Addendum

PROJECT PROPOSAL: GEORGIA

This addendum is issued to add the following paragraphs 13 bis and 13 ter; and to replace paragraph 14:

13 bis. The Fund Secretariat and UNIDO concluded their discussion on the project proposal. The project cost was agreed at US \$220,000 to phase out 6 ODP tonnes of MB, representing the entire MB consumption in soil fumigation in the country. Taking into consideration that the current surface area fumigated with methyl bromide is only 18 ha but additional 400 ha of greenhouses could be also be fumigated with methyl bromide, the project is therefore designed as a technical assistance project, rather than an investment project, to demonstrate four alternative technologies and prevent an increase use of methyl bromide in greenhouses.

13 ter. Through the implementation of the this technical assistance programme, the Government of Georgia commits to a permanent national reduction in aggregate consumption of controlled uses of methyl bromide from 10.8 ODP tonnes in 2002 to 4.8 ODP tonnes (remaining consumption in grain storage) in 2005. In addition, Georgia commits to sustain this phase out of methyl bromide through the use of import restrictions and other policies it may deem necessary.

RECOMMENDATION

14. The Executive Committee may wish to consider the project proposal on the basis of the comments presented in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/37/37 and Add.1.
