REPORT ON BALANCES AND AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES

Introduction

- 1. This document presents a summary of financial adjustments indicated by the bilateral (BAs) and implementing agencies (IAs) as agreed by the Secretariat. It includes statistical data¹ from all projects with balances that have been held for over 12 months following completion of the project, as required by decisions 28/7 and 56/2(c). It addresses balances to be returned against projects as a follow-up to relevant Executive Committee's decisions (referred to as "by-decision" projects in this document). It indicates the level of resources available to the Executive Committee in cash as recorded in the Status of contributions and disbursements document,² as required by decision 41/92(b), and presents a recommendation.
- 2. This document also contains the following three annexes:

Annex II Amounts held by IAs and BAs for by-decision projects

Funds to be returned to the 82nd meeting

3. The total funds to be returned amount to US \$3,232,996 (i.e. US \$121,266 by BAs and US \$3,102,557 by IAs from completed, by-decision and ODS alternatives survey projects, and US \$9,173

interest by BA). Annexes I, II and III provide explanations on the delays in disbursing committed amounts or returning not-committed amounts.

Funds to be returned by IAs

4. The total funds to be returned by IAs amount to US \$3,102,557 as shown in Table 1 (the list of projects with funds returned is presented in Annex IV).

Funds to be returned to the 82nd meeting by BAs

6. The total funds to be returned by BAs amount to US \$130,439 as shown in Table 3 (the list of projects with funds returned is presented in Annex IV).

- 7. The Government of France's return to the 82nd meeting will be either offset against future bilateral project approvals or in cash, in consultation with the Treasurer and the Secretariat.
- 8. The Government of Spain has already returned in cash the amount of US \$5,942 to the Treasurer.
- 9. Table 4 presents the balances from completed projects that are being held by BAs.

- 10. With regard to balances held by BAs:
 - (a) The Government of Japan has a committed balance of US \$63, including agency support costs for one completed project; and
 - (b) The Government of Spain has a committed balance of US \$3,092, including agency support costs for one completed project.

Availability of resources

11. The Status of contributions and disbursements document³ indicates an available balance amounting to US \$108,841,602 as at 12 October 2018. The total net balance returned by BAs and IAs, including agency support costs and interest is US \$3,232,996. The total level of resources available for approvals by the Executive Committee at the 82nd meeting, after taking into account the Fund's balance, and the return from the Secretariat 2017 unspent budget of US \$1,665,431 is US \$113,740,029.

Secretariat's comments

- 12. During the Inter-agency Coordination Meeting,⁴ the Secretariat reminded BAs and IAs that balances associated with completed projects and by-decisions projects that are due should be returned to the Multilateral Fund no later than the 82nd meeting. BAs and IAs committed to continue with their efforts to return funds as soon as possible, and to provide an update to the 82nd meeting with a view to returning additional balances. IAs were also reminded that completed IS projects balances should be returned to the Fund.
- 13. Considering that the total level of funding for projects and activities as submitted to the 82nd meeting amounts to US \$98,717,726 including agency support costs⁵, there are sufficient resources available for approvals at the 82nd meeting.

Recommendations

- 14. The Executive Committee may wish:
 - (a) To note:
 - (i) The report on balances and availability of resources contained in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/82/4;
 - (ii) That the net level of funds being returned to the 82nd meeting by the implementing agencies was US \$3,102,557, consisting of US \$109,231, plus agency support costs of US \$8,619 from UNDP; US \$1,248,220, plus agency support costs of US \$108,993 from UNEP; US \$1,241,267, plus agency support costs of US \$90,757 from UNIDO, and US \$220,000 plus agency support costs of US \$75,470 from the World Bank;
 - (iii) That UNEP held balances of US \$158,200, including agency support costs, in not-committed balances, for one project completed over two years previously;
 - (iv) That UNEP held balances of US \$301,042, including agency support costs, for seven ODS alternatives survey projects;
 - (v) That UNIDO held balances of US \$12,773, including agency support costs, for two ODS alternatives survey projects;
 - (vi) That the net level of funds and agency support costs due to be returned by the bilateral agencies to the 82nd meeting was US \$121,266, consisting of: US \$120,723 from the Government of France and US \$543 from the Government of Spain;
 - (vii) The Governments of France's and Spain's return of accrued interest of US \$3,774 and US \$5,399, respectively, which would be considered additional income to the Fund;
 - (viii) That the Government of Japan held US \$63, including agency support costs, in committed balances, for one completed project;
 - (ix) That the Government of Spain held US \$3,092, including agency support costs, in committed balances, for one completed project.
 - (b) To request:
 - (i) Bilateral and implementing agencies to disburse or cancel commitments not needed for completed projects and projects completed by decision of the Executive Committee, and to return balances to the 83rd meeting;
 - (ii) UNEP and UNIDO to return the outstanding balances for ODS alternatives survey projects before the 83rd meeting, in line with decision 80/75(c)(i); and
 - (iii) The Treasurer to offset US \$124,497 against the Government of France's approvals at the 82nd meeting or to follow up with the Government of France on the return, in cash, of US \$124,497 referred to in sub-paragraphs (vi) and (vii) above.
