**Addendum**

**BILATERAL COOPERATION**

- This addendum is being issued to reflect additional information received from the Government of Japan on the demonstration project to validate the use of super-critical CO<sub>2</sub> in the manufacture of sprayed polyurethane rigid foams in Colombia.
- **Replace** paragraph 12 with the following text:

12. Subsequent to the submission of this document, the Secretariat received a communication from the Government of Japan informing on its intention to notify the Government of Colombia of withdrawing the HCFC demonstration project for the use of super critical CO<sub>2</sub> in the manufacture of sprayed polyurethane rigid foams, taking into consideration, *inter alia*, current circumstances and procedural impediments surrounding the HCFC demonstration projects. The Government of Japan also stated that the content of the demonstration project would be of value to Article 5 countries in meeting their phase-out by utilizing the Japan's technology and, hence, would seek an opportunity for resubmitting it to the next Meeting. Accordingly, the project is not for consideration by the 59<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee and document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/59/24 has not been issued.

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
