#### UPDATE ON THE STATUS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 2021–2023 **PART I: BUSINESS PLANS**

At its 86th meeting, the Executive Committee endorsed the 2021–2023 consolidated business plan of the Multilateral Fund. In response to decision 86/45, the Secretariat adjusted the consolidated 2021–2023 business plan, as shown in Table 1.

# Status of implementation of the 2021 business plans

3. The total funding available for 2021 amounts to US \$154,392,623. Of this amount, US \$20,885,937 has been approved at the 87<sup>th</sup> meeting. In addition, activities amounting to US \$84,761,734 would be considered at the 88<sup>th</sup> meeting; if funding requests for all project proposals submitted are approved, a balance of US \$48,744,952 would be available from the 2021 business plan, as shown in Table 2.

- 4. The value of project activities reviewed/recommended to the 88<sup>th</sup> meeting is US \$77,716,860, of which US \$2,835,618 is associated with project proposals not included in the 2021 business plan.<sup>2</sup>
- 5. The value of HFC-related activities submitted to the 88<sup>th</sup> meeting is US \$4,111,058, of which US \$915,360 is associated with project proposals not included in the 2021 business plan. Annex I to the present document lists HFC-related projects submitted by the bilateral and implementing agencies to the 88<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- 6. Project proposals with a value of US \$39,399,993³ that were included in the 2021 business plan, were not submitted to the 88th meeting. These proposals have been included in the Consolidated business plan of the Multilateral Fund for 2022–2024.<sup>4</sup>

#### **Forward commitments**

7. The total amount for existing forward commitments for multi-year agreements (MYAs) for the period 2021 to 2031 is US \$301.24 million, assuming that the funding requests of MYAs submitted to the 88th meeting will be approved in principle, as shown in Table 3.

# PART II: RESOURCE ALLOCATION FOR THE 2018–2020 TRIENNIUM

- 8. The resources approved by the Parties to the Montreal Protocol for the 2018–2020 triennium<sup>5</sup> amount to US \$540,000,000. Taking into account the total funding approvals in 2018, 2019 and 2020, balances returned, interest accrued, paid contributions from non-Article 5 Parties, the gain/loss of the fixed exchange rate mechanism, and the Secretariat/Executive Committee/Treasurer expenditures, the cash available as of 7 October 2021 is US \$385,240,783.
- 9. In addition, taking into account net funds transferred of US \$14,654,407 at the 87<sup>th</sup> meeting and the cash contributions in 2021, the carry-over for the 2018–2020 triennium would be US \$299,413,518, as shown in Table 4.
