FINAL 2004 ACCOUNTS

1. At its 46th Meeting, the Executive Committee considered the provisional accounts of the Multilateral Fund for the year 2004 (UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/46/38 and Corr.1), which were presented by the Treasurer. The Executive Committee took note of the provisional accounts for the year 2004 and noted that the final 2004 accounts would be submitted to the Committee at its 47th Meeting.

2. Schedules 1.1 to 1.7 attached to this document constitute the final 2004 accounts of the Fund as recorded in the UNEP system. The 2004 accounts have been audited and are awaiting signature of the management letter by the UN Board of Auditors. The Treasurer will bring to the attention of the Executive Committee any observations and subsequent material changes in the final accounts, if any.

3. The attached 2004 final accounts are based on the following submissions from the implementing agencies:

(a) UNDP's provisional accounts were submitted to the Treasurer and are recorded as such in the final 2004 accounts. UNDP has submitted its 2004 final accounts after the closing of the UNEP accounts. Some minor adjustments are required in the UNDP 2004 schedule and will be recorded by the Treasurer in the 2005 year end accounts as a prior year adjustment.

Pre-session documents of the Executive Committee of the Multilateral Fund for the Implementation of the Montreal Protocol are without prejudice to any decision that the Executive Committee might take following issue of the document.

For reasons of economy, this document is printed in a limited number. Delegates are kindly requested to bring their copies to the meeting and not to request additional copies.

- (b) UNIDO's final accounts were submitted to the Treasurer prior to the closing of the UNEP 2004 final accounts and are recorded in them. UNIDO has also submitted their 2004 audited accounts. Some minor adjustments are required in the UNIDO 2004 schedule and will be made by the Treasurer in the 2005 year end accounts as a prior year adjustment.
- (c) UNEP's final accounts were submitted to the Treasurer prior to the closing of the UNEP final accounts and are recorded in these accounts pending the UNEP management letter.
- (d) The World Bank submitted to the Treasurer audited accounts together with the letter of the board of auditors and are recorded in the UNEP 2004 final accounts.
