1. In accordance to decision 30/8 (e), the draft Revised Format for Terminal Reports and Extension Requests for Institutional Strengthening Projects, as contained in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/30/7, Annex II, was presented to the following Regional Network Meetings of Ozone Officers:

- 2. During the above meetings, discussions were held in order to obtain the opinions of the Ozone Officers with regard to the revision of the format proposed. Generally, the formats were accepted. Some changes were proposed which are incorporated in the present revised version. There were no changes proposed by the implementing agencies.
- 3. The standard procedure for preparing the Terminal Report and the Plan of Action will be that the Ozone Office prepares a draft and sends it for comments to the implementing agency concerned, which after sharing the comments made with the Ozone Office, would forward the consolidated Terminal Report and Extension Request for consideration to the Multilateral Fund Secretariat.
- 4. The format containing the revisions made following the discussions of the Network Meetings is attached as Annexes I and II. Two countries, Mexico and Uruguay, have already used the new format in presenting their Terminal Report and Extension Request to the Multilateral Fund Secretariat; their experiences have been taken into account as well as deliberations in the Secretariat aiming at incorporating the essence of decision 30/7 and simplifying the format in order to avoid unnecessary reporting work.
- 5. The Secretariat will place the format in its web site once it is approved by the Executive Committee.
