AIRPORT / DOWNTOWN / AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

Different services of bus and shuttle operate between Montreal - Pierre Elliot Trudeau International Airport (former Dorval Airport) and downtown, at intervals of 30 minutes, from 5 a.m. to 11 p.m. at the cost of CAN\$12 for a one way trip; and CAN\$20 for round trip. The estimated travel time is 45 minutes. The tickets can be purchased at the Central Station (across the road from ICAO building). A one way taxi ride between Montréal - Pierre Elliot Trudeau International Airport (former Dorval Airport) and the downtown area costs about CAN \$31.

VISAS

Please arrange for your entry visas from the Canadian Embassy or Consulate nearest to you. The letter of invitation issued by the Secretariat should be included in your submission of request for visas. Canadian authorities do not grant visa upon arrival at the airport.
