## 2008 BUSINESS PLANS AND ANNUAL TRANCHE SUBMISSION DELAYS

- **Replace** paragraph 11 **with** the following:
- 11. Submissions to the 55<sup>th</sup> Meeting also include project values, amounting to US \$86,936,001 (including US \$7,315,385 that were not in the business plans), which exceed the amount included for them in the 2008 business plans. Those activities not included in the business plans are: HPMP preparation for 29 projects (US \$6,905,112), a TPMP for Benin (US \$115,540), a MDI transition strategy for Mongolia (US \$32,700), a methyl bromide technical assistance project in Colombia (US \$43,600), a TPMP verification report technical assistance project for Kyrgyzstan (US \$22,600) and three institutional strengthening projects Jamaica (US \$60,000), Kenya (US \$75,833), and Saint Lucia (US \$60,000). If all of the submissions to the 55<sup>th</sup> Meeting are approved at the levels requested/recommended, the Executive Committee would have approved US \$35,885,595 more than the total amount included in the 2008 business plans for these projects.

• **Add** paragraphs 26 (bis) and 26 (ter) and Table 9 under the section on Forward commitments as follows:

26 (bis). Forward commitments *inter alia* consist of funding for multi-year agreements and "other standard activities" such as institutional strengthening, budget of the Fund Secretariat, Treasurer and Executive Committee meeting costs, UNEP's Compliance Assistance Programme (CAP), and the core unit costs for UNDP, UNIDO and the World Bank. Funding for "other standard activities" is based on projections in the 2008-2010 ODS phase-out plan of the Multilateral Fund.

26 (ter). Table 9 presents the total amount of forward commitments assuming that the requests submitted to the 55<sup>th</sup> Meeting are approved at the level requested. If the multi-year agreements are approved at the values submitted to the 55<sup>th</sup> Meeting, an additional US \$5.9 million would be needed to cover forward commitments. The total amount of existing commitments for the period 2009 to 2014 is US \$138.2 million.
