值技术的企业必须根据最初提出的技术制造设备。同时,秘书处认为必须适当考虑企业的财务可持续性。
- 18. 此外,秘书处指出,不得利用增支经营费用支付除商定的技术以外的任何其他技术。在本文件印发时,秘书处正在确认在秘书处知道的那些案例中没有支付增支经营费用。
- 19. 秘书处指出,就室内空调行业而言,中国似乎正在建立一种有效的机制,利用增支经营费用,鼓励将获取的采用商定的技术的设备投放到市场。其他第 5 条缔约方不妨考虑是否可以利用类似的机制,同时应考虑到各自的国情。

#### 建议

- - (a) 如有企业已经获得了制造低全球变暖潜能值设备的资金,却在一条生产线上临时生产高全球变暖潜能值设备,一旦查明,就应立即报告。该报告应包括使用高全球升温潜能值替代品的原因,政府(如果适当的话包括企业)为使企业能够开始制造采用最初提出的低全球升温潜能值的设备而将采取的步骤,以及预计开始制造这些设备的时间表:
  - (b) 继续向执行委员会每次会议报告在企业改装的生产线上使用高全球升温潜能值 替代品的状况,直到在改装的生产线上只能生产利用原先提出的低全球升温潜 能值技术的设备;

(c) 支付增支经营费用只能用于制造利用原先提出的低全球升温潜能值技术的设备。

#### 提交一揽子核准的项目和活动

#### 提交一揽子核准的项目和活动

21. 本文件附件一列出了 77 个建议供一揽子核准的项目和活动,共计 8 241 271 美元,其中包括支助费用。执行委员会核准的这些项目将包括相应的项目评价表中的相关条件或规定,以及核准与多年期项目付款有关的执行方案。

#### 供单独审议的投资项目

22. 有 71 个项目/活动建议经秘书处审查后提交单独审议,费用共计 149,690,219 美元 (678,515,829 美元包括原则上申请的数额),包括支助费用。 为便于执行委员会审议供单独审议的投资项目,秘书处按行业对项目进行了分类,并按问题对其进行分组,如表 1 所示。
