**RESEÑA DE LAS CUESTIONES IDENTIFICADAS DURANTE EL EXAMEN DE
PROYECTOS**

Los documentos previos al período de sesiones del Comité Ejecutivo del Fondo Multilateral para la Aplicación del Protocolo de Montreal no van en perjuicio de cualquier decisión que el Comité Ejecutivo pudiera adoptar después de la emisión de los mismos.

Para economizar recursos, sólo se ha impreso un número limitado de ejemplares del presente documento. Se ruega a los delegados que lleven sus propios ejemplares a la reunión y eviten solicitar otros.

Proyectos y actividades presentadas a la 48ª Reunión del Comité Ejecutivo

Propuestas de los organismos de ejecución y bilaterales

1. El valor total de los acuerdos plurianuales (todos los tramos), los proyectos y las actividades notificados por los organismos de ejecución y bilaterales a la Secretaría del Fondo es de 74 363 909 \$EUA (incluidos los costos de apoyo al organismo, cuando corresponda). El nivel de financiación revisada que se somete a la aprobación en la 48ª Reunión se eleva a 73 407 382 \$EUA para los tramos anuales de los acuerdos plurianuales, proyectos y actividades.

Examen por la Secretaría de los proyectos y actividades propuestos

2. Tras examinar las propuestas para la financiación de proyectos y actividades, la Secretaría del Fondo recomendó la aprobación general de un total de 58 tramos anuales, proyectos y actividades por un monto de 22 554 805 \$EUA (véase el Anexo I). Se suprimieron o aplazaron treinta y nueve proyectos de inversión y otras actividades, con un valor total de 3 322 808 \$EUA, incluidos proyectos para los que no se proporcionó información adecuada o cuya admisibilidad era incierta.

3. Se ha llegado a un acuerdo con los organismos de ejecución pertinentes sobre los costos incrementales de los proyectos de inversión y de los tramos anuales de planes sectoriales y planes nacionales de eliminación, para los que se solicitó una financiación total de 47 827 440 \$EUA, y que se presentan para consideración individual (véase el Anexo II) de acuerdo con práctica habitual o porque quedan pendientes otras cuestiones no relacionadas con costos.

Situación del Fondo y asignación de recursos

4. Al 6 de marzo de 2006, los recursos del Fondo Multilateral disponibles que pueden comprometerse se elevan a 37 598 485 \$EUA. El valor de los saldos devueltos por los organismos de ejecución a la 48ª Reunión es de 828 470 \$EUA. Por consiguiente, el nivel total de recursos disponible es de 38 426 955 \$EUA (informe sobre saldos y disponibilidad de recursos, UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/48/4). El valor total de los proyectos sometidos a la aprobación de la 48ª Reunión del Comité Ejecutivo asciende a 70 084 574 \$EUA, incluidos 3 899 208 \$EUA en el marco de una contribución bilateral al Fondo, como se muestra en la tabla que figura a continuación. Por lo tanto, el Comité Ejecutivo no dispone de recursos suficientes para desembolsar toda la financiación correspondiente a los proyectos presentados en la 48ª Reunión.

5. Habida cuenta de la tabla anterior, la Secretaría hace constar lo siguiente:

- a) El total de financiación solicitada para los proyectos en los grupos 1 a 6 se eleva a 20 279 166 \$EUA, teniendo presente que el valor de proyectos presentados como contribución bilateral al Fondo (a saber, 3 899 208 \$EUA) no se deduce de los recursos disponibles para aprobaciones; y
- b) Del nivel total de financiación relacionada con tramos en el sector de producción (esto es, 45 906 200 \$EUA), 17 956 200 \$EUA corresponden al sector de producción de CFC en tres países (Argentina, 2 100 000 \$EUA; China, 13 975 000 \$EUA; y Venezuela, 1 881 200 \$EUA). Otros 27 950 000 \$EUA guardan relación con el consumo y producción de CTC en el sector de agentes de proceso en China (fase I con un nivel de financiación de 17 200 000 \$EUA; y fase II con un nivel de financiación de 10 750 000 \$EUA).

6. La Secretaría está discutiendo con los correspondientes organismos de ejecución las modalidades de financiación para todos los proyectos que podrían aprobarse en la 48ª Reunión, a fin de minimizar la incidencia que podría tener la demora de los desembolsos de dicha financiación en la ejecución de los mismos. Según los resultados de estas deliberaciones y en función de las contribuciones que pudieran recibirse antes de la 48ª Reunión, la Secretaría propondrá al Comité Ejecutivo un procedimiento para el desembolso de los fondos de todos los proyectos aprobados.

Presentación para consideración individual de propuestas de planes de gestión para la eliminación definitiva

7. El PNUD y el PNUMA, en nombre de los Gobiernos de Dominica y Saint Kitts y Nevis, respectivamente, han sometido a la consideración del Comité Ejecutivo planes de gestión para la eliminación definitiva, con objeto de eliminar completamente los CFC en los dos países. La descripción de los proyectos, los comentarios y recomendaciones de la Secretaría, así como los correspondientes acuerdos entre los dos países y el Comité Ejecutivo figuran en los documentos UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/48/29 y UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/48/38.

8. Las dos propuestas de planes de gestión para la eliminación definitiva se han preparado de conformidad con las Decisiones pertinentes del Comité Ejecutivo, concretamente las Decisiones 31/48 (actualizaciones de planes de gestión de refrigerantes) y 45/54 (planes de gestión para la eliminación definitiva en países de bajo consumo). Aunque todos los asuntos de política, técnicos y de costos se han resuelto y la Secretaría y los organismos de ejecución pertinentes han llegado a un acuerdo, la Secretaría ha elaborado una lista de los proyectos para consideración individual, dado que estos proyectos representan planes de eliminación definitiva, constan de financiación plurianual e incluyen un proyecto de acuerdo entre el Gobierno del caso y el Comité Ejecutivo.

9. De conformidad con la Decisión 45/54, unos 69 países de bajo consumo adicionales podrían presentar en los próximos años planes de gestión para la eliminación definitiva con el fin de eliminar completamente su consumo de CFC restante. Una vez concluidos sus planes de gestión de refrigerantes o las actualizaciones de los mismos, el nivel máximo de consumo restante cuya eliminación pudiera financiarse para cada país no superará el 15 por ciento de su umbral de consumo de CFC, que para estos países varía entre 0,3 y 50,0 toneladas PAO. El nivel de financiación para la eliminación del consumo restante que pudiera aprobarse fue establecido por el Comité Ejecutivo en su Decisión 45/54.

10. Habida cuenta de los niveles de consumo relativamente bajos que figuran en los planes de gestión para la eliminación definitiva, de los niveles máximos de financiación establecidos, y del número de proyectos que probablemente se presentarán, el Comité Ejecutivo pudiera decidir si desea seguir examinando cada proyecto por separado o, por el contrario, si desea encargar a la Secretaría que someta para aprobación general todos los planes de gestión para la eliminación definitiva que reciba en el futuro de países con bajo consumo, siempre que estos planes sean conformes a las políticas y decisiones pertinentes del Fondo Multilateral, no contengan cuestiones de política y todos los asuntos técnicos y de costos hayan sido convenidos entre la Secretaría y los correspondientes organismos bilaterales y/o de ejecución.
