

UNDP WORK PROGRAMME FOR 2004

COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE FUND SECRETARIAT

1. In its Work Programme for 2004, UNDP is requesting approval at the 42nd Meeting of US \$630,500 for project preparation and other projects plus agency support costs of US \$52,912. The activities proposed in UNDP's 2004 Work Programme are presented in Table 1 below:

I. Projects for blanket approval

2. The Fund Secretariat recommends blanket approval of the projects listed above in Section IA at the level of funding indicated in Table 1.

II. Project for individual consideration

<u>Jamaica</u>: <u>Technical assistance umbrella project to phase out ODS solvent use (re-submission)</u> (US \$25,000)

Project description

- 3. The purpose of the project is to provide training and technical assistance to distributors of ODS solvents to familiarise them with conversion to the use of non-ODS alternatives.
- 4. The Government of Jamaica will support this training initiative through the implementation of a regulatory programme that controls imports. It will also develop an awareness creation programme, targeted at users in the solvents sector, including potential users of ODS sterilants in hospitals. The programme will supplement existing awareness-raising activities underway through its Institutional Strengthening project.
- 5. It is expected that the training, regulatory and awareness-raising efforts will result in indirect elimination of the remaining ODS solvent consumption with the exception of any residual use in laboratories.

Fund Secretariat's comments

6. This project was first submitted for consideration at the 41st Meeting of the Executive Committee. However, it was deferred to enable UNDP to address some issues relating to its cost. These issues have been addressed by UNDP as indicated above, resulting in a funding level of US \$25,000 as opposed to US \$145,375 as originally requested. The cost of the project has been agreed between the Secretariat and UNDP.

Fund Secretariat's recommendation

7. The Fund Secretariat recommends approval of the technical assistance project to phase out ODS solvent use in Jamaica at the level of funding indicated in Table 1 on the basis that Jamaica will not seek any additional funding for phase out of ODS in the solvent sector.

Activities for consideration at the 42nd Executive Committee Meeting (29th March - 2nd April 2003, Montreal)

I. SUMMARY

1. UNDP has submitted its 2004 Business Plan, comprised of both a series of tables and a detailed narrative, for consideration at the 42nd Meeting of the Executive Committee in March 2004. As a complementary submission, this work programme document contains a request for US\$ 683,412 (including support cost for US\$ 52,912) of funding to be submitted for consideration at the 42nd Meeting of Executive Committee.

II. BUSINESS PLAN RELATIONSHIP

- 2. As indicated in UNDP's 2004 Business Plan, UNDP will continue or will start preparation of activities in the servicing sector in 8 countries, individual sector projects in 9 countries and multiyear projects in 3 countries. These activities will represent US \$12,587,954 within the context of the regular programme, and will eliminate 1,080 ODP tonnes.
- 3. The funds required during 2004 for preparation of these projects will be US \$485,900 (including support cost of US\$ 33,900), A total of US\$ 274,662 (including support cost of US\$ 19,162) are being submitted to the 42nd Executive Committee Meeting in this Work Programme (see Annex 1).
- 4. In addition to funds for project preparation, a total of US\$ 408.750 (including a support cost of US\$ 33,750) is being submitted to the 42nd Executive Committee Meeting for the implementation of 5 non-investment activities included in the UNDP's 2004 Business Plan. These projects were initially submitted to the 41st Executive Committee Meeting and deferred to this meeting for different reasons.
- 5. Detailed information on the activities submitted for consideration at the 42nd Executive Committee Meeting is presented in the next two sections.

III. PROJECT PREPARATION RELATED TO PLANNED INDIVIDUAL PROJECTS, PLANNED MULTIYEAR PROJECTS AND PROJECTS IN THE SERVICING SECTOR

- 7. The preparation funds requested for servicing activities are summarized as follows:
 - One (1) request to start formulation of investment components of RMP developed in cooperation with UNEP: Cape Verde (US\$ 24,000).
 - Two (2) requests to formulate investment components of RMP update being prepared by UNEP: Belize (US\$ 20,000) and Guinea Conakry (US\$ 20,000).
 - Two (2) requests to finalize formulation of investment components in countries where preparation funds were approved for UNDP during 2003 but the activities have not been completed yet: Barbados (US\$ 8,000), Suriname (US\$12,000).
- 8. It should also be noted that funds for the preparation of RMP updates for Bahrain, Fiji and Nepal included in the BP 2004, will be requested to the 43rd Meeting of the Executive Committee, when all the requirements related to these requests are fulfilled (Fiji and Nepal will be prepared in cooperation with UNEP).

IV. NON-INVESTMENT ACTIVITIES

9. The following table summarizes all CP and IS requests contained in UNDP's 2004 Business Plan. As shown in the right column of the table, no activities related to CP or IS need to be funded at the 42nd Meeting of Executive Committee.
