基金秘书处的评论和建议

1. 开发计划署在其 2004 年工作方案中请求第四十二次会议核准提供 630 500 美元,以用于项目编制和其他项目,并为此核准 52 912 美元的机构支助费用。下面的表 1 开列了开发计划署 2004 年工作方案拟议举办的活动:

一. 供一揽子核准的项目

2. 基金秘书处建议一揽子核准以上一A节开列的项目,供资数额如表1所示。

二. 供个别审议的项目

牙买加: 旨在逐步停止使用 ODS 溶剂的技术援助总括项目(重新提交)(25 000 美元)

项目介绍

- 3. 项目的宗旨是为 ODS 溶剂分销商开展培训和提供技术援助, 使之了解转用非 ODS 替代品的情况。
- 4. 牙麦加政府将支助这一培训倡议,为此而执行一项管理方案,对进口进行管制。还将制定一项提高认识方案,其针对对象是溶剂行业的用户,包括医院中潜在的 ODS 消毒剂用户。方案将通过其加强体制项目,对进行之中的现有提高认识活动形成补充。
- 5. 培训、管理和提高认识努力可望间接消除剩余的 ODS 溶剂消费现象,但实验室中仍将残存一些使用活动。

基金秘书处的评论

6. 本项目第一次是提交给执行委员会第 41 次会议审议的。但为了使开发计划署解决与 其费用有关的一些问题,审议时间推迟。如上所示,开发计划署已解决这些问题,提出的 供资数额为 25 000 美元,而不是最初申请的 145 375 美元。秘书处和开发计划署已就项目 费用达到一致。

基金秘书处的建议

7. 基金秘书处建议核准旨在在牙麦加逐步停止使用 ODS 溶剂的技术援助项目,核准的供资数额如表 1 所示,但前提是牙麦加不再为溶剂行业逐步淘汰 ODS 寻求任何进一步的供资。

I. SUMMARY

1. UNDP has submitted its 2004 Business Plan, comprised of both a series of tables and a detailed narrative, for consideration at the 42nd Meeting of the Executive Committee in March 2004. As a complementary submission, this work programme document contains a request for US\$ 683,412 (including support cost for US\$ 52,912) of funding to be submitted for consideration at the 42nd Meeting of Executive Committee.

II. BUSINESS PLAN RELATIONSHIP

- 2. As indicated in UNDP's 2004 Business Plan, UNDP will continue or will start preparation of activities in the servicing sector in 8 countries, individual sector projects in 9 countries and multiyear projects in 3 countries. These activities will represent US \$12,587,954 within the context of the regular programme, and will eliminate 1,080 ODP tonnes.
- 3. The funds required during 2004 for preparation of these projects will be US \$485,900 (including support cost of US\$ 33,900), A total of US\$ 274,662 (including support cost of US\$ 19,162) are being submitted to the 42nd Executive Committee Meeting in this Work Programme (see Annex 1).
- 4. In addition to funds for project preparation, a total of US\$ 408.750 (including a support cost of US\$ 33,750) is being submitted to the 42nd Executive Committee Meeting for the implementation of 5 non-investment activities included in the UNDP's 2004 Business Plan. These projects were initially submitted to the 41st Executive Committee Meeting and deferred to this meeting for different reasons.
- 5. Detailed information on the activities submitted for consideration at the 42nd Executive Committee Meeting is presented in the next two sections.

III. PROJECT PREPARATION RELATED TO PLANNED INDIVIDUAL PROJECTS, PLANNED MULTIYEAR PROJECTS AND PROJECTS IN THE SERVICING SECTOR

- 7. The preparation funds requested for servicing activities are summarized as follows:
 - One (1) request to start formulation of investment components of RMP developed in cooperation with UNEP: Cape Verde (US\$ 24,000).
 - Two (2) requests to formulate investment components of RMP update being prepared by UNEP: Belize (US\$ 20,000) and Guinea Conakry (US\$ 20,000).
 - Two (2) requests to finalize formulation of investment components in countries where preparation funds were approved for UNDP during 2003 but the activities have not been completed yet: Barbados (US\$ 8,000), Suriname (US\$12,000).
- 8. It should also be noted that funds for the preparation of RMP updates for Bahrain, Fiji and Nepal included in the BP 2004, will be requested to the 43rd Meeting of the Executive Committee, when all the requirements related to these requests are fulfilled (Fiji and Nepal will be prepared in cooperation with UNEP).
