**Addendum**

**PROJECT PROPOSALS: DOMINICAN REPUBLIC**

This addendum is issued to:

- **Add** the following paragraph:

14 bis. The Secretariat and UNIDO have agreed on the total project cost at US \$922,900 for the complete phase out of MB used as a soil fumigant (141 ODP tonnes). Of this amount, US \$369,160 would be required for the phase out of 60.6 ODP tonnes representing the amount of MB needed to achieve the 20 reduction in the MB baseline consumption by 2005.

- **Replace** paragraph 15 **with** the following:

15. The Executive Committee may wish to consider the project proposal on the basis of the comments presented in document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/38/30 and Add.1. The Executive Committee may also wish to consider whether to approve for funding the total consumption of MB used as a soil fumigant (141 ODP tonnes) on the understanding that:

- (a) the Government of Dominican Republic undertook to permanently sustain this reduction in the consumption of MB through implementation of the project and the use of import restrictions and other policies that it might deem necessary;
- (b) no additional funding will be requested by the Government of Dominican Republic for the phase out of MB; and
- (c) UNIDO will report to the Executive Committee once the project had been completed and the phase-out under the project had been achieved.
