REPORT ON BALANCES AND AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES

1. This document presents a summary of the financial adjustments indicated by the implementing agencies, and agreed by the Fund Secretariat. It includes statistical data from projects with balances held over 12 months past the completion of the project, as required by decision 28/7. The data presented are based on the reporting format developed pursuant to decision 31/2 and include both obligated and un-obligated balance amounts. Further to decision 41/92, this document also indicates the level of resources available to the Executive Committee in cash and promissory notes as recorded in the Status of Contributions (UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/49/3) plus the amount of funds returned from projects as stated in the report on balances.

### Funds being returned to the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting

- 2. Information supplied by the implementing agencies indicates that a total of US \$4,324,771, plus agency support costs, will be returned to the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting. This total amount is calculated taking into account completed projects with balances, un-obligated funds from cancelled projects, and returns from ongoing projects and adjustments (although there were no returns from ongoing projects to this meeting).
- 3. Table 1 indicates the level of funds being returned for each agency.

#### **Projects with Balances by Year of Completion**

4. Table 2 indicates the number of projects with balances that are still being held by the implementing agencies, and the years in which the projects were completed. It shows that implementing agencies had balances totalling US \$27,477,995 for projects completed up to and including 31 May 2005 (at least 12 months previously).

- 5. At its 47<sup>th</sup> Meeting, the Executive Committee requested that the Fund Secretariat continue to monitor multi-year annual tranches in the context of documents on implementation delays and project balances (decision 47/50(b)(ii)). The World Bank holds the highest balance (US \$23,672,267) but almost all of this balance (US \$23,254,078) is attributable to multi-year annual tranches. UNIDO has total balances valued at US \$216,697 from multi-year agreements. Neither UNDP nor UNEP have balances from multi-year tranches.
- 6. UNDP has the highest number of projects with balances (68) but the lowest total level of balances, amounting to US \$792,725. The other agencies have 56 or fewer projects with balances.
- 7. All agencies have projects with balances that were completed over two years ago. Most of the funds (US \$13,702,420 of US \$14,550,486) attributed to the World Bank's eight projects were completed over two years ago. UNDP also has 37 projects with balances amounting to US \$366,760 that were also completed over two years ago.

#### **Obligated and Un-obligated Balances**

8. The level of balances classified as obligated and un-obligated for the four implementing agencies are as follows:

- 9. Of the US \$27,564,050 in balances from completed, cancelled, ongoing and transferred projects, US \$26,364,982 is obligated, meaning that these funds are expected to be spent. US \$1,199,068 in balances being held have not been obligated. Annex I presents additional information on un-obligated and obligated balances, by agency. Implementing agencies are required to report the reasons why any un-obligated (unencumbered) balances could not be returned within the required time-frame and to indicate when they will be returned (decision 31/2(a)(ii)).
- 10. UNDP has 66 completed projects, one cancelled project and one transferred project with obligated balances that range from US \$45 to US \$57,309. The overall number of projects with balances has decreased from 139 projects reported to the 48<sup>th</sup> Meeting to 68 reported to the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting, and the level of balances has decreased from US \$1.85 million to US \$0.79 million.
- 11. UNEP has two completed projects with obligated balances amounting to US \$14,468, and 54 completed projects and one ongoing project with un-obligated balances amounting to US \$1,055,219.
- 12. UNIDO has 20 completed projects with obligated balances. US \$1,478,949 of the total US \$1,885,522 held by UNIDO in obligated balances covers four projects.
- 13. The World Bank holds US \$23,672,267 in obligated balances for completed projects of which US \$23,254,078 was for multi-year projects. One of the main reasons that balances from annual tranches of multi-year projects appear in the report on balances is the short duration of the project (i.e., one year) and the definition of completion for such projects being the attainment of the agreed ODS reductions. These funds will be disbursed against actual costs when project costs are presented to the World Bank for payment. The World Bank has US \$418,189 in obligated balances from 10 completed individual projects.

#### **Agency Support Costs**

14. At its 35<sup>th</sup> Meeting, the Executive Committee requested that implementing agencies return all agency support costs associated with remaining funds from projects. If expenditures had been incurred from these costs, the implementing agencies should provide an explanation

and return the balance of funds (decision 35/13(k)). Table 4 indicates a total of US \$532,132 in agency support costs being returned to the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting.

### **Total Resources Available for the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting**

15. The status of contributions and disbursements as at 12 June 2006 indicates that the Treasurer had a negative balance available amounting to US \$3,907,245 in cash and promissory notes. The total level of balances returned by multilateral implementing agencies, including agency support costs, is US \$4,856,903. Therefore, as of 12 June 2006, the total level of resources available for approvals by the Executive Committee at its 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting is US \$949,658. However, the value of submissions to the Meeting, excluding withdrawals, is US \$22,915,048. Therefore, based on the full value of submissions received by the Fund Secretariat, there will not be sufficient resources to enable the Executive Committee to approve all projects submitted to its 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- 16. The Executive Committee may wish to:
  - (a) Note the report on balances and availability of resources contained in UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/49/4;
  - (b) Note the net level of funds being returned by the multilateral implementing agencies to the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting against project balances totalling US \$4,324,771. This includes the return of US \$650,450 from UNDP, US \$50,803 from UNEP, US \$216,855 from UNIDO, and US \$3,406,663 from the World Bank.
  - (c) Note the net level of support costs being returned by the multilateral implementing agencies to the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting against project support cost balances totalling US \$532,132. This includes the return of US \$82,209 from UNDP, US \$12,076 from UNEP, US \$26,190 from UNIDO, and US \$411,657 from the

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#### World Bank;

- (d) Note that implementing agencies had balances totalling US \$14,550,486 excluding support costs from projects completed over two years ago. This includes US \$366,760 plus support costs from UNDP, US \$258,155 plus support costs from UNEP, US \$223,151 plus support costs from UNIDO, and US \$13,702,420 plus support costs from the World Bank; and
- (e) Note that US \$949,658 (to be updated at the meeting) was available to the Executive Committee for approvals at the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting.
