COMPLETED PROJECTS WITH BALANCES, FOLLOW-UP ON DECISION 29/9

#### Introduction

- 1. At its 28<sup>th</sup> Meeting, the Executive Committee noted in considering the Consolidated Progress Report that about US \$9 million was being held by the implementing agencies for projects that had been completed over a year previously. The Committee then decided that project balances should be returned to the Fund by, at the latest, 12 months after project completion and requested implementing agencies to report to the Committee if they could not close the accounts on a project within 12 months after project completion and to report cases where they could not liquidate their remaining obligations within 12 months of project completion (Decision 28/7).
- 2. At the 29<sup>th</sup> Meeting, UNDP was the only implementing agency that reported information (as at March 1999) on projects that were completed through December 1997. The Executive Committee took the following decision:
  - (a) To take note with appreciation of the report of UNDP;
  - (b) To request a report from each agency, to be submitted to the Thirtieth Meeting of the Executive Committee, on the extent to which the implementing agencies' share of the project balances from projects completed through 1998 has been obligated;
  - (c) That where there were still balances that had not been committed or obligated for projects completed by December 1997, those amounts should be made available for utilisation by the Executive Committee at its Thirtieth Meeting.
- 3. The Secretariat requested reports from all implementing agencies and sent reminders. UNDP indicated that it would not be able to provide a report to this meeting because of UNDP's move to a new financial accounting system.
- 4. UNEP, UNIDO and the World Bank provided data according to a format developed by the Fund Secretariat. The reports of UNEP and UNIDO are presented in Annexes I and II, respectively. The World Bank provided two tables: one table for all of its completed projects through 1998 with balances (Annex III) and one for its Chilean auction programme (Annex IV).
- 5. The reports are provided on a project by project basis. They include information such as the status of the project (completed (COM) or financially completed (FIN)), the project code, the project title, the date the project was approved, the date the project was completed, the level of approved funding, the latest level of funds disbursed, the unliquidated obligations, the level of funds to be returned to the 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting, and the remaining un-obligated balances.

#### **Summary of data**

6. Table 1 summarises the results of the data contained in the annexes.

- 7. A review of the data provided by UNEP; UNIDO and the World Bank indicated that:
  - Significant un-obligated balances remain (US \$8,103,213);
  - Project budget overruns are projected (most are less than US \$1000 but four exceed this amount);
  - Funds are being returned (US \$6,168,085)

#### <u>Un-obligated balances</u>

- 8. Un-obligated balances are balances that are neither being returned to the 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting for reprogramming nor are they funds that have been committed or obligated by the implementing agencies to be disbursed in the future. Table 1 indicates that there are US \$8.1 million in unobligated balances for projects completed through 1998.
- 9. In general, the level of un-obligated balances is more than US \$1,000 per project. The largest remaining balances for UNIDO projects is for one with an un-obligated balance over US \$200,000. This is the Hefei Meiling refrigeration project in China, which has a remaining balance of US \$241,786. This project was completed in December 1998.
- 10. The World Bank has four projects with remaining un-obligated balances of over US \$200,000. Those projects with the largest remaining un-obligated balances are: the MCMC refrigeration project in Egypt (remaining balance of US \$2.1 million, the Subros Ltd. refrigeration project in India (US \$474,967), the PT Inter Foamindosentra project in Indonesia (US \$220,771), and the Halon servicing, maintenance and recovery project in Malaysia (US \$207,760).

#### Project budget overruns

- 11. There are 22 projects that are projected to have project budget overruns or already have such overruns. Most of the budget overruns are for less that US \$1000. The World Bank does not have any projects with a budget overrun.
- 12. UNEP has three projects with project budget overruns. Two of those projects have overruns that exceed US \$1000. Those projects are the country programme preparation of Nepal, which has a budget overrun of US \$6,000, and the methyl bromide information kit, which has a budget overrun of US \$2,086.
- 13. UNIDO has 16 projects with project overruns of less than US \$1000. However, the following UNIDO projects have projected budget overruns over US \$1000: Elgin Maquinas S.A. refrigeration project in Brazil (projected overrun of US \$3,177) and Al-Yaman aerosol project in Syria (US \$1,039).
- 14. Decision 17/22(c) states, <u>inter alia</u>, that cost savings resulting from investment project implementation should not be permitted to be offset against cost overruns. Therefore, funds being returned to the 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting cannot be used to offset cost overruns.

#### Funds being returned for reprogramming

- 15. Table 1 also shows that US \$6,168,085 is being returned to the 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting for reprogramming.
- 16. US \$386,174 of the US \$481,365 being returned by UNEP are from balances from regional networks. They represent unspent funds for the salaries of the network manager and regional co-ordinators where recruitment has taken substantial time. Additionally, some network took time to become established such that not all the approved funds were fully used. Expenditure also varies year on year according to where meetings are held and how much additional travel is required.
- 17. US \$208,532 of the US \$336,091 being returned by UNIDO is from the Hualing refrigerator project in China. Most of these funds are being returned because the equipment purchased was locally purchased instead of internationally purchased (which resulted in savings) and an additional transnational ownership was identified (which resulted in a reduced grant).
- 18. Of the US \$5,350,629 being returned by the World Bank, the largest amount of funds being returned is for the Sanyo project in Thailand. The implementation of the Phase I and II projects will result in the return of US \$1,599,278. The large sums being returned from the Sanyo project is a result of a fire at its factory (as reported in the Bank's previous progress report). As a result, the company was not able to produce sufficient receipts, etc. for reimbursement and the Bank's financial agent did not release the funds.
- 19. The Bank is returning US \$607,000 from the PT Hanjaya Mandal Sampoerna and P.T. Djarum tobacco project in Indonesia. The funds returned from the tobacco project was a result of one of the two companies choosing an alternative technology and withdrawing from the project instead of seeking an additional approval from the Executive Committee.

#### RECOMMENDATION

- 20. The Sub-Committee on Monitoring, Evaluation, and Finance may wish to consider:
  - (a) Noting with appreciation the reports of UNEP, UNIDO and the World Bank and the return (excluding agency fees) of: US \$481,365 from UNEP, US \$336,091 from UNIDO, and US \$5,350,629 from the World Bank against approved projects as indicated in Annexes I, II, III and IV of this document on a project by project basis;
  - (b) Seeking explanations during the Sub-Committee Meeting for the US \$8.1 million in remaining un-obligated balances from projects completed through 1998; and
  - (c) Noting that UNDP was unable to provide a timely financial report due to the implementation of a new corporate-wide financial, accounting, and project reporting system.
