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执行蒙特利尔议定书 多边基金执行委员会 第八十三次会议 2019年5月27日至31日,蒙特利尔

项目审查期间查明的问题概览

- 1. 本文件由以下部分组成:
 - (a) 各双边机构和执行机构提交的项目和活动概览;
 - (b) 项目审查期间查明的问题概览;
 - (c) 提交供一揽子核准的项目和活动;及
 - (d) 供个别审议的投资项目。

各双边机构和执行机构提交的项目和活动概览

- 2. 各双边机构和执行机构提交了 101 项已核准多年期协定付款、项目和活动的供资申请,数额为 96,021,850 美元(如包括原则上申请的数额,则为 148,331,866 美元),其中包括适用的机构支助费用。供资申请包括:
 - (a) 1个国家的氟氯烃生产淘汰管理计划第二阶段(将由化工生产行业分组审议);
 - (b) 19个国家的已核准氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的付款;
 - (c) 1 个国家挤塑聚苯乙烯泡沫行业淘汰 HCFC-142b/HCFC-22 的投资项目;
 - (d) 28 个国家的机构加强项目的延续:
 - (e) 9个国家氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段准备及4个国家第三阶段准备;
 - (f) 1 个国家 HCFC-22 生产过程中 HFC-23 的控制和削减(将在议程项目 12(c)下予以审议)¹;

- (g) 1个国家氢氟碳化物投资项目;
- (h) 3个国家氢氟碳化物投资项目的项目准备;及
- (i) 1个国家氢氟碳化物削减的扶持活动。
- 3. 经过项目审查,建议一揽子核准的有 72 个项目和活动,费用总额为 8,576,869 美元(包括机构支助费用);交付个别审议的有 16 个项目和活动,费用总额为 59,492,567 美元(包括机构支助费用),其中 31,619,787 美元用于中国的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划 第二阶段挤塑聚苯乙烯泡沫、工商制冷、清洗和制冷维修行业²计划的第三次付款,25,138,537 美元用于中国的氟氯烃生产淘汰管理计划第二阶段第一次付款。供一揽子核准和供个别审议的项目的费用加在一起,总额为68,069,436 美元。
- 4. 建议一揽子核准 1 个国家(阿拉伯叙利亚共和国)氢氟碳化物削减扶持活动的项目,该项目将在额外捐助下予以资助。

提交后撤回的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划(伊朗伊斯兰共和国、巴基斯坦、塞尔维亚)

- 5. 开发计划署代表伊朗伊斯兰共和国提交了氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段第二次付款申请。 在仔细研究秘书处提议且随后与开发计划署讨论后,无法将该申请提交执行委员会审议,因为开 发计划署未能提交制冷和空调制造行业前 15 家企业转成低全球变暖潜能值替代品的改造结果报告, 其中突出吸取的经验教训和面临的挑战(第 77/44 号决定(d)段),也因为工发组织无法对泡沫行 业计划将要发生的若干变化的增加成本作出解释。预计将向第 84 次会议提交付款申请。
- 6. 根据第 76/39 号决定(f)段3,工发组织提交了一个项目,将巴基斯坦一家挤塑聚苯乙烯泡沫企业(Symbol Industry)改造成使用二甲醚(DME)、二氧化碳和氢氟烯烃的企业。提交的项目总费用为 871,527 美元,外加工发组织的支助费用 61,007 美元;费用有效性为 11.36 美元/公斤⁴。尽管进行了详尽的讨论,但工发组织和秘书处无法在项目谈判的最后期限之前就项目的总费用达成一致。秘书处随后要求将该项目重新提交第 84 次会议。秘书处进一步指出,推迟提交该项目不会影响巴基斯坦政府遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》的义务,因为该政府已经同意在 2020 年之前通过氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第一阶段和第二阶段下活动削减氟氯烃消费量基线水平的 50%,这些活动不包括挤塑聚苯乙烯泡沫行业的改造。
- 7. 工发组织代表塞尔维亚政府提交了一个项目,在一家名为 Eko Elektrofrigo 的企业的工业冷冻隧道制造中淘汰 R-404A。在讨论之后项目被撤回,因为该项目似乎不符合第 78/3 号决定(g)段和第 79/45 号决定列出的标准。尤其是该应用似乎是在组装子行业,而不是制造业,并且该技术的可复制性是有限的。注意到迄今为止尚未从欧洲和中亚区域提交单个氢氟碳化物项目,而地理分布也包括在第 79/45 号决定规定的氢氟碳化物单个项目的审议标准中,因此秘书处建议工发组织考虑向第八十四次会议另外提交一个满足第 78/3 号决定(g)段和第 79/45 号决定标准的来自该区域的项目。

机构加强延续申请

8. 秘书处根据有关决定,包括关于机构加强项目供资水平的第 74/51 号决定(c)段和要求列入所规划活动的具体业绩指标的第 74/51 号决定(e)段,审查了 28 个国家的最终报告和延续机构加强项目的供资申请。对照下列文件核对了所有申请:以前的机构加强报告;国家方案执行进度报告;根据《蒙特利尔议定书》第 7 条报告的数据;最新的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划执行情况报告;双边机

构和执行机构提交第八十二次会议的进度报告;《蒙特利尔议定书》缔约方通过的有关履约问题的决定。在本文件印发时,所有国家都有2017年国家方案执行数据,18个国家已提交2018年数据。所有国家都报告已经实现了全部或大部分为机构加强前一阶段进展报告中的具体业绩指标而设定的目标。秘书处建议一揽子核准提交第八十三次会议的所有机构加强项目。

提交核查报告或满足具体条件之前暂不发放的资金

9. 目前没有在提交核查报告或满足具体条件之前财务主任暂不发放的已核准资金。

受控物质和替代品的价格概述

10. 执行委员会第七十九次会议⁵要求秘书处在本文件中列入一项概述,说明任何新项目提案中请求供资的企业所述受控物质和将改用的替代品的价格,包括澄清这些价格与国家方案数据报告所述价格之间的任何差异。没有提交第八十三次会议审议的新的投资项目。

项目审查期间查明的问题

11. 在审查提交第八十三次会议审议的项目期间,没有发现提请执委会注意的新的政策问题。

提交供一揽子核准的项目和活动

低消费量国家遵守其氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的核查报告

12. 如表 1 所示,依照第 61/46 号决定(c)段⁶, 秘书处挑选了 17 个国家为实例,为的是核实遵守氟氯烃淘汰管理计划的情况。其中一项挑选国家进行核实的标准是距离下一次氟氯烃淘汰管理计划付款的临近程度(2020 年和 2021 年之间)以及如有可能该国在先前核查中未被选过(这包括若干太平洋岛国)。但是,注意到被列为低消费量国家、以前没有选定进行核查的第 5 条款国家数量有限,可能过去已经为在此清单上的有些国家提供了核查资金。有鉴于此,秘书处使用了额外的选择标准:除了地理分布、消费水平以及双边和执行机构之间的分配等标准外,其先前的核查应在四年多前得到核准并已完成。选定的国家(非洲 4 个,亚洲 9 个,欧洲 2 个,拉丁美洲和加勒比 2 个)如下。

秘书处的建议

- 13. 执行委员会不妨请各双边和执行机构在其各自应提交第八十四次会议的工作方案修正案中,纳入以下国家的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第一阶段核查报告的供资,金额为 30,000 美元,外加机构支助费用:布基纳法索、柬埔寨、库克群岛、危地马拉、洪都拉斯、基里巴斯、莱索托、马绍尔群岛、密克罗尼西亚(联邦)、黑山、瑙鲁、纽埃、南苏丹、图瓦卢和瓦努阿图,以及以下国家的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段核查报告的供资:安哥拉和亚美尼亚。
- 14. 本文件附件一列出了总额为 8,576,869 美元(包括机构支助费用)的建议一揽子核准的 72 个项目和活动。对这些项目的核准应包括相应项目评价表中的相关条件或条款,以及对与相关多年期项目付款相关的执行方案的核准。

供个别审议的投资项目

- 15. 秘书处经过审查,建议对 16 个项目/活动进行个别审议,其费用共计 59,492,567 美元,包括机构支助费用。这些项目/活动是:中国氟氯烃淘汰管理计划第二阶段挤塑聚苯乙烯泡沫、工商制冷、清洗和制冷维修行业⁷计划的第三次付款,费用为 31,619,787 美元,包括机构支助费用;中国氟氯烃生产淘汰管理计划第二阶段第一次付款,费用为 25,138,537 美元,包括机构支助费用(如果包括原则上申请的数额,则为 109,769,643 美元,其中 75,415,613 美元将用于中国的氟氯烃生产淘汰管理计划)。
- 16. 为方便执行委员会讨论供个别审议的投资项目,秘书处对项目进行了行业分类,并根据所涉问题对其进行了分组,如表 2 所示。
