## التعليقات والتوصيات من أمانة الصندوق

1- يتألف برنامج عمل عام 2004 لليونيب المقدم إلى الاجتماع 41 من الميزانية المقترحة لبرنامج المساعدة على الامتثال اليونيب والمقدر بمبلغ 6,837,900 دولار أمريكي إلى جانب تكاليف مساندة الوكالة 8% وبالبالغة 547,032 دولار أمريكي.

2- تبعاً للمقررين 36/35 (ب) و 40-49، قدمت اليونيب تقريراً إلى الاجتماع 41 بشأن استخدام تكاليف مساندة البرنامج لبرنامج للرنامج المساعدة على الامتثال والذي يرد في الوثيقة UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/41/22.

# التغيرات في ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال

E تتضمن أيضاً ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال المقترحة لعام 2004 تكاليف الشبكة الإقليمية الأوروبية/ آسيا الوسطى (ROE). ومجموع المبلغ لميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2004 بما فيها 8% رسم الوكالة (ROE). ومجموع المبلغ لميزانية على ميزانية عام 2003 المعتمدة (6,297,356 دولار أمريكي) تزيد على ميزانية عام 2003 المعتمدة (6,297,356 دولار أمريكي) تأويدية/ الأسيوية الوسطى) بمقدار 13.8%. وباستبعاد تكاليف سنة كاملة للشبكة الإقليمية الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى).

4- أبلغت اليونيب أن الزيادة على ميزانية العام الماضي تعزى إلى البنود التالية للميزانية: القائمين على المشروع/ المساعدة المؤقتة، اجتماعات/ مؤتمرات، سنة كاملة للشبكة الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى، السفر، العقود من الباطن، إيجار المكاتب/ الاتصالات والتكاليف المتحركة.

5- تم الحفاظ على بعض بنود الميزانية في برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2003 على زيادة 4%. أما الأنشطة الأخرى فإما أنها انخفضت في التكاليف أو أنها استبعدت. وتبلغ قيمة الأنشطة مع التخفيضات في التكاليف مبلغ 600,114,600 دو لار أمريكي.

#### استخدام الميزانية في عام 2002

6- أعادت اليونيب تكاليف المساندة البالغة 1,265,686 دو لار أمريكي بالإضافة إلى 8% إلى الاجتماع 40 كما يطلبه المقرر 36/35 (د). وكانت 78% من الأموال التي أعيدت تتعلق بوفورات تكليف المسؤولين نظراً لعملية التوظيف. وتتعلق الأسباب الأخرى لإعادة الأموال بالتكاليف التشغيلية والمعدات والإيجارات. وأشارت اليونيب أن هذه الوفورات ليست متوقعة عام 2004 نظراً لأن جميع العاملين المقررين (ما عدا بالنسبة إلى منسق الشبكة الإقليمية لأوروبا وآسيا الوسطى) قد أصبح واقعياً.

### الأساس المنطقى لزيادات الميزانية

7- تحتوي ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2004 لليونيب على زيادات في الميزانية نظراً للتكاليف التشغيلية
 وتكاليف الموظفين وإدخال الشبكة الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى في برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال ، والتوسع في البرامج
 الأخرى.

## التكاليف التشغيلية

8- تشمل ميزانية اليونيب لعام 2004 زيادات تفوق 4% لعدة أنشطة قائمة بما فيها: اجتماعات الشبكة الإقليمية/ الاجتماعات الموضوعية وتكاليف المكاتب والاتصالات.

9- أشارت اليونيب أن بعض التكاليف قد ازدادت نظراً لزيادة القيمة في اليورو مقابل الدولار الأمريكي، على سبيل المثال، إيجار المكاتب (زيادة 79,157 دولار أمريكي) على الرغم من أنها

أشارت ايضاً أن الزيادات في تكاليف الاتصالات كانت أيضاً ضرورية للاتصال مع المكاتب الإقليمية لـ برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال . واستناداً إلى وسطي أسعار تبادل العملات في الأمم المتحدة في عام 2002 مقابل عام 2003، فقد ازداد اليورو في القيمة بـ 16%. وإن أي أموال غير مستعملة لهذه البنود من الميزانية يتم إعادتها إلى الصندوق المتعدد الأطراف لإعادة برمجتها تبعاً للمقرر 36/35 (د).

10- أشارت اليونيب أن الزيادة في تكاليف النشرة الإخبارية لأشطة الأوزون (إزدادت بمبلغ 13.000 دولار أمريكي) تعود إلى ترجمة النشرة الإخبارية إلى اللغة الروسية وبعض تكاليف الإنتاج للنشرات باللغتين العربية والصينية.

11- أعيد توزيع تكاليف CD-Rom لنظام الإعلام الإستراتيجي لأنشطة الأوزون (OASIS) قامت به اليونيب لميزانية 2004 وذلك لنتاول القطاعات ذات الأولوية المتعلقة بأهداف الامتثال لمعلومات إدارة غاز النبريد وإدارة الهالونات ونظام الوب لخدمة النبريد.

#### تكاليف الموظفين

12- تقترح ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2004 (بإستثناء الشبكة الإقليمية الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى (ROE) زيادة تكاليف الموظفين للمشروع بمقدار 9.9% (بزيادة 272,314 دولار أمريكي)، وتكاليف موظفي الخدمات العامة بزيادة قدرها 7% (بزيادة تبلغ 52,022 دولار أمريكي) والمساعدة المؤقتة لبرنامج المساعدة على الامتثال بزيادة (38% (زيادة بمقدار 44,635 دولار أمريكي). وكما هو الحال في التكاليف التشغيلية فإن أي تكاليف غير مستخدمة للموظفين سوف تعاد إلى الصندوق المتعدد الأطراف. وأشارت اليونيب بزيادات تقوق 4% وتعكس التكاليف المتعلقة بالوظائف، أي الأفراد الذين تم تعيينهم في الوظائف لهم تعويضات موظفين تقوق المبلغ المذكور أصلاً في الميزانية لتاك الوظائف.

13- عملت اليونيب على زيادة ميزانيتها للمساعدة المؤقتة من 115,880 دولار أمريكي إلى 160,515 دولار أمريكي على الرغم من أن برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لديه الموظفين بشكل كامل فيما عدا منسق الشبكة الإقليمية لأوروبا وآسيا الوسطى. في ميزانيات برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال الماضية، كان بند الميزانية للمساعدة المؤقتة مشمولاً لتخويل تشغيل البرنامج بشكل يسبق تعيين الموظفين.

# دمج الشبكة الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى في برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال

14- في الاجتماع 39 طلبت اللجنة التنفيذية إلى اليونب تقديم إلى الاجتماع 41 لللجنة التنفيذية ميزانية منقحة، استناداً إلى الخبرة، بهدف إمكانية دمج المشروع ضمن برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال المنطقية لعام 2004 (المقرر 28/39 (ب)). أعدت الميزانية المنقحة للشبكة الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى بشكل سنوي في ميزانية عام 2004 وهي تمثل زيادة مبلغ 167,920 دو لار أمريكي إلى 335,180 دو لار أمريكي – أي ضعف المبلغ المعتمد لبرنامج الشبكة لفترة ستة شهور لعام 2003. وتقابل البنود الفردية للميزانية الميزانيات للشبكات الأخرى. ومع أن الشبكة كانت قد أدخلت في ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2004، فإن التكاليف لم تكن منطقبة تجاه الأنشطة الأخرى للبرنامج في برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2003.

## التوسعات الأخرى في البرنامج

15- تقترح اليونيب التوسع في برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال ي تكاليف إضافية للسفر والأموال لاجتماعات الشبكة/ الحلقات العملية الموضوعية والتعاقد من الباطن لطباعة النشرات/ تحديث النشرات والتكاليف المتحركة لبرنامج آسيا والمحيط الهادئ ROAP.

16- عملت اليونيب على زيادة ميزانية سفر الموظفين للبرنامج الإقليمي للمساعدة على الامتثال بمقدار 13% (زيادة بمقدار 68،000 دولار أمريكي). وأشارت بأن كان معدار 68،000 دولار أمريكي). وأشارت بأن كان هناك ضرورة لزيادة التكاليف في السفر لمنح المساندة المستمرة والمباشرة إلى البلدان التي يلزمها الامتثال نظراً لأن مرحلة

الامتثال تصبح أوسع لتشمل مواداً إضافية ولتناول الحاجة المتزايدة لمساعدة الامتثال، ولتخويل بلدان المادة 5 الحصول على مجال أوسع من الخبرات والمهارات. وطلب إلى اليونيب تقديم أساس لميزانياتها التقديرية لسفر الخبراء وموظفي البرنامج الإقليمي للمساعدة على الامتثال بالنسبة إلى عدد الزيارات ووسطي التكاليف لكل زيارة، وعدد الزيارات قد تم اعتماده وعدد الزيارات التخصصية هي متوقعة. وأشارت اليونيب أنه ليس بإمكانها تقديم المعلومات المطلوبة ولكن استد التقدير إلى تكاليف السفر للعام الماضي والزيادة المتوقعة في السفر.

17- إن الزيادة في تكاليف اجتماعات الشبكة/ الحلقات العملية الموضوعية تبلغ 61،320 دو لار أمريكي (بزيادة 11%). وأشارت اليونيب أن ميزانيات عام 2003 لاجتماعات الشبكة في مناطق أفريقيا وأمريكا اللاتينية قد ازداد مصروفها وأن الزيادة المقترحة لعام 2004 تعكس المصروفات المتوقعة. وأشارت اليونيب أيضاً أن الزيادة في تكاليف مناطق آسيا الجنوبية قد استندت إلى أشكال جديدة في الشبكة واجتماعات موضوعية إضافية نظراً لعدد الخبراء الإضافي الذي سوف تتم دعوته.

18- إن ميز انية إعادة طبع النشر ات/ تحديث النشر ات القائمة لم يكن متضمناً في ميز انية عام 2003. وبلغت ميز انية عام 2004 لهذا البند 50،000 دو لار أمريكي.

19- تتضمن ميزانية عام 2004 أيضاً مبلغ 30،000 دولار أمريكي للتكاليف المتحركة لمنطقة آسيا والمحيط الهادئ (ROAP) التي لم تكن منضمنة في ميزانية عام 2003. ورأت أمانة الصندوق أن التوسع في البرنامج بسبب مثل هذه التكاليف لم يتم النص عليه في الميزانيات السابقة لبرنامج المساعدة على الامتثال وينبغي أن يعتبر بشكل طبيعي كجزء من رسوم الوكالة التي تتسلمها اليونيب.

#### التعليقات

20- إن أحد مبادئ برنامج أنشطة الامتثال كان تخصيصاً عاماً تقوم اليونيب بموجبه بالإدارة وإعادة التخصيص ووضع الأساس المنطقي وفقاً للاحتياجات المتغيرة للبرنامج مما يسمح بزيادة حتى 4% في البرنامج بالنسبة للتضخم. إن ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2003 بما فيها الشبكة الجديدة (6,487,106 دو لار أمريكي) تمثل زيادة بمقدار 12.2% على الميزانية المعتمدة لعام 2002 بالنسبة للميزانية الأولى لبرنامج المساعدة على الامتثال (5,779,566 دو لار أمريكي).

21- تقترح الميزانية إعادة توزيع بسيط للأموال القائمة بإستثناء CD-ROM لنظام الإعلام الإستراتيجي لأنشطة الأوزون (OASIS CD-ROM).

22- إن مستوى التكاليف المنطقية لاحتواء التوسعات في البنرامج تبلغ 114،600 دولار أمريكي مما يمثل 1.8% من الميزانية المعتمدة لعام 2003 في حين أن زيادة التكاليف تمثل زيادة تبلغ 1.5% على الميزانية بإستثناء الشبكة الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى. أما التكاليف الإضافية للمساعدة المؤقتة فلم يكن لها أساس منطقي نظراً لأنه جرى تعيين جميع موظفي برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال من ميزانية عام 2003.

23- إن الزيادات المقترحة لبرنامج المساعدة على الامتثال تشبه الطلبات لزيادات للسماح بإنجاز أهداف برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال القائمة، وعلى سبيل المثال، الزيادات بسبب التجاوزات في التكاليف لاجتماعات الشبكة الإقليمية، وتكاليف النشرة الإخبارية لأنشطة الأوزون، وتكاليف الموظفين التي تفوق المخصص البالغ 4%.

24- مهما يكن من أمر، فإن زيادات الموظفين تبدو أنها تعكس تعديلاً استثنائياً لميز انية التكاليف ليعكس نتائج عملية تعيين الموظفين.

25- بدون تكاليف التوسع في البرامج الأخرى ولكن السماح بمقدار 4% للتضخم، فإن الميزانية الإجمالية لبرنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2004 ستبلغ 6,676,572 دو لار أمريكي بإستبعاد رسوم الوكالات والشبكة الإقليمية الأوروبية/ الأسبوية الوسطى.

26- تجدر الإشارة بأن ميز انيات الوحدات الرئيسية للوكالات المنفذة لا تشمل نصاً لزيادة 4%.

27- قدمت اليونيب تقريراً حول تكاليف مساندة الوكالة في الوثيقة UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/41/22. وتمت الموافقة على ميزانيات برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال السابقة مع رسم الوكالة البالغ 8%.

### التوصيات

قد ترغب اللجنة الفرعية لاستعراض المشروعات أن تأخذ في الحسبان عندما تنظر في ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال لعام 2004 لليونيب أن تنظر في الموافقة على ميزانية برنامج المساعدة على الامتثال بمبلغ 6,676,572 دولار أمريكي على الأساس التالي:

- (أ) إدخال تكاليف 12 شهراً للشبكة الإقليمية الأوروبية/ الأسيوية الوسطى بالتناسب مع تكاليف عام 2003؛
  - (ب) إدخال زيادة 9.9% لتكاليف الموظفين على أساس التكاليف الفعلية المتوقعة؛
- (ج) السماح الإجمالي لتضخم 4% لتغطية جميع التكاليف الأخرى بما في ذلك التوسع في البرنامج المقترح؛
- (c) تكاليف المساندة، بالإضافة إلى ما ذكر أعلاه، ينبغي أن تنظر فيها اللجنة التنفيذية على أساس الوثيقة .UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/41/22

# **UNEP 2004 CAP BUDGET**

PRESENTED TO THE
41ST MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
OF THE MULTILATERAL FUND FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION

#### **INTRODUCTION**

As per guidance provided by the Multilateral Fund Secretariat, the 2004 Business Plans of the Implementing Agencies will be submitted to the 42<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee. At that time, UNEP will provide as part of its 2004 Business Plan the details of programme orientation, planned country-specific support for compliance, and the planned activities of the information clearinghouse.

In light of UNEP's budget cycle and administrative system, the core budget for the Compliance Assistance Programme (CAP) must be approved prior to the following year (e.g. funds to cover staff salaries must be approved prior to 1 January). Hence, in keeping with the existing procedure, UNEP is submitting the 2004 CAP operating budget to this meeting for the Executive Committee's consideration.

For 2004, UNEP is requesting a CAP budget of **US\$ 6,837,900** excluding programme support costs, of which US\$ 335,180 is for the Eastern European and Central Asian Regional Network of ODS Officers. For comparison, the 2003 CAP budget approved during the 38<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee was US\$ 5,830,885.

Apart from inflation, the majority of the requested increase is for delivery of direct assistance by the Regional CAP Teams (ROA, ROAP, ROLAC, ROWA) to meet demand for compliance assistance from the countries (for example, in 2004, CAP will have to assist the large number of countries in danger of non-compliance with the CFC, halon, methyl bromide and CTC controls as per Executive Committee document 40/25). These additional resources are required to help countries successfully meet their compliance challenges.

As per Decision 38/36, UNEP has been requested to prepare, if possible, unified budgets that internalize the programme support costs, if necessary in an indicative way. UNEP cannot currently implement this decision for the following reasons:

- a) The recommendation limits the authority to approve and allot programme support cost delegated to the UNEP Executive Director under United Nations Administrative Instruction ST/AI/286 which has been subsequently confirmed by the United Nations Secretary-General in ST/SGB/188;
- b) The recommendation contradicts the United Nations Financial Rules and Regulations which stipulate that programme support cost should be budgeted and expended under the special Trust Fund Support account.<sup>1</sup>

UNEP, in cooperation with UNON, is continuing to investigate how such a unified budget could be presented to the Executive Committee in the future.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF RESULTS ACHIEVED BY CAP IN 2003 (TO DATE)

The CAP was operationalised in 2002-2003 and the programme was re-oriented to provide direct compliance assistance to Article 5 countries, primarily through staff based in UNEP's Regional Offices. Given the unique character of the services provided under the CAP, the following highlights of results achieved by the CAP in 2003 to date are provided below (full details will be provided to the Executive Committee as part of the regular Progress Reporting process).

#### **DETAILS OF THE 2004 CAP BUDGET**

The 2004 CAP budget being submitted for consideration is contained in Annex I. The methodology used in the development of this budget is based on the experience gained in the implementation of the regionalised CAP programme. Areas where UNEP perceived a need for increased support for countries have been strengthened.

The limitations in the development of this budget are as follows:

- The entire CAP teams for Asia and the Pacific and Africa were in place as of January 2003 but the staff complement for Latin America and the Caribbean, West Asia and Paris were only completed later during that year.
- The up-to-date expenditures during the year were not fully available during the development of this budget. Therefore rough estimates had to be made.
- The actual operational cost will only be available after having all teams in place working for an entire year period. Thus, the actual 2003 cost figures will only be available in 2004.
- The changing nature of networking (i.e. moving towards incorporating a more thematic approach) directly impacts on the cost.

For clarity, text explaining the reason for adjustments to the budget has been added at the end of each budget line. The following is a general summary of what was used to determine the changes in each area:

- <u>Salary lines:</u> All salary lines (1101-1125 and 1301 -1316) are adjusted to reflect expected cost requirements for the posts. Some posts were under-budgeted in the 2003 budget and there was an upward adjustment of UN professional staff salaries in 2002.
- Eastern European and Central Asian Network: This new network, which was approved for six months at the 39<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee, has been consolidated into the CAP budget as per line-by-line approval.
- Short-term experts: The short-term expert lines were reduced to 0 as these costs can be covered from the budget lines for Temporary Assistance and South-South/North-South expert travel.
- Training: The consultant's line (1201) for training of CAP staff was reduced to 0 as CAP training was completed in 2003.
- Staff travel: Paris staff travel remains unchanged. Staff travel to support countries in achieving compliance remains the same for Asia and the Pacific but a slight increase is requested for West Asia. Significant increases however are requested for the Africa and Latin America regions as the number of countries being managed are large and travel distances are also significant. It is also important to note that quite a number of counties in Africa will require assistance in achieving compliance.
- South-South/North-South expert travel: An additional line was added for South-South/North-South expert travel (3207) for the Eastern European and Central Asian Regional Network. An increase in the South-South/North-South budget lines will allow the networks to have a wide range of experts available for support. The use of such assistance is increasing and countries are particularly receptive to the support provided. UNEP believes that an increase in these budget lines as indicated is warranted and would provide needed support to the countries in achieving compliance.
- Network meetings: All regions in integrating the networking approach with thematic workshops are indicating a need for additional small meetings to deal with specific issues. As a result of this, the increasing cost of travel and having some meetings in outlying countries of regions as normal rotation of meetings, the meeting budget lines in some regions have been over-expended. An increase in budget line 3302 3205 is requested.
- Rental: The rental costs in Paris (4301) show a significant increase as there has been an important fluctuation (i.e. a reduction) in the value of the US dollar in comparison to the Euro, which is the currency of rental payment. This increase is not withstanding the fact that the actual space occupied by the OzonAction team has been reduced by one office.

Similarly, there is an increase for the regions (4302) due to normal rental increase and additional security costs.

• <u>Communication</u>: The budget for communication is being increased based on actual expenditures.

## **Guidance requested from the Executive Committee**

UNEP requests guidance or decisions on the following matters:

- 1. UNEP has not requested support for programmatic issues in the 2004 budget, but anticipates that in the future (e.g. for 2005) the need for such support will arise in the regions, particularly if countries face additional problems in achieving compliance. UNEP will assess the situation during 2004 and propose a programmatic budget, if merited. UNEP would like to raise this issue with the Executive Committee early.
- 2. The Help Desk Officer (1107) was approved by the Executive Committee at a P1 level. The duties and requirements for this post were classified at a P2 level. The Executive Committee is requested to approve this post at a P2 level. There is no additional financial implication as per the budget document.
- 3. Approval of the incorporation of the budget for the Eastern European and Central Asian Regional Network into the CAP Administrative budget.
- 4. Approval of the Eastern European and Central Asian Regional Network being coordinated out of UNEP's Regional Office for Europe (Geneva) and the RNC being located in that office. The original approved project document indicated that the RNC would be based in UNEP DTIE office in Paris.
- 5. The West Asia Regional Network of ODS Officers requested UNEP to include a budget line in the 2004 CAP budget for a Policy and Enforcement Officer for the region. The Executive Committee is requested to consider approval of a post of Policy and Enforcement Officer for the West Asia Network to be based in Bahrain.
- 6. Approval of the CAP 2004 Administrative budget.
