REPORT ON BALANCES AND AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES

Introduction

1. This document presents a summary of the financial adjustments indicated by the implementing agencies and agreed to by the Fund Secretariat. The document includes statistical data from projects with balances that have been held for over the allowable 12-month period following completion of the project, as required by decision 28/7. The data presented are based on the reporting format that has been developed pursuant to decision 31/2 and include both obligated and un-obligated balances. Further to decision 41/92(b), this document also indicates the level of resources available to the Executive Committee in cash and promissory notes as recorded in the Status of Contributions (UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/56/3), plus the amount of funds returned from projects as stated in the report on balances. With the addition of funds returned from an ongoing project and HPMP advances, the total balances addressed in this report amount to US \$1,230,604 including support costs. Although it had not been the practice to provide information on balances that may be held by bilateral agencies, the Secretariat has included some data on these in an effort to present to the Executive Committee with a complete picture of the situation.

Funds being returned to the 56th Meeting

2. Information provided by the implementing agencies indicates that a total of US \$1,124,367 excluding agency support costs will be returned to the 56th Meeting, of which a return of US \$1,055,000 is for project preparation for HCFC phase out-out management plans approved at the 54th Meeting.

3. As a follow-up to decisions 54/18 (c) and (d), 54/23 (c) and (d) and 54/28 (d) and (e), UNDP, UNEP and UNIDO have returned the full amounts approved at the 54th Meeting of the Executive Committee for the HPMP preparation advance. However, UNDP has disbursed or obligated funds for four projects, two of which were approved at the 55th Meeting (CPR/PHA/55/PRP/464 with a disbursed amount of US \$9,900 and BRA/PHA/55/PRP/283 with an obligated amount of US \$8,000), and two projects for HPMP preparation for India (funds disbursed: US \$11,700) and Iran (funds disbursed: US \$13,567) are submitted for approval at this meeting.

Projects with balances by year of completion

4. Table 2 presents the number of projects with balances that are still being held by the implementing agencies and the years in which those projects were completed. It shows that for projects completed up to and including 30 September 2007 (at least over the last 12 months) implementing agencies had balances that totalled US \$10,296,538.

- 5. At its 47th Meeting, the Executive Committee requested the Fund Secretariat to continue to monitor multi-year annual tranches in the context of documents on implementation delays and project balances (decision 47/50(b)(ii)).
- 6. The World Bank holds the highest reported balance of US \$3,651,624 all of which is attributable to multi-year annual tranches. UNDP holds a total balance of US \$1,747,948, of which US \$1,147,816 is attributable to MYAs, and UNIDO holds a total balance of US \$2,076,926, of which US \$1,301,264 is attributable to MYAs. UNEP has reported a balance of US \$2,820,040 of which US \$180,026 is attributable to MYAs. UNEP however, has the highest number of projects with balances (115) followed by UNDP (60), UNIDO (34) and the World Bank (11).
- 7. All agencies have projects that were completed over two years ago that have remaining balances. Most of the funds (US \$3,553,291 of US \$5,911,756) are attributed to the World Bank's 10 reported projects that were completed over two years ago. UNEP has 68 projects that were completed over two years ago, with balances totalling US \$1,322,165. Agencies have been asked to clarify why obligated balances remained for projects completed over three years ago.
- 8. UNEP explained that it is still experiencing difficulties in receiving final expenditures for some projects implemented in countries with difficult administrations. For institutional strengthening projects, final reports and inventory of non-expendable equipment have not been received and all requirements as set in the agreements established with the partners not satisfied to allow UNEP to record final

expenditures and liquidate obligations. In some instances, UNDP country offices effect payments on UNEP's behalf, and long delays are sometimes experienced in receiving the financial acknowledgements of these payments. Until these acknowledgments are received, UNEP cannot liquidate the obligations. UNEP's balances for projects completed over 2 years ago have been increased from US \$1.2 million to US \$1.3 million.

- 9. UNDP explained that balances totalling US \$412,783 result from projects implemented by Governments. UNDP explained that unless the balances are returned by the government, the funds cannot be returned to the Fund or reported as un-obligated balances since UNDP would have a receivable amount in its records until either the Government return the funds to UNDP, which would then be returned to the Multilateral Fund based on a financially completed status of the project, or the Government submits a financial report that would require additional expenditure to be recorded in UNDP's accounts.
- 10. UNIDO explained that out of 8 projects that have obligated balances, four are tranches of MYA projects. The remaining balances will therefore be fully utilized before the financial completion of these tranches. Most of the remaining balances are related to three projects, namely LIB/REF/32/INV/03, CPR/FOA/34/INV/376 and CPR/FOA/36/INV/387. The remaining balance on the Libyan project can be released as soon as the payment is signed by the counterpart. With respect to the two Chinese projects, as reported to previous meetings, negotiations are still ongoing with the contractor to fulfil the contractual obligations.
- 11. The World Bank's remaining obligated balance of US \$3.55 million is much smaller than that at the 55th Meeting (US \$4.25 million). The Bank specified that the US \$3.55 million balance is for tranches from the earliest Annual Plans (AP) of ten multi-year projects. As noted in the past, the assumption was that when the countries met the respective performance targets according to the agreement with the Executive Committee, the next tranche/AP would be approved. The dates of completion for these tranches were recorded accordingly in the Secretariat's Inventory when the next tranches were scheduled to be approved within a year. Nine of the 10 tranches are for national CFC phase-out plans. The funding of these tranches consists of a contribution to an allocation of funding for addressing various components of the entire National CFC phase-out plan over a period of time. In several cases as in the case of Ecuador and the Philippines, the balance is committed or partly committed to these countries. In others, the balances represent a savings that has or will be reallocated to another project component through the use of the flexibility clause in the agreements with the Executive Committee.

Obligated and un-obligated balances

12. The level of balances classified as obligated and un-obligated for the four implementing agencies are as follows:

- 13. Of the total balance of US \$10,296,538 from completed projects, US \$9,471,462 is obligated (which means that these funds are expected to be spent) and US \$825,076 has not been obligated. Implementing agencies are required to report reasons why any un-obligated balances could not be returned within the required time-frame, and to indicate when they will be returned (decision 31/2(a)(ii)).
- 14. UNDP has 60 completed projects. It has no un-obligated balances. The overall number of projects with balances has decreased from 64 projects reported to the 55th Meeting to 60 reported to the 56th Meeting. The overall level of balances has decreased from US \$2,185,375 to US \$1,747,948.
- 15. UNEP has 115 completed projects and un-obligated balances of US\$ 84,446. The overall number of projects with balances has increased from 113 projects reported to the 55th Meeting to 115 reported to the 56th Meeting. The overall level of balances increased from US \$2,776,592 to US \$2.82 million.
- 16. UNIDO has 34 completed projects, and un-obligated balances of US \$740,630. The overall number of projects with balances has decreased from 35 projects reported to the 55th Meeting to 34 reported to the 56th Meeting, and the overall level of balances has increased from US \$1,159,398 to US \$2,076,926. UNIDO explained that un-obligated balances will be returned to the MLF after financial completion of the projects.
- 17. The World Bank holds US \$3,651,624 in obligated balances for completed projects, of which all were for multi-year agreements. It has no un-obligated balances. The overall number of projects with balances has decreased from 12 projects reported to the 55th Meeting to 11 reported to the 56th Meeting, and the overall level of balances has decreased from US \$4,253,674 to US \$3,651,624. Annex I presents additional information on obligated and un-obligated balances by agency.

Agency support costs

- 18. At its 35th Meeting, the Executive Committee requested that implementing agencies return all agency support costs associated with remaining funds from completed projects. If expenditures had been incurred from these costs, the implementing agencies should provide an explanation and return the balance of funds (decision 35/13(k)). Table 4 indicates that a total of US \$123,488 in agency support costs will be returned at the 56th Meeting including US \$101,565 from the HPMP returns. It also includes a return US \$17,251 from the World Bank of from core unit funding.
- 19. As a follow-up to decisions 54/18, 54/23 and 54/28, UNDP, UNEP and UNIDO have returned the full amount approved at the 54th Meeting of the Executive Committee for the HPMP preparation support cost advance. UNDP has reported that it has disbursed or obligated Programme Support Cost (PSC) funds for four projects, of which two were approved at the last meeting (CPR/PHA/55/PRP/464 with US \$743 PSC disbursed and BRA/PHA/55/PRP/283 US \$600 PSC obligated) and two are submitted for the Committee's consideration at this meeting (HPMP project preparation for Iran (US \$1,018 PSC disbursed) and India (US \$878 PSC disbursed).)

20. Table 5 presents the balances that are being held by bilateral agencies and the years in which those projects were completed. It shows that for projects completed up to and including 30 September 2007 (at least over the last 12 months) implementing agencies had balances that totalled US \$617,117. Table 5 shows that bilateral agencies hold balances for projects completed over two years ago amounting to US \$457,254 with France holding the largest amount with an amount of US \$237,336.

21. At the last meeting France had confirmed that it had no objection to the wish of the Central African Republic to cancel its refrigerant management plan (RMP) projects (CAF/REF/34/TRA/08, CAF/REF/34/TRA/09 and CAF/REF/34/TAS/10) or to returning the remaining funds. France had not been able to specify the funds remaining under those projects. Similarly, no financial information had been provided by France in relation to the possible cancellation of the RMPs in Côte d'Ivoire (IVC/REF/24/TAS/10, IVC/REF/37/TAS/16 and IVC/REF/37/INV/17). At the last meeting, France indicated that it would clarify the position related to the transfer of funds at the 56th Meeting of the Executive Committee. No update had been provided by France on this matter to the Secretariat at the time of writing of this document.

Total resources available for the 56th Meeting

22. The status of contributions and disbursements as of 3 October 2008 indicates that the Treasurer had an available balance amounting to US \$99,836,498 in cash and promissory notes. The total level of balances returned by implementing agencies, including agency support costs and HPMP advances is US \$1,230,604. Therefore, as of 3 October 2008, the total level of resources available for approvals by the Executive Committee at its 56th Meeting is US \$101,067,102. The issue of available resources for the 56th Meeting, in light of the value of potential approvals, is addressed in the document "Overview of issues identified during project review" (UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/56/12).

COMMENTS

- 23. Of the US \$10.3 million in projects with balances in this report, about US \$6,280,730 is for MYAs and of that amount US \$3,651,674 is under World Bank implementation. As was the case in the last balances reports, the issue of balances from MYAs is therefore mostly an issue for the World Bank.
- 24. Bilateral Agencies have had the option to offset balances against future approvals or to return the balances on bilateral cooperation projects as a cash payment to the Fund. The Executive Committee may wish to consider requesting bilateral agencies to report on their disposition of these balances.
- 25. In line with decision 54/23(d) which stipulates that amounts approved in advance for project preparation submitted by UNDP to the 54th Meeting "would be deducted from any amount to be approved for future HPMP preparation projects", funds disbursed or obligated for the HPMP advances will be recorded in the Agency's progress report against the proposal for HPMP projects for the countries for which they had been approved.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 26. The Executive Committee may wish to:
 - (a) Note the report on balances and availability of resources contained in UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/56/4;
 - (b) Note the net level of funds being returned by the implementing agencies to the 56th Meeting amounting to US \$1,107,116 against projects and HPMP advanced balances. This includes the return of US \$267,698 from UNDP, US \$443,000 from UNEP, US \$396,418 from UNIDO;
 - (c) Note the net level of support costs being returned by the implementing agencies to the 56th Meeting amounting to US \$123,488 against projects and HPMP support cost advanced balances. This includes the return of US \$20,581 from UNDP, US \$55,840 from UNEP, US \$29,816 from UNIDO; and US \$17,251 from the World Bank;
 - (d) Note that implementing agencies had balances totalling US \$5,911,756 excluding support costs from projects completed over two years ago. This includes US \$412,783 from UNDP, US \$1,322,165 from UNEP, US \$623,517 from UNIDO, and US \$3,553,291 from the World Bank:

- (e) Note that bilateral agencies had balances from completed projects totalling US \$617,117 excluding support costs;
- (f) Note that bilateral agencies had balances totalling US \$457,254 from projects completed over two years ago. This includes US \$42,162 from Australia, US \$237,336 from France, US \$676 from Italy, US \$43,497 from Denmark; US \$76,730 from Finland and US \$56,853 from Japan;
- (g) Request bilateral agencies to report to the Committee on their proposed disposition of completed projects with balances to the 57th Meeting;
- (h) Request the Secretariat to continue monitoring completed projects with balances for bilateral agencies and report to the Committee.
