REPORT ON BALANCES AND AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES

Introduction

1. This document presents a summary of financial adjustments indicated by the bilateral (BAs) and implementing agencies (IAs) as agreed by the Secretariat. It includes statistical data¹ from all projects with balances that have been held for over 12-month following completion of the project, as required by decisions 28/7 and 56/2(c). It addresses balances to be returned against projects as a follow-up to relevant Executive Committee's decisions (referred to as "by-decision" projects in this document). It indicates the level of resources available to the Executive Committee in cash and promissory notes as recorded in the status of contributions and disbursements document², as required by decision 41/92(b), and presents a recommendation.

2. This document also contains the following three annexes:

Annex I Amounts held by IAs and BAs for completed projects

Annex II Amounts held by IAs and BAs for by-decision projects

Annex III Fund returns by IAs and BAs from completed and by-decision projects

Funds to be returned to the 81st meeting

3. The total funds to be returned amount to US \$833,355 (i.e. US \$740,597 by BAs and US \$91,055 by IAs from completed and by-decision projects, and US \$1,703 interest by BA). Annexes I and II provide explanations on the delays in disbursing committed amounts or returning not-committed amounts.

8. With regard to balances held by BAs:

- (a) The Government of France has a committed balance of US \$14,854 including agency support costs for one by-decision project to be completed in December 2018;
- (b) The Government of Japan has a committed balance of US \$713,678 and a not-committed balance of US \$1,738 including agency support costs for one completed and two by-decisions projects, respectively; and
- (c) The Government of Spain has a not-committed balance of US \$28,416 including agency support costs for one by-decision project.

Availability of resources

9. The status of contributions and disbursements document³ indicates an available balance amounting to US \$98,089,250 as at 25 May 2018. The total net balance returned by BAs and IAs, including agency support costs and interest is US \$833,355. The total level of resources available for approvals by the Executive Committee at the 81st meeting, after taking into account the Fund's balance and the total amount returned by IAs is US \$98,922,605.

Secretariat's comments

10. During the Inter-agency Coordination Meeting⁴, the Secretariat reminded BAs and IAs that balances associated with completed projects and by-decisions projects that are due should be returned to the Multilateral Fund no later than the 81^{st} meeting. BAs and IAs committed to continue with their efforts to return funds as soon as possible, and to provide an update to the 81^{st} meeting with a view to returning additional balances.

11. Considering that the total level of funding for projects and activities as submitted to the 81st meeting, amounts to US \$94,120,556 including agency support costs⁵, there are sufficient resources available for approvals at the 81st meeting.

Recommendations

- 12. The Executive Committee may wish:
 - (a) To note:
 - (i) The report on balances and availability of resources contained in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/81/4;
 - (ii) That the net level of funds being returned to the 81st meeting by the implementing agencies was US \$91,055, consisting of US \$10,467, plus agency support costs of US \$802 from UNDP; US -\$52,867, plus agency support costs of US -\$1,418 from UNEP; and US \$124,964, plus agency support costs of US \$9,107 from UNIDO;
 - (iii) That UNEP held balances of US \$158,200 in not-committed balances, including agency support costs, for one project completed over two years previously;
 - (iv) That UNIDO held US \$36,983 in committed balances, including agency support costs, for one project completed two years previously;
 - (v) That the net level of funds and support costs being returned by the bilateral agencies to the 81st meeting was US \$740,597, which included the return of US \$1,462 from the Government of Canada; US \$282,500 from the Government of France; and US \$456,635 from the Government of Japan;
 - (vi) The Government of Canada's return of accrued interest of US \$1,703 for the project MEX/FUM/54/INV/138 which would be considered additional income to the Fund;
 - (vii) That the Government of France held US \$14,854 in committed balances, including agency support costs, for one "by-decision" project.
 - (viii) That the Government of Japan held balances of US \$715,416, consisting of US \$713,678 and US \$1,738 including agency support costs, in committed and not-committed balances, respectively, for one project completed over two years previously and two projects completed "by-decision of the Executive Committee" respectively.
 - (ix) That the Government of Spain held US \$28,416 in not-committed balances, including agency support costs, for one "by-decision" project.
 - (b) To request:
 - (i) The Government of Japan, UNEP, and UNIDO to return, no later than the 82nd meeting, the balances of all projects completed over two years previously;
 - Bilateral and implementing agencies to disburse or cancel commitments not needed for completed projects and projects completed "by-decision of the Executive Committee" and to return balances to the 82nd meeting;
 - (iii) The Governments of Japan and Spain, and UNEP to return to the 82nd meeting not-committed balance no longer required for future projects;

- (iv) The Treasurer to follow-up with the Governments of Canada, France and Japan on the return, in cash, of US \$740,597 as per sub-paragraph (a)(v) above; and
- (v) The Treasurer to offset US \$5,275 against the Government of Canada's approvals at the 81st meeting in line with Annex IX of document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/68/53.
