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Addendum

STATUS/PROSPECTS OF ARTICLE 5 COUNTRIES IN ACHIEVING COMPLIANCE WITH THE CONTROL MEASURES OF THE MONTREAL PROTOCOL

Note that subsequent data and information indicate that:

- the 10.6 ODP tonnes of halon consumption for Cameroon in Annex II should be replaced with 1.180 ODP tonnes and Cameroon should be able to achieve its 50% reduction in 2005 based on updated Article 7 data. This would impact the executive summary, halon analysis in Part I and references to Cameroon in Part II;
- the 0.91 ODP tonnes of methyl bromide consumption for Bahrain in Annex III should be replaced with 0.0 ODP tonnes based on updated Article 7 data. This would impact the executive summary and the methyl bromide analysis in Part I. Recommendation 2b should also be removed; and
- the World Bank has informed that CTC will be addressed in the project preparation for TCA. This would impact the executive summary and the CTC analysis in Part I.
 Recommendation 2c should also be removed.
