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执行蒙特利尔议定书 多边基金执行委员会 第六十四次会议 2011年7月25日至29日,蒙特利尔

拖延项目的执行情况和第5条国家实现遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》今后管制措施的前景

执行摘要

- 所有可能无法在 2010 年淘汰氟氯化碳/四氯化碳之前实现中期削减或有剩余消费量的 国家,以及在 2015 年淘汰之前有甲基氯仿或甲基溴消费量的国家,都有为实现这些目 标而核准的项目,或在 2011-2014 年业务计划中包含有助于实现这些目标的活动或根 据全球环境基金(全环基金)开展的活动,但下列国家除外:
 - o 尽管厄瓜多尔和巴拿马在四氯化碳方面已履约,但仍有 0.1 ODP 吨剩余消费量用于实验室用途;
- 最新的消费数据显示有46个国家的2009年数据和4个国家的2010年数据中仍包含氟 氯化碳消费,但96个国家报告为零水平,1个国家报告为负消费;
- 然而,最新消费量数据显示多数国家实现了剩余物质的零消费(不包括氟氯烃),仅有6个国家报告有哈龙消费;30个国家报告有甲基溴消费;12个国家报告有四氯化碳消费;以及7个国家报告有甲基氯仿消费;
- 在履约委员会 2010 年解决的 33 个问题中,根据第 7 条数据和臭氧秘书处提供的信息,3 个问题已经得到解决,而根据国家方案报告或执行机构提供的数据,13 个问题已经得到解决;
- 关于国家方案执行情况的数据表明:
 - o 所有国家都按照 5 年以前核准的新格式提供了数据,但仅有 29 个国家使用网络系统提交 2010 年数据,其中 3 个国家只提交了数据表:
 - o 估计 2010 年第 5 条国家的消耗臭氧层物质剩余消费量共计 1,155.1 ODP 吨,不包括氟氯烃,约有 1,057.9 ODP 吨(包括第 7 条数据,有 2 个国家没有报告国家方案数据)消费量有待执行委员会审议采取行动;
 - o 1,057.9 ODP 吨的剩余消费量中,主要是甲基溴(1,057.7 ODP 吨),其次是四氯化碳(0.2 ODP 吨);
 - o 国家方案数据报告的氟氯烃消费量共计 469,494 公吨(31,419 ODP 吨)。60 个国家报告了 2009 年和 2010 年数据,其中氟氯烃消费量减少了 1%:
 - o 在 144 个报告了许可证制度相关信息的国家中,有 134 个国家报告称这些制度已运行中(57 个报告了 2010 年数据的国家中,有 54 个国家具有经营许可证制度,其中 98.1%运行情况"令人满意"或"非常好");
 - o HCFC-22、HCFC-141b 和 HCFC-142b 仍然比相关的各类氟氯化碳便宜得多。
- 在 15 个执行有延误的项目中,1 个项目已经完成,1 个项目报告了进展情况,1 个项目第一次报告没有进展,2 个项目将向第六十四次会议提交关于延误的报告,还有 7 个项目建议继续监测。尚未收到以色列(1 个项目)、日本(1 个项目)和葡萄牙(1 个项目)的延期报告;
- 建议就 4 个将向本次会议提交现状报告的项目提交一份补充报告,以及关于 3 个氟氯 烃淘汰管理计划编制活动情况的补充报告。

导言

- 1. 本文件由五部分组成:
 - (a) 第一部分是根据第 32/76 (b) 号和第 46/4 号决定编制的,其中请秘书处为 执行委员会各次会议编制关于应遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》管制措施的第 5 条 国家履约现状的增订资料。
 - (b) 第二部分包含应遵守各缔约方决定和执行委员会履约建议的第 5 条国家的资料。
 - (c) 第三部分提出了关于国家方案执行情况的数据,包括按行业分列的消耗臭氧层物质消费量数据的分析。还包含一部分述及国家消耗臭氧层物质淘汰方案特点的内容。
 - (d) 第四部分介绍了国家方案基于网络的数据报告的情况。
 - (e) 第五部分涉及执行有延误的项目以及要求提供额外情况报告的项目。
- 2. 本文件进行的分析和得出的结论,不妨碍由缔约方会议所确定的履约现状,缔约方会议是唯一得到授权对履约现状进行评估的机构。根据《议定书》第7条报告的数据专门用于确定年度基础上的履约现状。本文件在分析时所使用的数据综合了向基金秘书处报告的履约各阶段国家方案执行情况的数据和第7条数据。因此,文件本身没有决定履约现状,而是评估了第5条国家努力实现遵守《蒙特利尔议定书》一项或多项管制措施的前景。其主要目的是确定需要由多边基金予以支持的行动来加以处理的消耗臭氧层物质。

第一部分:履约现状和前景(以最新可用数据为准)

- 3. 本部分提出了对截至 2010 年的最终淘汰氟氯化碳、哈龙和四氯化碳以及 2015 年最终淘汰甲基溴和甲基氯仿的管制措施履约现状的分析结论。¹ 该分析假设根据第 7 条或国家方案数据报告的最新消费数据已经考虑到了已完成的由执行委员会核准项目的淘汰量。自多边基金设立以来,截至 2010 年 12 月,已完成项目淘汰的消费量为 235,604 ODP 吨,生产量为 191,246 ODP 吨。已完成项目的价值为 19.8 亿美元,核准的价值共计约 23.3 亿美元。关于此次分析所用方法的详细说明载于提交执行委员会第三十七次会议的UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/37/18 号文件。
- 4. 分析使用了最新可用数据。截至 2011 年 6 月 3 日,23 个第 5 条国家已根据第 7 条报告了 2010 年数据(2010 年 5 月有 21 个国家)。截至 2011 年 6 月 5 日,另有 37 个国家向基金秘书处报告了关于国家方案执行进度的 2010 年数据(第 17/34 号决定)。对于尚未提交 2010 年数据的国家,分析使用了最新可用消费数据。包括 87 个国家使用 2009 年第 7 条数据。分析假设,最新报告的不包括氟氯烃的消耗臭氧层物质消费量并未增加,尽管这种情况对于未提供 2010 年数据的 87 个国家来说可能并不属实。
- 5. 双边和多边执行机构向执行委员会第六十四次会议提交了年度进度报告,其中包含 关于截至 2010 年底委员会核准的所有活动和项目执行情况的数据。关于 2011 年可能获得

核准的数据来自第六十三次会议核准的《2011-2014 年综合业务计划》 (UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/63/7)。

6. 基金秘书处将继续综合以前关于履约现状和前景的报告中的所有数据。这些数据被基金秘书处用于分析之目的。可应要求提供这些数据。

生产行业

- 7. 在 7 个²有氟氯化碳生产设施的第 5 条国家中,阿根廷、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民 共和国、印度、墨西哥和委内瑞拉玻利瓦尔共和国政府有关于计划削减的协定。巴西政府 表示它已自行淘汰了各类氟氯化碳的生产。关于哈龙生产,中国政府已有一项协定,而印 度政府得到了一次性赠款用以关闭其哈龙生产设施。
- 8. 4 个国家(巴西、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国和印度)确定了四氯化碳生产基准。3 个国家(中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国和印度)的生产和消费行业彻底淘汰四氯化碳的项目已经得到执行委员会核准。第五十四次会议核准了巴西的一个四氯化碳加工剂行业项目。只有中国的甲基氯仿生产关闭项目得到核准。
- 9. 中国作为仅有的两个拥有甲基溴生产设施的第5条国家之一,其甲基溴生产关闭项目已获核准。另一个国家大韩民国没有寻求基金援助。
- 10. 有 6 个国家于 2009 年或 2010 年生产了氟氯烃: 阿根廷、中国、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国、印度、墨西哥和委内瑞拉玻利瓦尔共和国。除中国外,所有这些国家都与执行委员会签署了氟氯化碳生产行业协定,为关闭氟氯化碳设施供资,并且考虑到在相同工厂淘汰氟氯烃生产,前提是不再为关闭氟氯烃生产向执行委员会寻求额外供资。执行委员会授权基金秘书处启动关于中国氟氯烃生产行业技术审计的签约进程,同时谨记或许无需对所有工厂进行详细的技术审计(第 62/63(d)号决定)。

消费行业

消费仃业

- 11. 这一部分概述了对似乎未履约或可能违约的国家的违约程度进行详细分析的结果。在制定基准前提供了除氟氯烃外的所有五种受控物质的一览表。这些一览表的 2010 年数据显示了似乎未遵守 2010 年管制措施的国家,以及包括 2009 年数据在内的最新数据显示了有可能出现不遵守情事的国家。概述所依据的数据载于附件一,其中包含按物质分列的各国的详细资料。附件一还说明了这些国家是否得到了预计将由多边基金提供的所有援助。
- 12. 附件一所载履约情况评估中包含了何时核准有助于履约的活动以及国家是否报告了有关建立许可证制度的资料。这些资料应有助于执行委员会评估各国的履约前景,因为已核准数据表明了项目或协定已经执行的时间。此外,建立许可证制度的资料表明,现有的管制措施保证了未来的履约,不管当前的消费量是多少。关于项目核准的资料来自《已核准项目目录》。2011年5月19日,臭氧秘书处提供了关于建立许可证制度的数据。

各类氟氯化碳

13. 表 1 概括了各国对各类氟氯化碳管制措施的履约现状。

14. 所有其最新消费量超过管制措施或被认为可能违约的国家均已得到多边基金的支助,或在各机构 2011-2014 年业务计划中载入了计划执行的活动,但安哥拉、埃塞俄比亚、索马里和东帝汶除外。依据第 60/5 (d) 号决定,这些国家的氟氯化碳最终淘汰管理计划将被纳入氟氯烃淘汰管理计划。第六十三次会议核准了东帝汶的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划。

哈龙

15. 表 2 概括了各国遵守哈龙管制措施的现状。75 个国家 1995 年和 2010 年期间没有报告哈龙的任何消费量。61 个国家获得了关于哈龙库活动或淘汰协定的支助,包括参与区域哈龙库的国家。

甲基溴

16. 表 3 概况了各国对甲基溴管制措施的履约现状(不包括检疫和装船前)。已批准《哥本哈根修正案》的所有 144 个第 5 条国家均报告完成了基准数据。有 3 个第 5 条国家尚未批准《哥本哈根修正案》,它们是安哥拉、几内亚和尼泊尔。在这 144 个已批准《哥本哈根修正案》的国家中,57 个国家报告其基准消费量和最新消费量为零。99 个第 5 条国家的甲基溴淘汰活动和/或项目获得了多边基金的支助。

17. 土库曼斯坦是唯一一个最新消费量超过其 2005 年管制措施的国家。土库曼斯坦已核准有助于彻底淘汰甲基溴的项目。

四氯化碳

18. 表 4 概括了各国履行四氯化碳管制措施的现状。概况数据不包括原料,也不按照特定用途进行区分(诸如溶剂和加工剂)。在 146 个报告了基准数据的国家中,89 个国家报告基准消费和最新消费均为零。

19. 所有最新消费量超过其管制措施或被认为可能违约的国家均已得到了多边基金的支助,厄瓜多尔和大韩民国除外。厄瓜多尔是唯一可能不需要额外援助就能实现四氯化碳100%削减目标的国家。世界银行对某一项目的可能用途进行了调查,但发现所有的四氯化碳进口均用于实验室用途。大韩民国已同意不从多边基金领取四氯化碳供资。巴拿马尚未获得来自多边基金的援助,且其消费量也用于实验室用途。

甲基氯仿

20. 表 5 概括了各国对甲基氯仿管制措施的履约现状。在 146 个报告了基准数据的国家中,103 个国家报告其基准消费量和最新消费量为零。

21. 所有最新消费量超过其管制措施或被认为可能违约的国家均已得到多边基金的支助,大韩民国除外。大韩民国已同意不领取多边基金的供资。

氟氯烃

- 22. 附件一的附录六载有对氟氯烃最新消费数据的分析,并指出国家是否收到氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制供资、核准的投资项目数量、核准的示范项目数量、以 ODP 吨计算的核准淘汰总量以及 2011 年业务计划中规划的各项活动。
- 23. 提供补充资料是为了说明迄今获得核准并提交第六十四次会议的氟氯烃淘汰管理计划及其时间范围(例如,已核准氟氯烃淘汰管理计划将在 2015 年实现 10%削减或者在 2020 年实现 35%削减)。执行委员会迄今已核准 61 项氟氯烃淘汰管理计划,其中 13 项述及 2015 年之前的管制措施,39 项述及 2020 年之前的管制措施、8 项述及彻底淘汰氟氯烃,以及 1 个区域项目。
- 24. 将在 2011 年 9 月 30 日提供两个基准年度(2009 年和 2010 年)的基准数据,在此之前不会报告氟氯烃基准数据。截至 2011 年 6 月 5 日,86 个第 5 条国家报告了 2009 年数据,60 个国家报告了 2010 年数据。1 个国家尚未报告 2009 年的氟氯烃数据。
- 25. 所有国家均收到了氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制项目,大韩民国、新加坡和阿拉伯联合酋长国除外。这些国家同意不领取多边基金的供资。3 个已收到氟氯烃淘汰管理计划编制的国家(安哥拉、几内亚和尼泊尔)尚未批准《哥本哈根修正案》。依据第 53/37 号决定,批准《哥本哈根修正案》是获得氟氯烃淘汰管理计划供资的前提条件。

第二部分: 须遵守缔约方关于履约的各项决定的国家和可能违约的国家的执行情况

- 26. 本节述及须遵守关于履约的各项决定的第5条国家。
- 27. 有 33 项与缔约方履约相关的决定,2011 年执行委员会审议了这些决定在 27 个国家的适用情况,2010 年数据报告导致的问题除外。已根据第 7 条和臭氧秘书处的数据解决了 3 个履约相关问题。另外 13 个问题根据国家方案数据或执行机构的报告得以解决。有 14 个问题的相关资料尚未提供。根据臭氧秘书处提供的资料,截至 2011 年 5 月 19

日,由于 3 个国家的问题,未能实现在 2011 年 5 月 31 日前建立许可证制度的行动计划目标。表 6 根据提供给臭氧秘书处和各机构的信息以及国家方案数据,说明了执行委员会各项决定取得的进展。

附件二中的信息

- 28. 附件二提供资料,介绍了需遵守 2011 年缔约方关于履约的决定。提供的资料按履约问题和国家编排。
- 29. 附件二还包括题为"基金秘书处和执行机构评论意见"的专栏,提供的资料摘自国家臭氧机构提交的国家方案数据报告以及臭氧秘书处和各执行机构提供的数据。

第三部分:关于国家方案执行情况的数据

30. 第三部分载有关于国家方案执行情况的数据,包括按行业分列的消耗臭氧层物质消费数据,这些数据在每年的 5 月 1 日前提交基金秘书处。本节还提供了关于国家消耗臭氧层物质淘汰方案特点的补充资料。国家方案数据报告格式由执行委员会第三十五次会议第35/58(e)号决定核准,并根据第 46/39 号决定和第 60/4(b)(iv)号决定进行修订。

按行业分列的氯氟烃以外消耗臭氧层物质消费数据

31. 截至 2011 年 6 月 5 日,基金秘书处已从 144 个被要求提交这类报告的国家中收到 57 个国家的 2010 年国家方案执行情况的最新报告,76 个国家的 2009 年报告以及 9 个国家的 2008 年报告。以下国家未提交报告的国家方案数据:南非和东帝汶。东帝汶近期刚刚批准《议定书》,因此未报告国家方案数据。南非只有资格接受多边基金为氯氟烃提供的援助。应当指出,体制建设项目的延期要以接收到这类数据的情况而定。此外,国家方案实施数据必须在本年度最后一次会议和后续会议之前提交,作为核准和发放项目资金的先决条件。所有向第六十四次会议提交供资申请的国家还提交了 2010 年国家方案数据,不丹、玻利维亚多民族国、中国、刚果、哥斯达黎加、吉布提、印度、印度尼西亚、约旦、基里巴斯、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国、黎巴嫩、马来西亚、马绍尔群岛、莫桑比克、

缅甸、纽埃、阿曼、圣基茨和尼维斯、圣卢西亚、萨摩亚、塞内加尔、所罗门群岛、东帝 汶以及特立尼达和多巴哥除外。

- 32. 尽管所记录的消费量取自不同年份,并且可能未必符合所报告的第7条数据,但国家方案数据仍提供了全球范围内按国家分列的最新行业评估。这些数据应协助相关的第5条国家和执行委员会评估各行业仍需淘汰的物质。
- 33. 表 7 按行业分列了淘汰剩余消耗臭氧层物质的消费总量,并考虑到已核准但尚未执行的项目。表 7 还包括尚未完成的核准项目的淘汰消费总量。

- 34. 已核准但尚未执行的消耗臭氧层物质削减总量(表 7)不包括原则上核准多年期协定的数量或者该削减量预计是通过执行制冷剂管理计划和哈龙库活动实现。除已获供资的削减量,执行委员会原则上核准的行业和国家淘汰项目根据实现的计划削减量发放年度付款。
- 35. 如表 7 所示,今后年度付款的削减将涉及大量剩余消费量。此外,低消费量国家的制冷剂管理计划占这些国家基准消费和最终淘汰管理计划剩余基准的 85%,然而,已核准但尚未执行的项目数据不计入所有这一吨数。另外,表 7 中已核准但尚未执行的消耗臭氧层物质淘汰量不包括已接受哈龙库项目的国家的某些哈龙消费量。
- 36. 考虑到最终淘汰管理计划、低消费量国家的制冷剂管理计划、哈龙库、全部淘汰项目和原则上核准的多年期协定所产生的淘汰量之后,尚待解决的消耗臭氧层物质剩余消费总量似乎为 1,057.9 ODP 吨(表 8)。这比向第六十一次会议报告的 1,155.1 ODP 吨有所下降。

氯氟烃数据

37. 表 9 列出了基于现有最新数据的氟氯烃消费量。它表明,氟氯烃的消费量为 469,494 公吨(31,417 ODP 吨),主要包括 HCFC-22(占总量的 59%)和 HCFC-141b(占总量的 31.7%)消费量。469,494 公吨的氟氯烃消费量表明,该数量比报告给第六十一次会议的数量(441,738 公吨)增加了 27,756 公吨。相比之下,截至 2010 年 12 月 31 日,多边基金削减了 233,087 公吨(244,343 ODP 吨)消耗臭氧层物质消费量。报告中的这一数据来源于 57 个国家报告的 2010 年数据、76 个国家的 2009 年数据和 9 个国家的 2008 年数据。关于报告了 2009 年和 2010 年数据的国家,其氟氯烃消费量增长了 1%。

国家淘汰方案的特点

38. 第 46/39 号决定通过的且在第六十次会议上修订(第 60/4(b)(iv)号决定)的国家方案报告的新格式,为国家臭氧机构提供了一次从质和量的角度来评估履约前景的机会。

数据的完整性

- 39. 这是第五年使用新格式报告国家方案数据。3个国家使用第四十六次会议核准的该格式提供了2010年数据,54个国家使用了第六十次会议核准的修订格式。但大部分以新格式提供的数据都不完整,主要表现在质量、数量和规范性三个方面。仅有3个国家,即巴哈马、布基纳法索和摩尔多瓦共和国从所有三个方面提供了完整资料。
- 40. 按照第 59/4(b)(iv)号决定,秘书处审查了网上的国家方案执行数据。秘书处注意到,只有 29 个国家采用 2007 年 4 月 25 日启动的网络系统提交 2010 年数据,其中包括 3 个仅提交数据单表的国家。第四部分述及网上报告系统问题。
- 41. 在被要求提供国家方案数据的 144个国家中,仅有 57个国家及时提供了 2010年国家方案数据,用于本文件分析。所有向第六十四次会议提交供资申请的国家还提供了 2010年国家方案数据,不丹、玻利维亚多民族国、中国、刚果、哥斯达黎加、吉布提、印度、印度尼西亚、约旦、基里巴斯、朝鲜民主主义人民共和国、黎巴嫩、马来西亚、马绍尔群岛、莫桑比克、缅甸、纽埃、阿曼、圣基茨和尼维斯、圣卢西亚、萨摩亚、塞内加尔、所罗门群岛、东帝汶以及特立尼达和多巴哥除外。

数据概要

氯氟烃以外的所有消耗臭氧层物质

- 42. 在 57 个报告制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的国家中,有 48 个国家表示,在其制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的执行过程中取得了进展,或者已经完成这些计划。包括报告 2010 年以前数据的国家,这 142 个国家中有 115 个国家表示在执行制冷剂管理计划/国家淘汰计划/最终淘汰管理计划的过程中取得了进展,或者已完成了这些计划。
- 43. 包括报告 2010 年以前数据的国家表示,共有 12,858 台回收机和 5,644 台再循环机正在运行。在使用回收和再循环机器的国家中,72%的国家报告机器运行状况"令人满意"或"非常好"。回收的 CFC-11 共计 2,421.5 ODP 吨,其中 2,153.3 ODP 吨得到了再利用;回收的 CFC-12 共计 24,462.7 ODP 吨,再利用的有 21,115.6 ODP 吨。未收集其他消耗臭氧层物质的数据。综合 2006-2010 年报告的最新数据以及此前数年报告中的数据表明,共有 77,502 名制冷维修技术员接受过培训,60,375 人获得了证书,并有 3,627 名制冷技术员培训人员接受了培训。
- 44. 在 142 个报告了数据(包括此前数年报告的数据)的国家中,106 个国家表示已制定了配额制度。此外,121 个国家建议将进口商注册作为一项规定。根据报告,共有15,997 名海关官员接受了培训。目前尚不清楚这一数据是年度数据还是累计数据。
- 45. 在 144 个符合报告要求的国家中,134 个国家报告已具备经营许可证制度(在报告了 2010 年数据的 57 个国家中,54 个国家已具备经营许可证制度,其中 98.1%运行状况 "令人满意"或"非常好")。下列国家没有报告其许可证制度是否已经运行:莱索托。
- 46. 第 63/4(b)(iii)号决定要求环境规划署履约协助方案查明,库克群岛、海地、基里巴斯、毛里塔尼亚、密克罗尼西亚联邦和塞内加尔的许可证制度运行状况不尽人意的原因,

各国改进许可证制度运行情况的计划[······]。所有这些国家报告称,其许可证制度目前的运行情况良好。

47. 该决定还要求环境规划署查明"埃塞俄比亚和莱索托未建立许可证制度的原因"。缔约方会议第 XXII/19 号决定要求埃塞俄比亚和莱索托制定消耗臭氧层物质的许可证制度,并在 2011 年 5 月 31 日前向秘书处报告。环境规划署表示,埃塞俄比亚已将其消耗臭氧层物质进出口许可证制度的最终草案提交至适当机构,并且政府机构简要听取了《蒙特利尔议定书》和建立许可证制度的必要性。但截至 2011 年 5 月 29 日,埃塞俄比亚许可证制度仍待核准。环境规划署报告称,莱索托提供的资料显示,对消耗臭氧层物质条例的核准已进入高级阶段。由司法部制定消耗臭氧层物质条例的草案,准备提交至内阁进行核准。预计内阁核准工作将在今年第三季度末完成。谨建议执行委员会敦促埃塞俄比亚和莱索托政府尽快核准其许可证制度。

氟氯化碳和氯氟烃及其替代品的价格数据

- 49. 未提供哈龙、甲基溴或四氯化碳的此类数据。
- 50. 表 10 显示,根据本次数据样本,2010 年 HCFC-22、HCFC-141b 和 HCFC-142b 的价格仍旧比相关各类氟氯化碳便宜得多。应该指出的是,仅第 5 条国家提供了 CFC-11 的价格数据,13 个国家提供 CFC-12 的价格数据,而且由于这些氟氯化碳将来自库存量,故无法判断大多数国家是否销售氟氯化碳。例如,关于 HFC-143a 和丙烷(HC-290),表10 所示的价格高于各种氟氯化碳的价格,但该表并未考虑氟氯化碳缺乏可用性的问题。

氟氯烃

- 51. 这是第二年采用第六十次会议上核准的修订格式以纳入氯氟烃淘汰情况的相关资料(第 60/4(b)(iv)号决定)。在 57 个采用修订格式提供 2010 年数据的国家中,有 54 个列入有关氯氟烃的资料。
- 52. 在报告了数据的 113 个国家中,有 56 个指出,已经出台了配额制度,84 个国家建议进口商注册成为一项要求。回收的 HCFC-22 共计 38,890.3 ODP 吨,其中 38,039.2 ODP 吨得到再利用。根据报告,共有 5.062 名海关官员接受了氯氟烃方面的培训。
- 53. 共有 1,458 台回收机和 565 台再循环机正在运行。共有 11,709 名技术员获得了证书,20,833 名技术员接受了培训,1,842 名技术员培训人员接受了培训,以回收和再循环各种氯氟烃。

第四部分: 注重网络数据的国家方案报告

54. 在第六十三次会议上,执行委员会要求"秘书处与各执行机构进行磋商,以查明为何只有少数国家通过网络门户提交国家方案报告,并向委员会第六十四次会议报告结果(第 63/4(b)(i)号决定)。秘书处要求执行机构提供关于对国家方案数据报告工作做出改善善的建议。秘书处还收到了网络会议提供的资料。

- 55. 各国和各机构表示,它们想去除这一要求,以进行两次登记,对同一份文档各打印和保存一次,并使网络系统更便于用户使用。如果在可能的预算范围内,秘书处计划执行以下建议:
 - (a) 将目前的两次登记页面改为一次登记页面;
 - (b) 查询数据时,用户提供识别码和密码;
 - (c) 允许更改用户识别码和密码;
 - (d) 添加打印和保存功能:
 - (e) 允许获得之前的数据报告;
 - (f) 通知国家臭氧机构已收到最终意见;
 - (g) 增加一种表示最终意见的选项,以及在提交最终意见前提交附件的选项,使数据在最终意见提交前的若干时间段内得以更新;
 - (h) 将制冷剂管理计划/最终淘汰管理计划/氟氯烃淘汰管理计划分开,并设计一个停止报告的选项;
 - (i) 能够在线自动计算总额;
 - (j) 确保在线期间能更改数据报告年;
 - (k) 确保首次录入时能更改日期;
 - (I) 在线期间允许显示保存的备注。
- 56. 秘书处将补充任何其他有助于更好地利用网络报告系统的建议。秘书处对其国家方案数据报告实行集中管理,以便更好地处理各国和各机构在提交国家方案数据时遇到的问题。截至今年年底,将尽可能地修订国家方案报告,以便促进 2011 年数据的报告系统。

第五部分:存在执行拖延及需要特殊情况报告的项目

57. 有 15 个正在执行的项目被归于执行拖延的项目类别,并可能列入委员会的项目取消程序。存在执行拖延的项目包括: (一)预计将于超过 12 个月后完成的项目,和/或(二)在项目批准后的 18 个月内未付款。按执行和双边机构分列的拖延执行项目如表 11 所示: 开发计划署(5 个); 环境规划署(2 个); 工发组织(2 个); 世界银行(1 个); 加拿大(1 个)和法国(1 个)。尚未收到以色列(1 个)、日本(1 个)和葡萄牙(1 个)的报告。拖延最常见的原因与外界因素相关(5 个)。

解决拖延原因过程中取得的进展

58. 执行和双边机构在其报告中提出,在解决拖延问题的过程中已取得了不同程度的进展。在第六十三次会议上列出的存在拖延的项目中有 1 个现已完成(附件三)。1 个项目取得了一定进展,或者解决了执行有延误项目的问题,可能将其排除在今后报告的执行有延误的项目之外(附件四)。

取得一定进展的项目

59. 有 7 个项目被列入取得"一定进展"的类别,其执行和双边机构表示将继续对这些项目进行监测(附件五)。尽管取得了进展,但应该指出的是,必须根据第 32/4 号决定继续监测三年以前核准的项目。因此,在最终完成之前,不能将这些项目排除在监测清单之外,尽管可能已取得了进展。所以建议继续对这些项目进行监测。

未取得进展的项目一可能取消函

60. 有 1 个项目自第六十三次会议以来就没有取得进展(附件六)。根据现行程序,基金秘书处将以该项目没有取得进展为依据,对它发出可能取消函。

将向第六十四次会议报告的项目

61. 应向第六十四次会议报告 2 个项目的执行情况(附件七)。

需提交补充情况报告的项目

62. 体制建设、哈龙库、海关培训、回收和再循环以及示范项目不受项目取消程序的制约。然而,执行委员会已决定继续对其开展适当的监测(第 36/14(b)号决定)。在第六十三次会议上,执行委员会要求提交 9 份补充情况报告。法国尚未就其执行的一个项目提交补充情况报告。要求提交此类情况报告的条件是,自上一次报告以来没有任何进展迹象,和/或报告称执行过程中存在其他障碍。按要求有 4 个项目向第六十五次会议提交补充情况报告(附件八)。

氟氯烃淘汰管理计划制定

63. 执行委员会第六十三次会议要求就氟氯烃淘汰管理计划发展项目提交 7 份补充情况报告。要求提交此类情况报告的条件是,自上一次报告以来没有任何进展迹象,以及/或者报告称执行过程中存在其他障碍。按要求有 3 个项目向第六十五次会议提交补充情况报告(附件九)。

Annex I

DETAILED ANALYSIS OF THE STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION IN COUNTRIES SUBJECT TO DECISIONS OF THE PARTIES ON COMPLIANCE AND THOSE AT RISK OF NON-COMPLIANCE

1. Annex I presents the detailed analysis of the status of implementation in countries subject to decisions of the Parties on compliance and those at risk of non-compliance. The data tables in Appendixes I-VI indicate whether a country has received a total phase-out agreement for a specific controlled substance. The analysis of halons (Appendix II) indicates whether a halon banking activity has been approved. Halon banking guidelines require that regulations facilitating production and import bans are established within six months of the establishment of a reclamation centre (decision 18/22). The methyl bromide analysis (Appendix III) indicates further whether a country has received funding for a phase-out to meet the 2005 control measures. Appendices IV and V present information on the carbon tetrachloride (CTC) and methyl chloroform (TCA) phase-out, respectively. Appendix VI provides information on latest HCFC consumption only, as the baseline will not be established until after 2010.

ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR CFCs (Appendix I)

- 2. Countries have been grouped into two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 85 per cent baseline reduction target of 2007 that applies until December 2009; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target.
 - (a) Countries at risk of not achieving the 85 per cent CFC baseline reduction
- 3. This category consists of two countries, which may need to achieve additional CFC phase-out amounting to 294.9 ODP tonnes by 2007 in order to comply with the 85 per cent reduction target. Of these two countries, one was to receive projects with phase-out in the 2011 business plans.
- 4. The two countries that may require additional actions to achieve the 85 per cent reduction are Bangladesh and Iraq. All countries currently eligible for Fund assistance have national CFC phase-out agreements with the Executive Committee, which contain a phase-out schedule that is consistent with the targets in the Montreal Protocol. All of the countries that are at risk have received support from the Executive Committee to address their compliance needs.
 - (b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target
- 5. This category consists of 50 countries, including 26 LVC countries, which may need to achieve additional CFC phase-out amounting to 4,312 ODP tonnes by 2010 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction target. Of these 50 countries, three have phase-out projects included in the 2011 business plans.
- 6. Of the 50 countries, the Executive Committee has approved national CFC phase-out agreements for 44 countries including 22 LVC countries. Two countries (the Republic of Korea and the United Arab Emirates) have agreed not to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund. The remaining four countries do not have projects for complete phase-out of CFC or included in the 2011-2014 business plans including Angola, Ethiopia, Somalia and Timor-Leste. The CFC TPMP for these countries will be integrated into HPMPs according to decision 60/5(d).

ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR HALONS (Appendix II)

7. Seventy-five countries have reported no consumption of halons between 1995 and 2010.

- 8. Sixty-one countries have received support for halon banking activities or phase-out agreements. This includes those countries participating in regional halon banks. Halon banking is presumed to be the last funded activity in the halon consumption sector for most countries but there are some halon phase-out activities that are part of multi-sectoral phase-out agreements.
- 9. Countries have been grouped into the following two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 50 per cent reduction target of 2005 that applies until December 2009; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target.
 - (a) Countries at risk of not achieving the 50 per cent baseline reduction for halons
- 10. All countries are in compliance with the 50 per cent halon baseline reduction target.
 - (b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target
- 11. This category consists of six countries that may need to phase-out additional halons amounting to 2,163 ODP tonnes by 2010 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction targets. These countries have received support from the Multilateral Fund, except the Republic of Korea and the United Arab Emirates. The Republic of Korea and the United Arab Emirates have agreed not to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund.

ANALYSIS OF COMPLIANCE FOR METHYL BROMIDE (Appendix III)

- 12. This section presents the analysis for compliance with methyl bromide control measures. It should be noted that all data reported and used in this analysis relate to controlled use only, which means that the data exclude quarantine and pre-shipment (QPS). All of the 144 Article 5 countries that have ratified the Copenhagen Amendment have reported complete baseline data. Of these 144 countries, 57 reported zero for both the baseline consumption and the latest consumption.
- 13. Ninety-nine Article 5 countries have received support from the Multilateral Fund for methyl bromide activities and/or projects. This includes projects that will lead to a complete phase-out of methyl bromide in 60 of these countries, partial phase-out in an additional 10, and other forms of assistance received by 29.
- 14. Countries have been grouped into the following two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 20 per cent reduction target of 2005 that applies until December 2014; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix III identifies those countries that have not ratified the Copenhagen Amendment.
 - (a) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 20 per cent MB baseline reduction target
- 15. This category consists of only one country, Turkmenistan. This country may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 0.02 ODP tonnes in order to comply with the 20 per cent reduction targets. Turkmenistan has approved projects that will lead to complete phase-out of methyl bromide.
 - (b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 phase-out target
- 16. This category consists of 30 countries that may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 2,281 ODP tonnes by 2015 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction targets. Of the 30 countries, 20 countries have approved projects that will lead to complete phase-out of methyl bromide. Eight countries may need additional assistance from the Multilateral Fund to achieve the phase-out of methyl bromide by 2015. The remaining two countries (South Africa and Singapore) are

currently not eligible to receive funding from the Multilateral Fund. It should be noted that South Africa could receive funding for HCFC phase-out.

CARBON TETRACHLORIDE (CTC) (Appendix IV)

- 17. This section presents the analysis of compliance with CTC control measures. All data reported and used in this analysis are those related to controlled use only, which excludes feedstock. Reported CTC consumption was not differentiated by specific end use, such as solvents, process agents and laboratory use.
- 18. Of the 146 countries with reported baseline data, 89 reported zero both for the baseline and the latest consumption.
- 19. Countries have been grouped into the following two categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 85 per cent reduction target that applies until December 2009; and (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix IV notes those countries that have not ratified the London Amendment.
 - (a) <u>Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 85 per cent CTC baseline reduction target</u>
- 20. Two countries might not achieve compliance with the 85 per cent reduction: Ecuador and Panama. These countries would need to phase out a total of 0.09 ODP tonnes to meet the 85 per cent reduction by 2005.
- 21. Ecuador is the only country that may not need additional assistance to meet the 100 per cent reduction target for CTC since its consumption is for laboratory uses. Panama has not received assistance from the Multilateral Fund and its consumption is for laboratory uses as well.
 - (b) Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 2010 phase-out target
- 22. This category consists of 12 countries that may need to phase out additional CTC amounting to 147.1 ODP tonnes to meet the 100 per cent reduction by 2010. Nine of the 12 countries have received funding for CTC phase-out agreements or projects from the Multilateral Fund. The Republic of Korea has agreed not to receive CTC funding from the Multilateral Fund. Ecuador may not need additional assistance to meet the 100 per cent reduction target for CTC since its consumption is for laboratory uses. Panama has not received assistance from the Multilateral Fund and its consumption is for laboratory uses as well.

METHYL CHLOROFORM (TCA) (Appendix V)

- 23. This section presents the analysis for compliance with TCA control measures. Of the 146 countries that have reported baseline data, 103 reported zero both for the baseline and the latest consumption.
- 24. Countries have been grouped into three categories: (a) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 30 per cent reduction target that applies until December 2009; (b) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 70 per cent reduction target of 2010; and (c) those whose latest consumption exceeds the 2015 100 per cent phase-out target. Appendix V specifies those countries that have not ratified the London Amendment.

- (a) <u>Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 30 per cent TCA baseline reduction target</u>
- 25. All countries are in compliance with the 30 per cent TCA baseline reduction target.
 - (b) <u>Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 70 per cent TCA baseline reduction target</u>
- 26. This category consists of two countries: Bangladesh and the Republic of Korea. These countries may need to phase out additional TCA amounting to 27.6 ODP tonnes by 2010 in order to comply with the 70 per cent reduction targets. Bangladesh has received funding for agreement or projects for complete phase-out of TCA. The Republic of Korea is not eligible for funding from the Multilateral Fund.
 - (c) <u>Countries whose latest consumption exceeds the 100 per cent TCA baseline reduction target</u>
- 27. This category consists of seven countries that may need to meet additional combined reduction amounting to 278.5 ODP tonnes by 2015 in order to comply with the 100 per cent reduction target. Six of those seven countries have received funding for TCA phase-out agreements or projects from the Multilateral Fund. The remaining country (the Republic of Korea) is not eligible to receive TCA funding from the Multilateral Fund.

HCFCs (Appendix VI)

28. Appendix VI includes an analysis of the latest consumption data on HCFCs and indicates whether the country had received HPMP preparation funding, the number of investment projects approved, the number of demonstration projects approved, total phase-out approved in ODP tonnes and activities planned in the 2011 business plans. The baseline data will not be available until 2011 when both of the baseline years (2009 and 2010) will have been reported. All countries have received HPMP preparation funds. Information was provided for HPMPs approved to-date and those submitted to the 64th meeting and the duration covered by the HPMP (such as, HPMP approved to achieve the 10 per cent reduction in 2015 or to achieve the 35 per cent reduction in 2020, for example).
