Corrigendum

PROJECT PROPOSAL: CUBA

This corrigendum is issued to **replace** paragraphs 14 to 17 **with** the following paragraphs:

Issues with the current agreement

14. During the discussion of this project, UNDP brought to the Secretariat' attention an error in the table contained in the revised Agreement between the Government of Cuba and the Executive Committee approved at the 47th Meeting. As indicated in the Agreement, the maximum allowable total consumption of CFCs for 2008 is zero. However, the correct level of consumption for that year is 93.8 ODP tonnes.

RECOMMENDATION

15. The Executive Committee may wish to consider:

- (a) Noting that in the Agreement between the Government of Cuba and the Executive Committee the maximum allowable total consumption of CFCs for 2008 is 93.8 ODP tonnes; and
- (b) Approving the third and fourth tranches of the national CFC phase-out plan for the refrigeration sector for Cuba in the amount of US \$641,000 plus agency support costs of US \$48,075 for UNDP (US\$ 461,000 plus agency support costs US\$ 34,575 for the 2006 annual implementation plan and US\$ 180,000 plus agency support costs of US\$ 13,500 for the 2007 annual implementation plan).
