STATUS OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND DISBURSEMENTS

The Status of the Fund as at 27 February 2009

Report from the Treasurer

- 1. The tables in the following pages provide information on the Status of the Fund as recorded at UNEP as at 27 February 2009. At that date, the fund balance stood at US \$59,761,456. This is the net balance after taking into account all the funds approved by the Executive Committee, up to and including the 56th Meeting.
- 2. As a follow-up to decision 55/2, Table 1 of the Status of the Fund report reflects the additional income of US \$1,198,947 from the return of the Thai chiller project on a separate line under the income component. Such amount is provisionally allocated for unspecified projects with climate benefits until further clarification on the usage of these funds is provided.
- 3. The Parties should recall the importance of decision XI/6 paragraph 7 of the 11th Meeting of the Parties which urges "Parties" to "strive to pay their contributions as early in the calendar year as possible and not later than 1 June of each year" and that "Parties unable to make their contributions by 1 June should notify the Treasurer as to when during the calendar or fiscal year their payment will be made, but contributing Parties should strive to pay their contributions no later than 1 November of that year." Parties should also recall decision XVII/41 paragraph 5 of the 17th Meeting of the Parties, which urged "Parties to pay their contributions to the Multilateral Fund in full and as early as possible in accordance with paragraph 7 of decision XI/6".
- 4. In decision XVI/37 taken by the Parties at their 16th Meeting, it was noted that some Parties not operating under paragraph 1 of Article 5 have never paid their contributions to the Multilateral Fund, or have done so at an amount inferior to one annual contribution. The Meeting of the Parties urged those Parties to pay their outstanding contributions to the Multilateral Fund as soon as possible, in view of the current compliance needs of Parties operating under Article 5 of the Montreal Protocol.

- 5. The Treasurer dispatched notices in early January 2009 to all Parties advising them of the pledged contributions for 2009 and reminding them of their obligation. As at 27 February 2009, four Parties have paid their 2009 contributions either in full or partially, representing 2.9 per cent of payments against total 2009 pledges. In addition, since the last meeting, six Parties have made payments towards the settlement of their pre-2009 outstanding pledges. As a follow-up to the Executive Committee's decision 41/2, the list of outstanding contributions for certain countries with economies in transition will be available upon request.
- 6. In line with Meeting of the Parties decision XX/10 paragraph 1, which states "To adopt a budget for the Multilateral Fund for the Implementation of the Montreal Protocol for 2009-2011 of US \$490,000,000 on the understanding that US \$73,900,000 of the budget will be provided from anticipated contributions due the Multilateral Fund and other sources for the 2006-2008 triennium," the carry-over balance did not include the amount of US \$32,869,133 that had been withheld by the United States of America as a result of Section 307 of the USA Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 as amended. This amount will be classified as part of the "Disputed contributions" in future reports of the Status of the Fund.
- 7. Information on the fixed-exchange-rate mechanism (FERM) has been updated and reflects a gain due to the FERM of US \$38,026,296 since the inception of the mechanism. Paragraphs 1 and 2 of decision XX/11 of the Twentieth Meeting of the Parties to the Montreal Protocol directed the Treasurer to extend the FERM to the period 2009-2011. The decision states that Parties choosing to pay in national currencies will calculate their contributions based on the average United Nations exchange rate for the six-month period commencing 1 January 2008.
- 8. Pursuant to Executive Committee decision 32/2, paragraph 13 (c) which urged "Parties eligible to use the fixed-exchange-rate mechanism to inform the Treasurer by the Thirty-third meeting of the Executive Committee, (first meeting of 2003 to 2005 triennium), of their intention to do so", Parties who choose to make their payments for the triennium using the FERM are requested to advise the Treasurer of their decision before the 58th Meeting of the Executive Committee. So far six countries have advised the Treasurer of their decision to use the FERM in this replenishment period and a list of these countries is attached to this report as Annex I.
- 9. In response to decision 45/59 (f) (i) requesting the Treasurer "to circulate to the Secretariat and implementing agencies prior to each Executive Committee meeting, a ledger indicating when promissory notes are transferred, received and encashed" and to advise on the status of Promissory Notes, two tables relating to promissory notes as at 27 February 2009 have been added to the present report. Also included is a third table which provides information on the schedule of encashment of outstanding promissory notes.
- 10. The present report on the Status of the Fund for the 57th Meeting of the Executive Committee is abbreviated to nine schedules. It contains the following tables:

- 11. Through decision 40/2 paragraph (b)(i), the Executive Committee at its 40th Meeting requested that the explanation of the methodology and assumptions being used by the Treasurer be made available through the intranet. This record of assumptions and methodology first published in the Treasurer's report document UNEP/OzL.Pro/Excom/39/3/Rev.1, is still available for reference by the Executive Committee members on the Multilateral Fund intranet.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 12. The Executive Committee may wish to:
 - (a) Note the report of the Treasurer on the status of contributions and disbursements and the information on promissory notes as contained in UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/57/3;
 - (b) Urge all Parties to pay their contributions to the Multilateral Fund in full and as early as possible;
 - (c) Urge Parties eligible to use the fixed-exchange-rate mechanism to advise the Treasurer of their intention to do so before the 58th Meeting of the Executive Committee; and
 - (d) Request the Treasurer to add to his report to the 58th Meeting of the Executive Committee the list of Parties which have opted to use the fixed-exchange-rate mechanism in making their contributions to the Fund during the replenishment period of 2009 2011.
