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执行蒙特利尔议定书 多边基金执行委员会 第五十三次会议 2007年11月26日至30日,蒙特利尔

关于资金余额和可动用资金的报告

执行蒙特利尔议定书多边基金执行委员会的会前文件不妨碍文件印发后执行委员会可能作出的任何决定。为节省经费起见,本文件印数有限。请各代表携带文件到会,不索取更多副本。

#### 导言

1. 本文件摘要介绍了由执行机构提出、并经基金秘书处同意的财务调整。本文载有第 28/7 号决定所要求的、从完成 12 个月后仍留有余额的项目收集的统计数字。本文所载数据是以按照第 31/2 号决定制定的报告格式为基础,既包括已承付余额,也包括未承付余额。根据第 41/92 号决定,本文件还介绍了捐款情况报告(UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/ 53/3)中记录的、执行委员会可动用的资金水平(现金和期票),以及余额报告中说明的各个项目退还的资金额。再加上可能在本次会议上撤销的项目和执行中项目退还的余额,本报告所涉总余额达 15,288,092 美元。

#### 将退还第五十三次会议的资金

- 2. 执行机构提供的资料显示,将向第五十三次会议退还总共 292,961 美元,外加机构支助费。计算这一数额时考虑了留有余额的已完成项目。
- 3. 表 1 开列了每个机构退还的资金额。

- 5. 在其第四十七次会议上,执行委员会请基金秘书处结合关于执行中的拖延和项目余额的文件,继续对多年期协定的年度档进行监测(第 47/50 号决定(b)(二段)。
- 6. 世界银行持有的上报余额最多(11,929,010 美元),全部来自多年期协定的年度档。环境规划署持有的余额共计 1,820,696 美元,其中 200,532 美元来自多年期协定。工发组织持有共计 835,377 美元的余额,其中 222,308 来自多年期协定。开发计划署持有的上报余额最少(703,009 美元),其中没有任何是来自多年期协定。在仍有余额的项目方面,环境规划署的项目最多(80个),其次是开发计划署(36个)、世界银行(228个)和工发组织(21个)。
- 7. 所有这些机构都有两年前即已完成但仍持有余额的项目。大多数资金(9,576,651 美元中的7,888,725 美元)都来自世界银行上报的12个两年前即已完成的项目。环境规划署有39个两年前即已完成的项目,余额共计899,062 美元。
- 8. 执委会请各机构说明,为什么三年前完成的项目仍有已承付余额。世界银行为 2003 年 12 月前完成的项目持有的余额达 3,049,354 美元。这些来自 6 个早期的多年期协定。其中最低的余额为 178,000 美元(第三十七次会议核准的马来西亚的 CFC 项目),最高的余

额为 775,117 美元 (第三十八次会议核准的菲律宾的 CFC 项目)。在核准多年期协定的下次年度档时,均认为以前各年度档的活动已经完成。在若干情况下,资金是分配给将持续几年的活动。在另一些情况下,余额是将按照灵活性条款重新分配的节省经费。世界银行表示,对于阿根廷的生产设施关闭项目,其年度计划的余额已分配给该国政府开展的与关闭生产设施 FIASA 有关的技术援助活动。这些资金被用来进行年度财务和技术审计以及其他与政府的工厂关闭措施有关的活动。

- 9. 环境规划署表示,在 2003 年底之前完成的项目仍有余额的主要原因是,在某些与政府之间有难题尚未解决的国家,例如利比里亚、几内亚比绍、尼泊尔和刚果民主共和国,难以获得某些已执行项目的最后支出报告,或者对环境规划署提出的查询做出答复的速度很慢。在一些情况下,在从联合国国家办事处收到付款确认书的时候出现拖延。关于尚未按照 2005 年履约协助方案预算支付的 193,959 美元,环境规划署表示,其中 146,864 美元是根据分包合同承付的。此外还有履约协助方案工作人员的差旅费 23,295 美元,以及 23,800 美元尚未结清的人事费。环境规划署说,大多数与会议和分包合同有关的余额仍然是承付款,有待提交最后支出报告,在某些情况下则有待提交产出。环境规划署说,它将密切监视这个问题,以获得尚未提交的报告和产出,从而加速支付尚未支付的款项。
- 10. 对于 2003 年 12 月之前完成的项目,开发计划署有 12,168 美元的已承付余额。开发计划署表示,总计 12,168 美元的余额报告之所以上报为承付款,是因为有关项目是政府执行的。由于政府尚未退还预付款的现金余额,开发计划署或是正在在退还资金之前等待政府付款,然后再把其付款退还给多边基金,或是可以由政府提交一份财务报告,要求开发计划署记录更多的支出。开发计划署将要求其国家办事处解决这些问题。
- 11. 对于 2003 年 12 月之前完成的项目,工发组织有 11,148 美元的已承付余额。持有这些余额的原因是,对开发计划署国家办事处的义务尚未结束(主要原因是 2005 和 2006 年期间的战争和政治不稳定)。工发组织正在密切注视承付款问题,但由于这个余额涉及多年期项目,预计将不会退还任何资金。

#### 已承付和未承付余额

12. 四个执行机构的已承付和未承付资金余额如下:

- 13. 已完成、已撤销和执行中项目的余额共计 15,288,092 美元,其中已承付 15,167,390 美元(意味着这些资金预计将要支出),还有 120,702 美元未承付。基金秘书处要求各执行机构提交报告,解释为什么没有在规定时限内退还未承付余额,并表明退还余额的时间(第 31/2 号决定(a)(二段)。附件一按机构开列了关于已承付和未承付余额的补充资料。
- 14. 开发计划署有 35 个已完成项目和 1 个已关闭项目,没有未承付余额。仍有余额的项目总数有所减少,向第五十二次会议报告的这类项目有 39 个,向第五十三次会议报告的则有 36 个。总余额则从 608,083 美元增至 703,009 美元。
- 15. 环境规划署有 78 个已完成项目和 2 个执行中项目,没有未承付余额。仍余额的项目总数有所增加,向第五十二次会议报告的这类项目有 76 个,向第五十三次会议报告的则有 80 个。总余额则从 185 万美元减至 182 万美元。执行委员会第 52 次会议敦促环境规划署解决 1,680,292 美元未承付余额问题,并就此向第五十三次会议提出报告。环境规划署报告说,在该机构为时两年的审计周期结束时,所有承付余额均已注销,在能够再次用于承付之前成为未承付余额。环境规划署表示,这是就未承付余额向第五十二次会议报告的理由,现在,这些数额或是已经再次用于承付,或是成为项目经费余额。
- 16. 工发组织有 20 个已完成项目和 1 个执行中项目,未承付余额为 120,702 美元。仍余额的项目总数有所增加,向第五十二次会议报告的这类项目有 18 个,向第五十三次会议报告的则有 21 个。总余额从 803,385 美元降至 835,377 美元。
- 17. 世界银行持有 11,929,010 美元的已完成项目的已承付余额,全部是多年期项目的余额。世界银行没有未承付余额。仍有余额的项目总数有所减少,向第五十二次会议报告的这类项目有 25 个,向第五十三次会议报告的则有 22 个。 总余额从 25,837,831 美元减至 11,929,010 美元。

#### 机构支助费

18. 执行委员会第三十五次会议请各执行机构全部退还与已完成项目的留存资金有关的机构支助费。如果用机构支助费支付了开支,执行机构应做出解释,并退还资金余额(第 35/31 号决定(k)段)。表 4 显示,将向第五十三次会议退还的机构支助费共计 24,787 美元。

#### 项目移交

- 19. 肯尼亚政府请求将两个全国甲基溴项目(KEN/FUM/44/INV/38 和KEN/FUM/50/INV/40)从开发计划署转给工发组织。 开发计划署表示,两笔分期付款的未支出余额为510,659美元。由于需要签署一项新的协定来把项目转给工发组织,概述文件(UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/53/15)讨论了该协定的核准问题。
- 20. 尼日尔政府请求把第四十八次会议核准的结束性淘汰管理计划项目的编制活动从开发计划署转给工发组织。由于尚未支付任何资金,将把核准的全部数额转给工发组织。
- 21. 执行委员会第 52/33 号核准了在伊朗伊斯兰共和国的计量吸入器生产中淘汰 CFC 消费的项目,但须由该国自行选择,把核准的计量吸入器改造项目或伊朗全国淘汰计划的经费减少 465,500 美元,或同时减少二者的经费,使减少额达到这个数,目的是消除资金的重复计算。执委会请工发组织向第五十三次会议汇报作出的选择。伊朗伊斯兰共和国政府已同意把计量吸入器改造项目的经费减少一半。因此,工发组织将向执行委员会第五十三次会议退还 232,750 美元的经费,并退还 17,456 美元的机构支助费。由于这一改动还涉及协定的改动,关于在项目审查期间所发现问题的概述文件(UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/53/15)也讨论了几个问题。

### 第五十三次会议可动用的资金总额

22. 截至 2007 年 10 月 22 日的捐款和支付情况表明,财务主任可动用资金余额共计 102,052,565 美元,均为现金和期票。多边执行机构退还余额总计 317,748 美元,其中包括机构支助费。因此,2007 年 10 月 22 日可供执行委员会第五十三次会议核准动用的资金总额 为 102,370,313 美元。关于项目审查期间所发现问题的概述文件(UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/53/15)参照可能核准动用的资金数额,讨论了第五十三次会议可动用的资

金问题。

#### 评论

23. 在本报告所述 1,530 万美元的项目资金余额中,大约 1,230 万美元是多年期协定的余额,其中又有 1,190 万美元来自世界银行负责执行的协定。因此,多年期协定的余额问题主要是世界银行的问题,开发计划署的多年期协定的余额是零,其他机构的多年期协定的余额不到 223,000 美元。世界银行解释说,其最老项目的大多数余额来自将用于今后活动的项目节省费用。余额问题看来主要涉及如何界定多年期协定年度档的完成,并也许涉及这些协定当初的设计,在费用节省导致年度活动费用的高估,或者活动的持续时间长达几年的情况下,所报告的完成日期与所预期的供资活动的完成时间无关,而是与核准下一档的时间有关。

### 建议

#### 24. 谨建议执行委员会:

- (a) 注意到 UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/53/4 号文件所载关于资金余额和可动用资金的报告;
- (b) 注意到多边执行机构将向第五十三次会议退还的项目余额净额为 292,961 美元。 这个数额考虑到了将补偿工发组织的 280,915 美元、开发计划署退还的 551,168 美元和环境规划署退还的 22,708 美元;
- (c) 注意到多边执行机构将向第五十三次会议退还的机构支助费余额净额为 24,787 美元。这个数额考虑到了将补偿工发组织的20,934美元、开发计划署退还的42,769 美元和环境规划署退还的2.952 美元:
- (d) 注意到多边执行机构持有的余额共计 9,576,651 美元,其中不包括来自两年前即已完成项目的机构支助费。这笔余额包括开发计划署的 119,512 美元、环境规划署的 899,062 美元、工发组织的 669,352 美元和世界银行的 7,888,725 美元:
- (e) 注意到把肯尼亚全国甲基溴项目(KEN/FUM/44/INV/38 和 KEN/FUM/50/INV/40) 的 510.659 美元经费及其机构支助费从开发计划署转给工发组织:
- (f) 注意到把尼日尔结束性淘汰管理计划项目(NER/PHA/48/PRP/17)的 12,000 美元 经费及其机构支助费从开发计划署转给工发组织;
- (g) 注意到现有 102,370,313 美元(本次会议将予以修订)可供执行委员会第五十三次会议核准动用。
